

**RACE 1** 10:35 AM | AUD32,000 | **PAKENHAM** | 1200m

2	<b>DREAM IF YOU CAN</b>	Well held but far from disgraced on debut in sloppy conditions at Moe when supported. Likely to improve from there and Egan sticks.
5	<b>VANVITELLI</b>	Rise in distance should help and has the benefit of a better draw. Has upside to make an impact here.
1	<b>BRADFORD</b>	Will benefit from that run and gets onto firmer ground. In the mix.
7	<b>JUNDAH</b>	\$40k Inglis Premier yearling. First foal out of a Stakes placed mare. Won latest Pakenham jumpout and gets a good draw for career opener. Include.

**RACE 2** 10:50 AM | AUD32,000 | **WANGARATTA** | 1000m

2	<b>MY ALPHA SONIC</b>	Returns for second campaign (35-weeks). More mature now. Wasn't all that far away in first campaign. Building experience. Can improve.
4	<b>REGAL VANGUARD</b>	Close to the pace, lacked response when winner burst clear but kept boxing away this course at this journey. Leads, handy. Only for exotics.
13	<b>XUXA KISS</b>	Returns for second campaign (20-weeks). Maps to get a sweet run. Set to play a leading role fresh.
10	<b>MY BONNIE LASSIE</b>	Settled handy and responded well in sloppy conditions to fill the minors at Moe. Sound claims.

**RACE 3** 11:10 AM | AUD32,000 | **PAKENHAM** | 1200m

6	<b>COSMIC SHOWER</b>	Resuming (50-weeks). Shown early potential and looks primed for this winning two Pakenham Synthetic jumpouts. Expected to make an immediate impact.
15	<b>STAKES</b>	\$300k Magic Millions Gold Coast yearling out of an unraced half sister to Global Glamour. Looked impressive winning a recent Flemington jumpout. Awkward alley but bears close watching.
5	<b>VALLO</b>	Fronting up for second campaign (19-weeks). Impressive when rounding them up to win recent Pakenham Synthetic jumpout. Can show more this time in. Among chances.
7	<b>EGYPTIAN CROWN</b>	\$230k Inglis Easter yearling and is the second foal out of multiples Stakes winner. First and sixth in two recent jumpouts, the second one under light riding. Big watch on debut.

**RACE 4** 11:25 AM | AUD32,000 | **WANGARATTA** | 1300m

5	<b>GALAGACISCO</b>	Unplaced but he has shown enough on occasions. Good response but narrowly outpointed late at Echuca when off an extended spell. Breaks from a low barrier. Will be fitter second-up.
2	<b>BOLD JESTER</b>	Not too far off them at Moe on debut 18 Jun. Took valuable lessons. A bit raw on debut but there's plenty of upside. Worth thought.
8	<b>SIYAASI</b>	5 weeks since last run. Gave a good sight in soft going making the frame at Corowa in only his second race appearance when in the market. Sharper now and will take stopping in this company.
4	<b>DON'T DOUBT TIGGA</b>	Resuming (62-weeks). Drawn to effect. Can make his presence felt fresh in this affair.

**RACE 5** 11:45 AM | AUD32,000 | **PAKENHAM** | 1400m

12	<b>INSOLENCE</b>	Let down fiercely from midfield to grab second at Flemington at second run back. Still only a 2YO but looks the one they have to beat.
9	<b>JENNI BASSETT</b>	Prominent before fading late this venue at second run back. Has early speed and is ready to peak.
1	<b>BRAZEN WARRIOR</b>	Failed to threaten in heavy ground at Donald at second run back when in the market. Has a tricky draw but is suited back onto firmer going.
3	<b>RAINY NIGHT</b>	Ex A & S Freedman in Victoria. Well in the market in shifty conditions last start. Gets some key gear changes and suited onto drier ground.

**RACE 6** 12:00 PM | AUD32,000 | **WANGARATTA** | 1590m

8	<b>THE QUIET IMMORTAL</b>	Shown some ability. Out the back, closed with raking strides in the Mdn Plate at Cranbourne. Has a big say here.
10	<b>WAR NO MORE</b>	Not disgraced in sloppy conditions at Moe at \$17. Good draw. Capable of making an impact.
7	<b>THE CHARLATAN</b>	Knocking on the door. Handy, knuckled down with purpose in rain affected going at Donald as a betting firmer. Fitter second-up. Among the dangers again.
4	<b>PRINCE OF SPIRIT</b>	Sound on debut at Wangaratta 14 Jun. Failed to threaten in sticky going at Wodonga in only his second race appearance after speccing from \$19 into \$13. All the better and can play a role.

**RACE 7** 12:20 PM | AUD32,000 | **PAKENHAM** | 1600m

17	<b>ACHY BREAKY HEART</b>	Dual acceptor at Flemington Saturday. Ran home respectably into a non-threatening 5th this track last start. Had strong market support two runs prior and looks well placed at this level.
11	<b>FRANKEL'S WORD</b>	Dual acceptor at Flemington on Saturday. Showed a fine turn of foot from the back this venue in only his second race appearance. Suited by the longer assignment now and right in the mix again.
8	<b>SHINDY</b>	Looked home but couldn't get past the winner this track at this trip under heavy support. Gets winkers and they may be the difference.
9	<b>SOUL MISTRESS</b>	First-up (15-weeks). Fairly consistent without winning last campaign. 10th in recent Cranbourne jumpout. Kicks off prep over suitable trip.

**RACE 8** 12:35 PM | AUD22,000 | **WANGARATTA** | 1590m

7	<b>DUBAI FOUNTAIN</b>	Led them up but melted under pressure at Gundagai. Leads, handy. Looks a serious player.
9	<b>PENDANTE</b>	Went close at Swan Hill 6 Jun. Went home tamely in the slosh at Donald at \$15. Key player with even luck.
1	<b>ALTRUIST</b>	Settled close and ran an honest race at Bendigo. Good draw. Capable of playing a key role in this.
10	<b>FOGGY BOTTOM</b>	Sent out \$101 when unable to threaten at Pakenham Synthetic. Drawn favourably. Deep into his campaign and not out of this.

**RACE 9** 12:55 PM | AUD22,000 | **PAKENHAM** | 1600m

7	<b>DUNTULM LASS</b>	Filly who is in a rich vein of form. Usually gets back but is dropping in grade and can run well again.
8	<b>QUEEN OF THE SURF</b>	Ridden in back half, strong late to fill the minors this venue at this trip. Blinkers go on first time. Worth a look.
3	<b>FENESTELLA</b>	Fresh. Was a valiant but vanquished third at Swan Hill over their carnival. Leads, handy and likely to be in this for a long way.
9	<b>COSMIC</b>	Handy competitor who is fitter for those two runs and ready to show best. Placed to effect here.

**RACE 10** 1:10 PM | AUD22,000 | **WANGARATTA** | 2000m

1	<b>SIR BASIL</b>	Racing well. Triumphant on speed display at Wodonga. Only win was on heavy ground. Looks extremely hard to beat again.
8	<b>I COULD DO BETTER</b>	Settled handy and responded well in sticky going to fill the minors at Wodonga. Gets through rain affected ground. Deep into his campaign and could get into the placings.
9	<b>VISION THING</b>	Closed off late from the tail at Bairnsdale. Only win to date was this distance. Can make her presence felt with even luck.
4	<b>KAMAROOKA</b>	Rider found a forward spot at Donald but she put in a very lacklustre finish. Capable of making an impact.

**RACE 11 1:30 PM | AUD22,000 | PAKENHAM | 1200m**

4	<b>COSMIC CHARGER</b>	First-up (24-weeks). Form solid last time in. and moved well when finishing second in recent Pakenham Synthetic jumpout. Best form over slightly further but respect first-up.
11	<b>QUBELLA</b>	Let-up (66-days). Beaten in the Corinthian last start but recent jumpout behind Le Ferrari was encouraging. Could give some cheek at odds fresh in this line-up.
6	<b>BARDIA'S DREAM</b>	Resuming (21-weeks). Fourth in recent Werribee jumpout. Ticks the track and distance win box. Can challenge fresh in this line-up.
7	<b>BELLA PIETRA</b>	Let-up (43-days). Sixth of six in recent Flemington jumpout between runs. Keep safe on her maiden win alone.

**RACE 12 1:50 PM | AUD22,000 | WANGARATTA | 1000m**

11	<b>KAZOTSKY</b>	Not disgraced in testing conditions at Wodonga when second-up. Proven record wet/track. Sharper now and major player here.
7	<b>ALPINOVA</b>	Resuming (31-weeks). Raced well last time in. Ticks the wet and track boxes. Winner at only other start at Wangaratta.
12	<b>REDEMPTION TIME</b>	Issued decent challenge in heavy ground Hcp (56) at Donald and over this trip. Not out of this.
9	<b>ADKI</b>	Seasoned performer. Led, gave away final stages at Echuca first up. Jump-and-run mare. Fitter second-up.

**RACE 13 2:10 PM | AUD22,000 | PAKENHAM | 1200m**

4	<b>FLYING MEAN</b>	Picked up strongly from back half this course. Sound stats this venue and Mott takes the ride over key rival. Shapes as a major player.
1	<b>GODTFRED KIRK</b>	Let-up (45-days). Reserved at rear, late into the frame at Pakenham at first run for new trainer. Sixth in a jumpout between runs. Can challenge again.
2	<b>THATSMONEYBROTHER</b>	Last assignment this trip when ran on okay without troubling this course. Highly rated in this line-up.
5	<b>ANGEL IN BLACK</b>	Good in Stakes company earlier. Wore them down late this track at resumption and Lachlan Neindorf retains the ride. Can again play a role.

**RACE 14 2:30 PM | AUD22,000 | WANGARATTA | 1300m**

3	<b>BOULDER JACK</b>	Delivered in dominant style at Echuca. Should be prominent. Strikes another winnable race.
2	<b>TOUXLOVE</b>	Got back and hit line with a full head of steam at Moe. Adept heavy/proven track. Ticks the track and distance win box. All the better and capable of making an impact if things pan out.
1	<b>KING INCANTO</b>	Terrific effort when just shaded in heavy ground at Albury 16 Jun. Rates among the better chances.
6	<b>PLEASE ME DO</b>	Not disgraced at Ballarat Synthetic at \$15. Proven record wet/track. Hard fit and has some claims.

**RACE 15 2:50 PM | AUD22,000 | PAKENHAM | 1000m**

10	<b>SMASH BLUE</b>	First-up (22-weeks). Fourth in a recent Cranbourne jumpout. Gets the services of J Mott from a good gate. Worth a look fresh in this company.
9	<b>SHOCAP</b>	Went back, closed intently this venue at this distance. Looks a serious player.
2	<b>MANHATTAN THUNDER</b>	Specped \$9 into \$7.50 when just behind the minors this course at this trip. Capable of making an impact.
1	<b>BOLD PRINT</b>	Resuming (15-weeks). Winless since 29 Nov 2024. Awkwardly drawn for return but gets some weight relief after the claim. Capable of showing some cheek.

**RACE 16 3:20 PM | AUD22,000 | PAKENHAM | 1400m**

11	<b>PHOEBE BUFFAY</b>	Fresh. Not disgraced in soft going at Swan Hill at first run for new trainer. First run synthetic but warrants attention.
12	<b>WRITTEN STORY</b>	Honest type who was brave effort in busy finish this track. Only win to date was this distance.
10	<b>LOTTA CITY</b>	Ran home nicely to win after settling handy this course at this journey. Going well but meets stronger field and must lift again.
4	<b>TITAN OF CHOICE</b>	On a quick back-up. Well back and race shape against last start. Fit from racing and suited rising in trip.
