11	EVERY LITTLE THING	Placed 2yo+ (Bm56) at Echuca 11 May. Ran on okay without troubling in sloppy conditions at Kilmore. Placed only other time here. Hard fit and not out of this.
4	OUTDRIVE	Dictated terms in recording a gritty win in the Mdn Plate at Pakenham. J Mott retains the ride. Among the dangers again.
6	ANNABELLE SUNSHINE	Aiming for hat-trick. Settled close and responded strongly at Moe at this distance. Loves the wet. Will take stopping in this company.

5	ROGUE WARRIOR	Cleared maiden ranks at Sale 21 Dec. Picked up strongly from back half at Sale. Fitter second-up. Among the dangers again with even luck.
2	LUDLUM	Returns for second campaign (31-weeks). More mature now. Broke maiden at Seymour in his first preparation. Just denied in Maiden company at Ballarat first-up last time in. Winner at track and distance.
