

RACE 1 8:35 PM | SAR40,000 | RIYADH | 1200m

7	ROZZEN	Useful colt who has run well in Open and conditions races thus far. Drops into maiden company for the first time and should go close.
6	NORTHERN WINNER	Speedy colt who caught the eye when fourth on debut over course and distance. Unable to sustain his run in a conditions event last time but now drops back in grade.
14	TRIPLE ONE	Made notable late headway when sixth of 20 on debut over 1400m in December. Shouldn't be discounted with blinkers going on.
4	MOUJ ALMUHAMADIA	Unraced Dandy Man colt out of a UK-bred mare. Purchased for 12,000gns in May.

RACE 2 9:00 PM | SAR40,000 | RIYADH | 1200m

16	THOUGHTS'N PRAYERS	Patience is wearing thin with this filly but her penultimate runner-up effort gives her leading claims in this field.
9	SAFEER JEAN	Winless in 22 starts but boasts the highest official rating in this line-up. Vulnerable to an improver but cannot be dismissed.
3	ANA ALBAASEL	Eighth of 18 in a 0-70 handicap when last seen in December. Progression has levelled off but he has drawn well and drops back into maiden company.
7	OMRAN	Made some late headway when fifth of 17 over this trip in November. Now winless from 10 starts and others may have more improvement than him.

RACE 3 9:25 PM | SAR85,000 | RIYADH | 1200m

11	NASEEM ALNAFEL	Landed a 0-70 handicap over 1400m with ease earlier this month and should be well suited to this drop in distance.
10	SAHAB ALMOGHTARH	Runner-up in a course-and-distance Open before finishing a respectable sixth of 19 two weeks ago. Not without a chance now dropped into a handicap.
4	ALAMAWEE	Runner-up at this level over 1400m last week. Dropped 1lb and appears well handicapped if able to reproduce that effort after a short break.
12	ANALEEN	Course-and-distance scorer in December who fared well over 1400m earlier this month. Don't discount.

RACE 4 9:55 PM | SAR40,000 | RIYADH | 2000m

16	MAHA	Well-related filly who finished third of eight in an Open here in November. Steps up in trip and must go close if she stays.
3	BATRAN	Clearly the horse to beat on official figures. Competitive in handicap and stronger maidens and should win this.
12	ROSARIO CENTRAL	Third of 20 over 1600m when last seen. Worth a try over longer distances given his closing style.
14	WIZAAREY	Finished well from off the pace to take third of 18 in a 1600m maiden earlier this month. An interesting participant now upped in trip.

RACE 5 10:20 PM | SAR95,000 | RIYADH | 2000m

1	FEELINGS	Consistent colt who deserves a breakthrough success. Second in an 1800m Open here earlier this month and should take a lot of beating in this company.
6	MONAFES	Eight-race maiden who finished runner-up in a 1600m 0-80 handicap earlier this month. Clear place candidate.
11	SAMID	Sixth of 20 in a 0-80 handicap over 1600m here last week. Quickly returns and goes up in trip. Races from 3lb out of the handicap.
7	RABEGH	Yet to win in 10 starts but clearly boasts enough talent to show his hand at this level.

RACE 6 10:50 PM | SAR40,000 | RIYADH | 2000m

11	MUAENIZ	Yet to win in 13 starts but has placed over this course and distance and boasts a lofty official rating. Horse to beat.
14	TAKLIM	Fourth of 19 on debut over track and trip. Not as good here last week over 1600m but open to more improvement.
7	BIN YASHJOB	Caught the eye when third of 20 on debut over course and distance. Hasn't matched that form in five subsequent starts and now can't be trusted.
1	ADDAL MEELAH	Plugged on to finish eighth of 16 in a weak Open over course and distance four weeks ago. Seen to better effect over shorter distances thus far.

RACE 7 11:20 PM | SAR300,000 | RIYADH | 1800m

1	DUBAMEEN	Fended off stablemate Ableekh to win the trial for this earlier in the month. Likely to confirm that form and looks the horse to beat.
2	ABLEEKH	Consistent filly who finished second behind Dubameen over track and trip earlier this month. Tough draw but should go close.
8	NIGHT QUEEN	Showed some ability when third of 20 on debut over 1600m last month. Shouldn't be overlooked granted likely improvement.
4	AESAL JIRDAAN	Runner-up in a 19-strong field over 1200m last month. Major player if staying this longer trip.

RACE 8 11:50 PM | SAR300,000 | RIYADH | 1800m

2	AL LAHEEF	Lightly raced colt who finished second behind Saif Barzan in the trial for this race earlier this month. Seventh in a Group 3 since.
1	SAIF BARZAN	Four wins from 14 starts and boasts the highest official rating in this field. Won the trial for this race earlier this month and will take some beating today.
19	IBN HATEM AL KHALEDIAH	Classy sprinter who is unproven over this distance but clearly has the talent to go close if he stays.
7	QASWRAH ALQANON	Fourth of 17 behind Saif Barzan in this race last year. Hasn't shown his best form so far this season but is clearly capable of competing at this level.

RACE 9 12:20 AM | SAR300,000 | RIYADH | 2000m

2	MIDHASS	Consistent type who finished second to Saudi Act in the trial for this race earlier in the month. Not without a chance of reversing that form.
1	SAUDI ACT	Made every yard to win the trial for this race over course and distance earlier this month. Dangerous if given an easy lead again.
8	KBAR	Runner-up in a Taif maiden over 2000m earlier this season. Place claims if repeating that form.
18	ZANAT AELOOMIK	Unraced Footbridge colt out of a highly rated UK-bred mare. Drawn inside on debut.

RACE 10 12:45 AM | SAR300,000 | RIYADH | 1200m

6	SNAFIYA	Classy type with nine wins from 30 outings. Beat a handful of these on her penultimate outing and fared well in a much stronger Cup race here a fortnight ago.
5	SAIL ON SILVERBIRD	Smart mare who finished third of 18 behind Snafiya earlier this month. Shouldn't be far away.
7	TWEETSTER	US import with an improving profile for these connections. Fifth of nine in December against better opposition and now drops into a sprint.
1	KAWAFILL	Four wins from 13 starts. Second in a Cup race over course and distance in December and not beaten far over further last week.

RACE 11 1:10 AM | SAR300,000 | RIYADH | 1600m

1	AL KAASER	Won at this meeting last year and appears to be rounding back into form. Fifth of 12 in a Group 3 a fortnight ago and should go close here.
16	TURKI AL KHALEDIAH II	Usually reliable 10-time winner who produced a rare disappointing display here two weeks ago. Hard to dismiss given his backform, but not easy to trust after his latest performance.
11	MOSTABSIL AL KHALEDIAH	Just two wins from 20 outings. Course-and-distance winner earlier this month but disappointing here last time.
5	FOO DE PINE	Produced a career-best performance when he won the Sprint Championship over 1200m here last week. May have ability to reproduce that over this longer trip.
