2nd Pick: SIMON (1)

Dragged back to the second half of the field during the run last start and made plenty of ground to finish just behind Legend Of Niagara, could repeat last starts performance.

3rd Pick: CHINA PEARL (2)

Won impressively last start, held up for most of the straight, got the gap and flew home at the right time. Up to class 5 and will appreciate the distance and should settle around midfield. Good chance.

4th Pick: SEAMLESSLY (5)

Just won last time out on the turf and distance, had a dream run and peeled out at the right time, rises back to class 5. Race conditions should suit and could back-up again.

3rd Pick: STEADY PUNPIPI (11)


Needs to find he's peak and has been falling short in open maiden company behind some competitive horses. Has experience on the turf and needs to jump from the stalls faster.

4th Pick: SACRED GOLD (2)

A 3yo with some ability, the 1400m does look to suit and has experience on both poly and turf.

4th Pick: KARISTO (1)

We haven't seen the best from him for some time, but he continues to front up trying to regain his form. He could come out here and surprise as top rater and draws well in four.

Honest win last start, sat behind a hot speed and just won. Has a handy record on the turf and 1400m which is ideal.

4th Pick: SUPER TALENT (12)

Fallen short from the placing in the last couple of starts. Had to go back last time out and worked home well just behind the placings.

4th Pick: HARD TOO THINK (6)

This two-time Group 1 winner has had his share of problems and was expected to take some time to return to fitness. If he can dig up his career best form, he must be included in the exotics.

This is his fourth run since dropping down to class four and hasn't quite measured up as some would have expected. He has won much tougher races in the past and don't dismiss him here.

4th Pick: CASH COVE (6)

He is a talented type that when he is good, he is very good but can be inconsistent as his form shows. If you are looking for value, then this gelding could be the play.

2nd Pick: LIM'S EVEREST (5)

Coming out of the same behind Commander and finished second. Always shows early speed and the distance should suit. Had a moderate trial of late.

3rd Pick: STAR EXPRESS (6)


Ran a good second last start off a slow speed and relished the trip. Now back to 1600m and has okay form on the long course.

4th Pick: KHAO MANEE (8)

Has a solid record on the long course over this distance and won impressively last start on the poly track. Has ability.

Course and distance specialist who draws the ace in this very open field. Should settle back but with the claim he will be catching the eye late yet again.

3rd Pick: PACIFIC BAO BEI (1)


This gelding was once touted as a Singapore Derby hope when he first arrived on the scene here at Kranji. This is his second run back from a spell and should strip fitter.

4th Pick: SOUSUI (5)

Having his second run for the new stable after finishing five lengths behind Silo in a race that has proven form in the last two weeks. Can be hard to follow but the ability is there.

Talented type who has some big feature races on his radar this year. His last win came in the Derby last year and has a better record over these shorter trips. The weight is a concern.

4th Pick: SKY EYE (3)
Racing first up this weekend since August after a great season where he recorded a few class 1 victories beating some very good horses. Watch for any betting moves.

2nd Pick: BIG TIGER (9)
On the quick six day turn around after he was seen flying home late to record a slick final sectional and beaten just under two lengths to Surrey Hills. Should gather plenty of support.

3rd Pick: OUR PINNACLE (4)
Recently recorded a barrier trial win albeit in very slow time. Gets back to a course and distance where he has recorded plenty of good results in the past. Duric on is a big plus.

4th Pick: TE AKAU BEN (5)
Has been a very frustrating horse to follow in his career but if you look at his wins, he certainly has some ability to offer. Draws well and will be aided by a claim. Value runner here.
