

RACE 1 9:00 PM | AED70,000 | ABU DHABI | 2400m

5	SS ALAHWAS (FR)	Placed twice over 1600m and 2000m and fair 2400m fifth earlier; consistent staying profile and rates highly.
1	ALNAYER (AE)	Won a 1700m Conditions race but well beaten last start; stamina test awaits yet can remain competitive.
10	GURM (FR)	Has not featured in recent staying handicaps; overall profile modest and needs improvement.
12	NASHWAAN (FR)	Has contested several 2400m handicaps recently; experience at the trip may help and could improve with the right run.
2	HK KHANJAR (AE)	Recent handicap efforts modest but stays the trip; capable of stepping forward if fit.

RACE 2 9:30 PM | AED66,000 | ABU DHABI | 2200m

9	MARLO DE FAUST (FR)	Fourth over 1800m two starts back and consistent at middle trips; extra distance suits and holds leading claims.
7	FA'ADHEL (FR)	Finished 14th over 2100m on latest staying attempt; may stay on into contention if fit.
2	ITALY (FR)	Recent 8th in maiden company; unproven at this trip but can pose a threat.
11	WHATEVERR (US)	Won a 1000m trial on 4 February; stamina unknown but may play a role stepping up sharply in trip.
12	MAWHIBAT AL ASAYL (AE)	Finished 7th and 6th in recent trials; yet to show form at this trip and minor chance only.

RACE 3 10:00 PM | AED66,000 | ABU DHABI | 2200m

4	SAMA AL IZZ (FR)	Won over 2200m in Conditions company and boasts multiple wins; progressive stayer who looks well placed to strike.
7	ES FAYEZ (AE)	Last-start 2400m handicap win following earlier placings; consistent stayer and should be in the mix again.
1	L'AMIRAL LA MAJORI (FR)	Fifth in Listed company over this trip after 2400m third; solid staying credentials and can figure prominently.
8	MAKNOON (FR)	Fourth over 1800m last time and previous handicap winner; up in trip and may play a role.
10	SSR LAHEEB (OM)	Last-start 13th but earlier Listed fourth over 2200m; capable on best form and holds minor claims.

RACE 4 10:30 PM | AED66,000 | ABU DHABI | 1600m

9	HAZEM AL WATHBA (AE)	Second over 1600m in Conditions company and consistent at similar trips; proven at the distance and looks the one to beat.
1	ARGHAD (AE)	Won a 1700m maiden previously but 7th last time; back in this company and should be in the mix.
2	DH ALBAHAR (AE)	Finished 14th last start but earlier 1400m placings; capable if returning to that level and can pose a threat.
12	SAMAA AL GHARBIA (AE)	Fourth over 1600m last time and generally consistent; may play a role.
7	ATHMAN BAYNOUNAH (AE)	Recent maiden 3rds but unproven in stronger grade; minor chance.

RACE 5 11:00 PM | AED66,000 | **ABU DHABI** | 1600m

3	NEVERMORE AL MAURY (FR)	Fourth over 2000m last start and previous 1600m handicap win; proven at the trip and is a strong contender for the win.
2	MOHARRAM (FR)	Eighth over 1600m last time but earlier winner at the trip; capable of better and should be in the mix.
1	BF GALA (OM)	15th last start but prior 1600m placings; capable of rebounding and can figure prominently.
6	AF ALAREEQ (AE)	13th over 1000m last time and modest at 1600m; may play a role if stepping forward.
14	AALA'A (FR)	Won a 1600m maiden on 25 October; capable of another bold showing.

RACE 6 11:30 PM | AED66,000 | **ABU DHABI** | 1600m

11	SALEETT (USA)	Second over 1600m last start and clear form edge in this maiden; prime opportunity to clinch victory.
10	NA EEM (USA)	Sixth last start but placed 3rd over 1600m on 12 December; should be in the mix with that form.
9	MUSICAL ROSE (IRE)	Seventh over 1200m in maiden company last start but 2nd over 1500m handicap on 21 November; can pose a threat.
7	KURDISTAN'S STORM (FR)	Placed 9th over 1400m in maiden company on 12 December; may play a role here if fit.
2	ALATAU (USA)	Showed speed when 2nd in 800m Barrier Trial on 29 January; one to keep watch.

RACE 7 12:00 AM | AED66,000 | **ABU DHABI** | 1600m

7	LA YETAL (USA)	Second and 3rd in recent 1600m maidens; consistent at the trip and looks the one to beat.
11	ORIGINAL OUTLAW (GB)	Second in handicap company last start and prior maiden placing; should be in the mix.
3	CHEF DE PARTIE (GB)	Third over 1600m in maiden company on 14 December; capable of better, watch closely.
13	QUESTOR (GB)	Third over 1400m in maiden company on 27 December; capable of improvement to place.
8	MIQDAAR (IRE)	Only mid-field finishes in maiden company; deserves another chance, market will be best guide.
