**RACE 1:       BEST TICKET DEALS ONLINE AT LEICESTER-RACECOURSE.CO.UK NOVICE STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 5) (3YO PLUS) (FROM LEICESTER RACE 2)**

**EXACTLY RIGHT - DARK TORNADO - JET PACKER**

Race Preview: EXACTLY RIGHT was well held when introduced at Kempton in December, but looked a transformed character when he returned from a gelding operation to gamely land a novice stakes at Southwell last month. With that experience fresh, the son of Kingman has a decent chance of following up now back at 7f, with the switch to turf not expected to bother him. Dark Tornado was highly tried last year and commands respect debuting for Denis Quinn. Jet Packer and Regal Guest should also be players at this level.

**SHELBOURNE - GINCIDENT - MARLAY PARK**

Race Preview: SHELBOURNE was on the back of a 173-day break when he finished an encouraging fourth at Wolverhampton recently. Unlucky in running on that occasion, George Scott's four-year-old is entitled to be sharper and could be tough to deal with back on turf from the same mark. Gincident is feared most as he takes a drop in class on his debut for a new yard, although Marlay Park is dangerous to rule out from 7lb lower than his last winning rating.

Race Preview: TOURIST narrowly prevailed at Windsor on his final start for Hilal Kobeissi and given that he has gone well fresh previously, a 2lb rise should be no barrier to further success. Now in the care of Robert Cowell, the son of Zoustar has proven himself tactically versatile so should they go a decent gallop, his ability to stay further could be key. The unexposed Miss Show Off and hat-trick seeking Regal Envoy are two others to consider.

Race Preview: KAMEKO SPIRIT has attempted to make every yard of the running but had to settle for second on each of her last two outings, with her latest effort coming in a first-time tongue-tie at Wolverhampton. Provided she can transfer that form to turf, she could prove tough to beat. Elland Road Girl outran her big odds when a respectable fourth at Wolverhampton last month and should go well, while Royal Accord is another to note.

Expecto is also interesting having her first run since leaving Jim Bolger's yard.
