RACE 1: BETWAY SPRINT HANDICAP (CLASS 4) (3YO ONLY) (FROM NEWMARKET RACE 1)

MIGHTY MAGNUS - QUANTUM POWER - PERCY'S STAR

Race Preview: The pace will likely come from Percy's Star, who was an impressive all-the-way winner on his handicap debut at Leicester. He is a definite player off this 8lb higher mark, as is the hat-trick seeking Quantum Power. However, marginal preference is for Michael Dods' class-dropper MIGHTY MAGNUS. The Dark Angel gelding certainly wasn't disgraced in 0-100 company at York last time and won with plenty in hand at this level on his penultimate outing.

WORDS OF TRUTH - ASFOORA - RUMSTAR

Race Preview: Rumstar could make another bold bid having won this last year with Shagraan back in third. Saying that, this looks a tougher renewal with both Asfoora and WORDS OF TRUTH in opposition. The former bounced back with a better effort at Royal Ascot last month, but the latter makes most appeal. Charlie Appleby's tough and consistent three-year-old was having his first start since January when landing a Listed contest over C&D in good style three weeks ago and he looks ready to take on these older sprinters on that evidence.

ARC OLE OLE - MYTHICAL BAY - HARD TO BELIEVE

Race Preview: The fast-improving ARC OLE OLE did well to finish as close as he did in the King George V Stakes at Royal Ascot, considering he was held up in rear and nothing figured from off the pace in that particular race. Dylan Cunha's charge had impressively notched a hat-trick prior to that contest and, with this step up in trip likely to suit, he looks the one to beat. Mythical Bay readily justified skinny odds at Newbury and rates the biggest threat, while Hard To Believe and Lopeo both have decent enough claims.

BEAGLE BAY - INDALO - CLASSIC

Race Preview: Last year's winner Classic is 12lb higher this time having won at Newbury in May, where Indalo was beaten a neck. The latter reversed running when third in the Royal Hunt Cup at Ascot last month and could go close, but the unexposed BEAGLE BAY may edge affairs. Ralph Beckett's charge defied a 9lb rise when successful over C&D on only his second start in a handicap and there looks plenty more to come from the four-year-old. Tribal Chief and Cerulean Bay are others of interest.

TIFFANY - TATTYCORAM - LAVA STREAM

Race Preview: This represents a great opportunity for Sir Mark Prescott's TIFFANY, who placed four times at Group 1 level prior to a narrow comeback defeat in Listed company at Chantilly last month. With the cobwebs blown away, and the potential to improve for a first-time visor, she could prove a tough nut to crack. Tattycoram looks to have improved from three to four years judged on her Goodwood success and is worthy of consideration, as is the dropped-in-trip Lava Stream.

Runner-up in the Juvenile Fillies Turf at the Breeders' Cup last term, Andrew Balding's filly could take the beating back on fast ground. Act Of Kindness finished just ahead of the selection when fourth at York in May and is not out of it. She's preferred to Sacred Ground, who drops in trip on the back of solid efforts over 1m2f in Listed company.

KLASSLEADER - ELSASS - PLAG DE HAVRE

Race Preview: KLASSLEADER leaps off the page here and is difficult to oppose. William Haggas' charge boasts an attractive, unexposed profile and continued his progression when making his seasonal debut at York in May. Versatile in regards to trip and ground, this has probably been the plan since that success on the Knavesmire and there should be more improvement in him off 8lb higher. Elsass is on a steep upward trajectory and also commands respect on the back of a pair of wins at Southwell and Hamilton, while Plage De Havre and Paddy The Squire are others to consider.

GETHIN - CONSTITUTION RIVER - HAWK MOUNTAIN

Race Preview: Not only has Aidan O'Brien taken out the last three renewals of this prestigious contest, he's also landed four of the last five and Dee Stakes winner Constitution River could be a tall order after defeating stable companion Hawk Mountain in the Prix du Jockey Club at Chantilly. It's difficult to envisage a scenario in which the pair aren't closely matched again, but even so, the ante-post market doesn't quite reflect that. Saddadd isn't without a chance because he posted a creditable third in the Tattersalls Gold Cup at the Curragh, though GETHIN could be the play. An impressive winner of the Magnolia at Kempton, he pushed the mighty Ombudsman all the way in the Brigadier Gerard and if taking that form literally, he should go very close to winning this.

Race Preview: ZUBARU has to concede weight all round here but arrives in excellent form having regained the winning thread at Doncaster eight days ago. The stiff finish over this 6f trip should suit George Scott's charge, who gets further, and another bold showing looks assured. Jonny Concrete makes some each-way appeal but the main danger is Distant Rumble, who has been in good nick since switching to turf in the spring.
