RACE 1: WEDDINGS AT WESTERN HOUSE HOTEL MAIDEN STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 4) (3YO PLUS) (FROM AYR RACE 1)

RAILWAYMAN - STONEACRE JOE - MIND OVER MATTER

Race Preview: Having belied his odds of 100/1 when runner-up at Doncaster recently, Stoneacre Joe shouldn't be underestimated. Tim Easterby's charge is heading in the right direction and isn't taken lightly, but RAILWAYMAN may be open to more improvement. The Blue Point colt arrives on the back of a third-placed debut at Leicester and that experience should stand him in good stead. Mind Over Matter could also feature judged on the pick of his form.

Race Preview: CANARIA QUEEN built on her sixth-placed return at Pontefract when landing the spoils in a 14-runner sprint at Doncaster 11 days ago. A 2lb nudge up in the ratings may prove to be lenient and she edges the vote over fellow last-time-out winner Phil's Dream. The Irish raider ran out a ready winner at Wolverhampton in March and merits respect reverting to handicap company. Little Mi Mi and Tommy McJohn are others of interest in an open event.

However, it could be worth taking a punt on C&D winner COCONUT BAY, who has fallen down the ratings and may leave last month's eighth-placed seasonal bow at Catterick behind her. Jkr Cobbler is a feasible alternative.
