**RACE 1: SKY BET RACE TO THE EBOR GRAND CUP STAKES (LISTED) (CLASS 1) (4YO PLUS) (FROM YORK RACE 3)**

**ALSAKIB - ABSURDE - EL CORDOBES**

Race Preview: Absurde kept on well when third to Illinois and Al Qareem over a furlong shorter in the Group 3 Ormonde Stakes at Chester last month and, given he meets the runner-up on better terms, he must have a good chance. ALSAKIB is already a C&D winner after beating Al Qareem here in July last year and, if he improves for his reappearance following a gelding operation when fourth in the Yorkshire Cup, then this race is comfortably within range. El Cordobes is respected too.

**COSI BELLO - BRIZE NORTON - SPIRIT OF FARHH**

Race Preview: Brize Norton showed a big chunk of improvement after being gelded to shed his maiden tag at Kempton last month and needs to be taken seriously on his handicap bow. Spirit Of Farhh is respected after his runner-up effort behind Derby fifth Stanhope Gardens last time, but the vote goes to COSI BELLO. Charlie Fellowes' charge is unbeaten in two starts, justifying short odds under a penalty in good style at Kempton last time. With any amount of improvement to come, he could defy his opening rating of 93.

Race Preview: DOUBLE RUSH is a sprinter on the upgrade and looks worth sticking with. The son of Blue Point won a competitive contest at Newmarket on his handicap debut and a 5lb rise looks fair given both the third and fourth have subsequently won. Marchogion also scored at Newmarket when beating American Style with a bit up his sleeve. He can confirm that form, while Clive Cox has won two of the last three renewals so Doncaster novice winner Fast Track Harry also enters calculations.

Race Preview: Klassleader is a half-brother to Regal Connection and the booking of Ryan Moore catches the eye, so he needs to be monitored in the market on his debut. However, BULL RUN shaped with promise when finishing second on his introduction at Salisbury and could have lots more to offer. Ralph Beckett's three-year-old may put that experience to good use in order to get off the mark. Lancashire is another to watch out for after his debut second at Wolverhampton last November.

Race Preview: STELLAR SUNRISE missed the break at Goodwood on his introduction, but showed plenty of pace to make up the lost ground and finish a creditable second. The son of Space Blues will be a lot wiser today and this flat 6f will suit Andrew Balding's charge. Lyrical Song would likely have finished closer than fifth at Pontefract with a clear run and he could be in the mix, while the newcomers Tactical Formation and Yy Nation should be noted for any significant support.

Southwell winner Prince Of Pillo faced a tough task at York last time and is not easily dismissed at this lower level, but a chance is taken that HYPERFOCUS bounces back to form. Tim Easterby's veteran won this contest off a higher mark in 2024 and looks to have plenty in his favour here.

Handily drawn and with the likelihood of suitable underfoot conditions, the George Boughey-trained four-year-old is an attractive proposition. Obelix, the hat-trick seeking Garden Oasis and Capital Guarantee also hold solid credentials, while Pisanello is another must for the shortlist having won this corresponding race off 7lb higher 12 months ago.
