RACE 1: WILLIAM HILL ROYAL ASCOT EPIC BOOSTS EBF MAIDEN FILLIES' STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 3) (2YO ONLY) (FROM WETHERBY RACE 1)

STARLIGHT MIRAGE - MARCH LILLY - NORTHERN VIOLA

Race Preview: Not a daunting standard set by the pair with experience, so STARLIGHT MIRAGE is taken to make a successful debut. The daughter of Dark Angel is a half-sister to three winners, notably useful miler Sisyphean, and looks to have been found an ideal starting point. In the same ownership, March Lilly makes some appeal and so does Northern Viola, who is from Stradivarius' first crop.

Race Preview: CROSSBAR wasn't the sharpest out of the stalls on his debut at Kempton, but that didn't matter as he came home best of all to record a cosy success. Clive Cox's gelding must concede 3lb to the filly Machadadorp, who stepped forward from her Ascot introduction to win at Chester, but that still might not prevent him from following up. Tago Mago shaped with real promise at Southwell in September and must not be underestimated on her return to action.

Race Preview: A few will fancy their chances, but the vote goes to HEY HAVANA. Geoff Harker's new recruit kept on well for second over 7f at Redcar last month, but he can prove even more effective at the mile and is expected to take another step forward. Oisin Murphy keeps the partnership intact with Thestral following a creditable Lingfield effort, while Supreme Dancer and Thornaby Annie are a couple of others to consider.

Versatile in regards to trip and surface, it's difficult to get away from the in-form six-year-old. Great Blasket was bang there at the finish when third at Nottingham and commands respect, as does Rajapour.

Captain Cess was denied by a short head at Chepstow and should go well on his first appearance for the Declan Carroll team, while Desert Master is also interesting.
