**RACE 1: BRITISH STALLION STUDS EBF FILLIES' NOVICE STAKES (GBB RACE) (CLASS 2) (2YO ONLY) (FROM CARLISLE RACE 1)**

**WILD BLOSSOM - CROWNBREAKER - MISS HAVISHAM**

Race Preview: Crownbreaker is the only contender with experience in the field after her third at Newmarket a few weeks ago and she will be looking to put that to good use. However, WILD BLOSSOM changed hands for 300,000gns at the Craven Breeze-Up sale last month and his dam is a half-sister to Group 1 winner Bayside Boy. The Karl Burke team certainly know how to ready one and she could make an instant impression. Watch the market vibes behind fellow newcomer Miss Havisham, who cost a pretty penny herself.

Race Preview: Blue Lakota only found one too good over this trip at Southwell on his most recent start and should go well, although the obvious concern would be the fact he is 0-6 on turf. Keldeo is a player based on her Catterick success two starts ago, but the one who appeals most is course winner HURT YOU NEVER. Adrian Nicholls' mare showed more when third in this grade at Ripon recently and could capitalise on a 2lb lower figure.

Race Preview: It's hard to get away from the hat-trick seeking RAFT UP, who went in by a neck at Newcastle on his latest outing. Harriet Bethell's gelding continues to go from strength to strength at present and could record his second victory on the grass. Magic Boy signed off his three-year-old campaign with victory over 7f at Redcar in November and has to be respected on his return. Of the remainder, Impressor makes the most appeal.

Race Preview: CASCADE HALL proved to be too tough to overhaul when he made all at Ayr 13 days ago and must have every chance of following up off a still handy mark in comparison to his peak ratings. The hat-trick seeking Charlie Darling has hit a rich vein of form on the all-weather and can also go close if reverting to turf doesn't cause any issues. Swinging London and Ashdown Forest are closely matched based on their recent encounter at Pontefract and are the pick of the rest.

Race Preview: WEZZEER looks progressive enough to cope with a 7lb penalty after readily justifying favouritism at Southwell last month. The son of Sioux Nation, a 280,000gns yearling, is bred to appreciate stepping up in trip and has more to offer. Lunar Melody stepped forward from her introduction over 6f here to fill the runner-up berth in a Doncaster maiden 23 days ago. The Wathnan-owned filly merits close inspection, while Blue Boy Junior is the pick of the rest.

Race Preview: None of these are overly convincing as they all seek an elusive first career win. The likes of Mereside Princess, Smoker Bellamy and Thankfully Simmy have the ability to figure prominently if they are on a going day and warrant consideration. However, slender preference is for COBALT COMET in the hope that his improved effort to finish third at Southwell won't just a flash in the pan and the low-mileage three-year-old can improve further now he switches to turf.

**CONCERT PITCH - FIRE THUNDER - MAY BEE IN PROFIT**

Race Preview: Unless the betting market is strong regarding any of the newcomers, it might be best to focus on those with experience. CONCERT PITCH appeals the most after overcoming a wide draw to finish a close second at Beverley. That was a step forward from his debut run at the same venue and the Brian Ellison-trained colt appears to be on an upwards trajectory. Fire Thunder, May Bee In Profit and Top Cote have all shown enough promise to go on the shortlist.

Race Preview: REGAL ENVOY won a strong renewal of this race 12 months ago and arrives in good enough form to stage a repeat off 3lb lower. The consistent seven-year-old made all at Bath last time and could again be hard to reel in. Adrestia, Democracy Dilemma and All Ways Glamorous are all strong contenders to keep an eye on in the betting, while Gaeli's Italian form has a solid appearance and he is an intriguing option reverting to turf on just his third start for the Marco Botti's yard.

Race Preview: There was plenty to like about the second-placed finish posted by CHIMES OF THUNDER in a novices' event at Haydock last month. The daughter of Night Of Thunder was just a neck behind an unbeaten Coronation Stakes entrant on that occasion and the form looks solid. Plenty of the rest are open to improvement, though and support in the betting for the likes of Tahalel, Withtearsinmyeyes and Trelissick would be dangerous to ignore.

**SANDSCREENDELIVERD - SHAVKAT - AL BAREZ**

Race Preview: SANDSCREENDELIVERD is going to win a race of this nature sooner rather than later judged on recent second-placed finishes at Lingfield and Goodwood. From a low draw on a front-runners track, this could be the time to catch him.
