

RACE 1 11:00 AM | \$32,000 | SEYMOUR | 1429m

14	CUTTIN' CLASS	Still a maiden but surely close to putting that right. Engaged pace when a valiant but vanquished second in the Mdn Plate at Geelong. This looks within his reach.
3	VEINS WITHIN ROCK	Let-up (46-days). Form reasonable. Did little 11 lengths 6th at Cranbourne. Among the dangers.
4	BILLY THE BOSS	On pace but under siege late and weakened out of the fight last outing. Has early speed. Sound claims.
5	THE FLYING POPOV	Raced in back half and never likely when 8 lengths 6th at Geelong. Has claims.
1	CHAINSAW	Battled home here at second run back. Has an adverse draw. Rough place prospect.

RACE 2 11:30 AM | \$32,000 | SEYMOUR | 1429m

3	ABRAFO	Resuming (21-weeks). Decent alley. Makes strong appeal fresh in this affair.
6	SUNBURNT COUNTRY	First-up (23-weeks). Third outing for new trainer/ this region. Can be thereabouts.
2	PICK A SYMPHONY	Third run now in new stable/region. Knocking on the door. Landed handy, unable to go with winner but ran on for the minor spoils at Pakenham in Maiden company. Makes a strong case in this company.
8	SHARE THE PENNIES	Came from well back to place in a 1312m Maiden at Geelong when off an extended spell. Will be fitter second-up. Can make her presence felt.
1	COVERED IN CASH	Been thereabouts. Sent out \$6.50 when laboured to finish 4th at Cranbourne. Good draw. Among the dangers.

RACE 3 12:00 PM | \$32,000 | SEYMOUR | 2246m

5	BOY FROM OZ	Posted some decent efforts from three appearances. Reserved at rear, late into the frame at Stony Creek last start. Highly rated in this line-up.
11	ZAEEMAH	Form reasonable. On pace but folded up quickly at Wagga at first run for new trainer. Will be fitter second-up. Among the dangers.
1	ALL THE MOVES	No threat to winner but ran on for the minors at Wangaratta. Should appreciate stepping up in distance. Makes strong appeal.
4	SAXON BLOOD	Not disgraced at Moe. Hard fit and can challenge.
6	KING KAUFFO	Settled back and didn't figure in the 3yo+ Mdn Plate at Wangaratta. Rise to 2246m a new challenge. Has claims.

RACE 4 12:30 PM | \$27,000 | SEYMOUR | 2246m

12	VELLASGLORY	Too strong 3yo+ Mdn Plate at Stony Creek. B Rawiller retains the ride. Highly rated in this line-up.
5	SINHALESE	Broke maiden at Yarra Glen 29 Dec. Well back and never a factor at Sandown-Hillside in second run from spell. First try at 2246m. Usually gets back.
9	FLASH OF DALLAS	Wodonga winner two back. Had all before her at turn and went home tamely at Sandown-Hillside. Can make her presence felt.
11	DONEGAL SOUL	Honest battler. Knuckled down for third here. First try at 2246m. Can play a role.
3	COMPOSTELA	Dropped out to last and never sighted at Wangaratta. Stamina on trial here. Form points elsewhere.

RACE 5 1:00 PM | \$22,000 | SEYMOUR | 1600m

9	ALGADON STORM	Battled home at Cranbourne at last start this journey. Drawn favourably. Worth a look.
2	ELEANOR DUMONT	Now 4 weeks between runs. Broke maiden at Warrnambool 11 Nov. Edged out late after making the pace at Terang at this trip when in the market. Claiming apprentice engaged again.
12	KHANT BEE	Resuming (27-weeks). Just missed at Casterton 29 Jun. Has run well fresh. Highly fancied for a winning return.
7	IL CIELO	Last at turn, ran on late at Pakenham at second run back. Ready to peak third-up. Right in the mix.
3	OCTANE REIGN	Led and held sway to win here over this trip. Winner at only other start at Seymour. Minor money hope at best.

RACE 6 1:30 PM | \$27,000 | SEYMOUR | 1429m

10	ZENACITY	Honest battler. Won a 1200m Benchmark 56 at Echuca two back. Decent effort in the small field at Cranbourne. Rates highly.
11	PHOEBE BUFFAY	Only better for two Aust runs. Fought bravely to the wire 1.3 lengths second (Bm56) at Werribee at second run back. Drawn to receive every chance and a nice weight drop. Can play a role.
1	SOUND OF JURA	Resuming (19-weeks). Has performed well previously first-up without winning but wasn't pushed out in latest trial. Not out of this.
14	KANSHERUN	Resuming (36-weeks). Cleared maiden ranks at Kilmore 5 May. Has claims.
6	CASHOUT	On pace and toughed in out well for 0.4 lengths len Maiden win at Geelong. Has a tricky draw to contend with this time. Each-way.

RACE 7 2:00 PM | \$22,000 | SEYMOUR | 1100m

9	APPLEBY	Fresh. She rarely wins, but is always well-placed in Bm56 grade. 1100 may be a bit short however. Each-way.
13	MR MARKLE	Let-up (51-days). Let down strongly into the placings in Bm56 company off a break. Suited at Seymour.
11	SHAME ON SUE	Freshened. Honest mare, and just pipped last two runs. Challenge here is the awkward gate. Include.
7	RED LINE FEVER	Resuming (26-weeks). Trialled well, gets the tongue tie, and is at pet distance. Forward showing likely.
3	DAMAS	4 weeks since last run. Last two a bit disappointing. Nice recent jump out, so give another chance.
