

RACE 1 12:00 PM | \$32,000 | WARRNAMBOOL | 2000m

6	THE SMASH FACTOR	No match but kept on for a distant third in the 3yo+ Mdn Plate here over this trip. Sticking to this trip a positive. This looks within his reach.
4	NICOFFHOME	Last couple encouraging. Just missed at Benalla Sep 2. Outgunned but did enough for second at \$61 this track over this trip. Capable of playing a key role in this.
8	HIGH HEELED	Kicks off second campaign (16-weeks). First run this region for new stable. Betting watch advised at first run for new trainer.

8	COSMOS FACTORY	On a quick back-up. Capable stayer. Finished it off well in the 3yo+ Hcp (56) at Coleraine. Rates highly.
6	CHEROKEE BRAVE	First two had his measure but did enough to claim third at Echuca. Has claims.
1	IDON'TGETIT	Got back when beat tired horses home for 8.5 lengths 5th this track. Experienced rider replaces apprentice. Could get into the placings.

RACE 3 1:00 PM | \$32,000 | WARRNAMBOOL | 1400m

15	SO LONG AGO	Unplaced but she has shown enough on occasions. In touch but couldn't find anything when pressured finishing 4.2 lengths 7th at Geelong. Among the dangers.
9	SHAYKHLISLAMOVA	Prominent and showed plenty of ticker in rain affected going to just go under in thrilling finish in the 3yo+ Mdn Plate at Mt Gambier at resumption. Fitter second-up. Can make her presence felt.
12	HARMONY	Trials (1:0-0-1). By Ten-time Group One winner So You Think and from Canny Lad mare Small Minds. Tidy trial performance Colac. Jarrod Fry sticks for debut. Looks a forward type.
11	DANZSIN	Raced in back half and was never in a position to mount a serious challenge at Sandown-Hillside. Highly rated in this line-up.
8	LISA LASS	Placed two of her three career outings at this level. Okay at latest when settled back. Sound claims.

RACE 4 1:30 PM | \$32,000 | WARRNAMBOOL | 1200m

11	STAR COMPASS	Indicated early potential. Raced on the pace and went down in a thrilling stoush at Hamilton. Placed in Maiden company at Terang second-up last campaign. Makes strong appeal.
13	QUEEN CHRISTINE	Patently handled and wasn't beaten far at Ballarat on debut. Fancy the extra trip will suit. Key player.
3	GINA'S A STAR	Prominent and went down fighting in soft going in the Maiden company at Seymour second-up. Improver, fitter third-up. Form good enough for this.
10	SHADES OF STARDOM	Set for second campaign (22-weeks). Likely to have benefitted from the spell. Slotted mid-field and was safely held at bay on debut this venue when in the market Apr 30. Home track advantage but has an adverse draw. Rough place prospect fresh in this line
4	PARCHMENT	Form to date sound. On pace but failed to run a drum at Hamilton when in the market. Switching to 1200m. Since trialled at Colac Sep 23.

RACE 5 2:00 PM | \$32,000 | **WARRNAMBOOL** | 1000m

10	BIG VEE	Trials (1:0-0-0). Prepared with a 800m barrier trial at Terang on Apr 14. John Allen sticks from latest trial. Gets a soft draw for first assignment.
4	THE DEFENDER	Given time to freshen up after 1st-up run. Form to date sound. Produced a searching finish into the minors at Warracknabeal at resumption. Decent alley.
12	PIKLEMEGRANMOTHER	Will have gained valuable experience by debut placing at Mt Gambier in rain affected going when blew like a gale in the betting. Warrants attention.
11	SOVIET STRIKE	Trials (1:0-0-0). Barrier trialed over 1000m at Colac on Sep 23. Fred W Kersley sticks from latest trial. Betting may tell the tale.
2	HOLLOW TURF	Fresh. Positive ride but emptied late at Warracknabeal. On pacer. Highly rated in this line-up.

5	LAVANDULA	Resuming (24-weeks). Among the dangers fresh in this line-up.
1	A GOOD YARN	Seasoned performer. Wasn't beaten far here over this distance. Can show early speed. Makes a strong case in this company.
7	BRASH LASS	Broke maiden at Seymour Aug 31. Just shaded for the minors after making the speed this venue over this distance as an odds drifter. Leader. Has claims.
3	MISS TOP GUN	First-up (26-weeks). Broke her maiden at Great Western last campaign. Can lead or take a sit. Makes strong appeal fresh in this affair.
2	MR TICKLES	Solid performer. Terrific effort when just shaded in rain affected going at Moe Sep 23. At optimum distance. Can play a role.

RACE 7 3:00 PM | \$22,000 | **WARRNAMBOOL** | 1300m

7	TEARS ARE FLOWING	Early pace was too much for her and weakened into 4th at Geelong. Wet form - soft (1:1-0-0); untested heavy. Form good enough for this.
9	SYMPHONITE	Broke maiden at Warracknabeal Aug 30. Courageous when defeated 1.5 lengths second 3yo+ (Bm62) this venue over this distance. Can play a role.
5	SACRED FORT	Ridden in back half, strong late to fill the minors on a soft deck 3yo+ (Bm56) at Hamilton. Has wet form. Nice gate. This looks very winnable.
16	RIPPA BUDDY	Let-up (68-days). Honest competitor. Up on the pace early and kept on courageously for second in the Hwt (58) at Casterton over a longer assignment. On pacer.
2	MASKED MARAUDER	Won (Bm64) Benchmark 64 Warrnambool Aug 21. Comfortably beaten in the slop at Bendigo in second run from spell. Since trialed at Colac Sep 23. Drawn to get a conservative run and gets 3kg off for Rose Hammond.

RACE 8 3:30 PM | \$22,000 | **WARRNAMBOOL** | 1700m

14	VEGAS ON FIRE	Reasonably consistent. Went close at Wodonga two back. Strode forward off wide gate, fought on bravely to just miss in rain affected going at Moe. Can control the race.
2	BLAZING GURU	Prominent and fought on determinedly to win 3yo+ (Bm56) on a soft deck at Hamilton. Well placed for repeat.
12	COOL STAR	Resuming (18-weeks). Can run a drum fresh in this company.
4	MORE TORQUE	Now 4 weeks between runs. Not disgraced in the slosh at Seymour over a longer test. Could give some cheek at odds.
10	COASTAL WHISPERS	Went close at Casterton two back. Led from pillar to post in the small field this track over a longer assignment. Won only other time at Warrnambool. Since trialed at Colac Sep 23.

RACE 9 4:15 PM | \$60,000 | MOONEE VALLEY | 1200m

2	CABRIOLE	Kicks off second campaign (16-weeks). First run this region for new stable. Recent trial winner. Better for his encouraging 1.9 lengths third at Canterbury at first race appearance.
1	AYE VEE AITCH	Returns for second campaign (26-weeks). Will have matured over the break. Can build on that foundation. Big watch.
4	CASUAL GHAI	Been supported at each run. Not disgraced at Mornington at resumption. Strips fitter second run back. Worth a look.
8	ST EDWARD	Bold debut effort when just shaded by winner at Mornington Sep 18 at \$5. Will be improved. Drawn to receive every chance. Right in the mix.
10	WYANDRA	Will have derived experience from his only other run at Wodonga when in the market Sep 16. Rough place prospect.

8	MISS DECEIVER	Improved by tidy debut performance at Geelong Sep 12. Good gate. Warrants attention.
5	JUSTIBELLA	Justify filly heading to the races without a public trial. Look to betting for a further guide.
6	LA REINE	Returns for second campaign (33-weeks). Will have matured over the break. Ex S P Nichols in Victoria. Market watch advised in first run for new stable.

5	OMAMORI	Striving for hat-trick. Pushed forward and found enough to score as a \$2.40 chance. Fancy the extra trip will suit and under less weight. Form good enough for this.
2	KARBURAN	Made all, no answer to winner but showed enough fight to secure third in the 3yo+ (Bm70) at Flemington. Up in distance and hope if speed on. Has early speed. Rates highly.
1	HIGHLAND BLING	Sat behind speed and was strongest late at Flemington second-up. Fancy the extra trip will suit. Can add to tally.
6	THURMOND	Won 3yo+ (Bm62) Benchmark 62 Bendigo Sep 7. Did little 10.5 lengths 6th at Flemington when in the market. First try at 3000m. Has a few runs under his belt this campaign and can challenge.
8	JENNY THE BEAVER	Gave a good sight in rain affected ground making the frame at Warrnambool when in the market. Stats are good this course. Senior rider takes over. Has claims.

RACE 12 5:45 PM | \$60,000 | MOONEE VALLEY | 1000m

5	TREMLES	Upside looks high. On pace and toughed in out well for 0.5 lengths len Benchmark 66 win at Bendigo. Good gate. Well placed for repeat.
3	STOKKE	Short course specialist. Made short work of the small field in the 3yo+ F&M (Bm70) at Sandown-Hillside first up. Will be fitter second-up. Makes a strong case in this company.
7	BINE	Off pace, hit line forcefully to place second at Bendigo. Strips fitter second run back and takes a 2kg claim. Warrants attention.
11	UNDER MY THUMB	Resuming (21-weeks). Consistent first-up form. Breaks from a low barrier and under less weight. Can play a role.
4	RICH DOTTIE	Started \$9 when safely held in Benchmark 78 company at Flemington when off an extended spell. Winner at track and distance. Fitter second-up. Can challenge.

RACE 13 6:15 PM | \$60,000 | MOONEE VALLEY | 955m

8	ONE HARD LADY	Back to the track for second campaign (16-weeks). Form sound last campaign. Just missed at Flemington May 17. Won at at Albury when fresh last campaign.
9	SALUTED	Went close at Sandown-Hillside two back. Tame to line in small field at Sandown-Hillside. Won only other time at Moonee Valley. Makes strong appeal.
5	TARPAULIN	Not disgraced in 3yo+ (Bm78) at Flemington at first run for new trainer at \$21. Key player.
1	CALL TO GLORY	Made the pace but got a stitch late 3yo+ (Bm78) at Flemington. Has early speed. Could give some cheek at odds.
10	DAPPER DARRI	Very tame performance at Flemington. Can improve to feature.

1	LINCOLN ROCKS	Trailed speed, kept coming but winner too strong this venue in second run from spell. Ready to peak third-up. Makes a strong case in this company.
2	I AM THE EMPIRE	On a quick back-up. Settled off pace, rallied well but couldn't match winner at Benalla. Hard fit and warrants attention.
8	MORRISSETTE	Ran on soundly into second in the small field at Flemington. Rates highly.
11	MY ROCA FELLA	Started \$6 when handily placed and showed fine turn of foot to register a 1.5 lengths win at Mornington. Can add to tally.
9	KOKORO	Finished in hot pursuit at Flemington. Has claims.

RACE 15 7:15 PM | \$60,000 | MOONEE VALLEY | 1600m

10	NAINA	Kept coming and just fell short at Ballarat first up. Strips fitter second run back. This looks very winnable.
9	FINALE	Midfield, great effort running into second 3yo+ (Bm62) at Mornington. Warrants attention.
3	COMPRESSING	Back to the track for second campaign (21-weeks). Has stakes form. Did a terrific job in his first campaign. Needs the breaks this time.
5	OUR WISHBONE	Settled close, couldn't match winner but ran on for third at Bendigo. First try at 1600m. Gets the gun run. Among the dangers.
1	EMPHASIZE	Freshened. Not disgraced in 3yo+ (Bm70) at Sandown-Hillside in second run from spell at \$9. Fitter for those two runs and ready to show best. Has claims.

RACE 16 7:45 PM | \$60,000 | MOONEE VALLEY | 1200m

10	SUN SETTING	Highly progressive winning 3 from 10. Valiant but vanquished second in the 3yo+ (Bm70) down the Flemington straight Sep 21. Has a few runs under her belt this campaign and worth a look.
14	MERCURIAL LADY	Let-up (83-days). Saluted at Geelong first-up last time in. Leads, handy. Form good enough for this.
9	ENNA'S DREAM	Put in some big strides late to place at Sandown-Hillside when in the market. Good draw. Among the dangers.
11	BALASTIER	Steps out for third run new stable/region. Lining up for three wins on the trot. Made the running and slipped away to win with authority at Bendigo Sep 7 at \$2.20. Draws to do no work.
6	PER SEMPRE	Short course specialist. Reeled in leaders to salute at Flemington. Ratings lift after that win but stays under strong notice at same level.
