

RACE 1 7:45 AM | \$240,000 | **FLEMINGTON** | 1000m

12	SALUKI	Blue Point filly heading to the races without a public trial. Locally trained. Look to betting for a further guide.
7	TALES OF TIME	By Pinatubo and making debut without an official trial. Big watch on debut.
13	SIMPLY STEFFI	Unraced 2yo by Graff and out of the Fastnet Rock mare Casquets. Bears close watching.
5	DIAMETER	Introducing a colt by Brazen Beau and out of the Street Cry mare Circular. No public trial form. Trained here. Market may prove best guide to expectations.
8	FREE FLYING	Promising debut 0.5 length second at Caulfield Oct 15 when in the market. Subject to improvement. Can run a drum.

RACE 2 8:20 AM | \$150,000 | **FLEMINGTON** | 2000m

3	MAKDANE	Ready to win. Close up when placed in similar races last couple and from inside gate must include.
4	NAVY KING	Chimed in at right time for brave Hamilton Cup win last start. He can go on with it here.
8	JAYKAYANN	Failed to threaten at Caulfield over this trip. Form points elsewhere.
19	QUELLO DORATO	Raced on speed and held minor spot at Geelong last start. This no easier.
10	PARTY CRASHER	On pace but failed to run a drum at Murray Bridgeat first run back when in the market. Will be fitter second-up.

RACE 3 9:00 AM | \$200,000 | **FLEMINGTON** | 1800m

9	ARABIAN PRINCE	Snagged back and last at 400m before letting down late to just miss the minors 1.2 lengths 6th at Caulfield last start. Switching to 1800m. Worth a look.
3	CHAMPAGNE HERO	Stationed midfield and never landed a blow at Randwick Oct 25. Drops to shorter trip. Each-way.
2	OBVIOUS	Broke maiden at Bendigo Sep 17. Left in winner's wake but trudged home for the minors at Caulfield. Can make his presence felt.
7	AITU	Gave solid kick from handy position and fought on well to triumph at Pakenham at second run back. Can play a role.
8	SNITZ SONIC	Wore them down late at Echuca at his second race start. Rough place prospect.

RACE 4 9:40 AM | \$150,000 | **FLEMINGTON** | 1000m

4	STREET ARTIST	4 weeks since last run. Bolted in at Mornington two back. Gutsy on-pace performance taking out the 3yo (Bm64) at Bendigo. Speedy and a nice weight drop.
7	TEMPT THE GODS	First-up (16-weeks). Has performed well previously first-up without winning. First time down Flemington straight. Could surprise.
2	PALLATON	Has decent Stakes form. Midfield, let down intently into the placings at Randwick. Drops to shorter trip. Makes strong appeal.
6	BLETHYN	Midfield, picked up solidly for 1.4 lengths 4th at Moonee Valley at resumption. Strips fitter second run back. Only for wider exotics.
10	VANGOGH BANKCHEQUE	Rearward and showcased his talent by running out an impressive 1.3 lengths debut winner at Echuca, Oct 20. Tackling stronger line-up.

RACE 5 10:20 AM | \$250,000 | FLEMINGTON | 2800m

10	GOLDEN CENTURY	Put in a long run from the back for third in a Benchmark 84 at Caulfield. Rise to 2800m a new challenge. Can make his presence felt.
1	CLEVELAND	Last at turn, ran on late at Moonee Valley. First time around Flemington. Looks vulnerable. Not out of this.
14	FERAGO	Not disgraced in choppy conditions at Geelong. Usually gets back. Fit from racing and one for exotics.
9	LITZDEEL	Terrific effort when just shaded at Caulfield Oct 15. Has claims.
15	HAALAND	Shooting for hat-trick. Just got the nod in at Geelong. Unexposed at trip. Nicely weighted.

RACE 6 10:55 AM | \$200,000 | FLEMINGTON | 1800m

6	ATHANATOS	Wasn't beaten far at Caulfield. Up in trip and hope off a strong tempo. Can challenge.
4	MAJOR BEEL	On pace but folded up quickly at Randwick first up. Fitter second-up. Has early speed. Can play a role.
2	APULIA	Close placing in the Melbourne Cup Day Plate at Flemington. Let down with a raking drive to get up in final bounds at Moonee Valley when off an extended spell. Fitter second-up. Can be thereabouts.
5	SAINT GEORGE	Came home with a wet sail to grab second Seymour Cup at Seymour when off an extended spell at odds of \$13. Fitter second-up. Sound claims.
1	UNSPOKEN	Freshened after resuming from a break. Off the speed, picked up soundly and wasn't beaten far at Rosehill at resumption. Since trialled at Warwick Farm Oct 17. Rough place prospect.

RACE 7 12:00 PM | \$10,000,000 | FLEMINGTON | 3200m

1	AL RIFFA	Let-up (51-days). Multiple G1 winning International runner. Solid 62kg winner at Ireland - Curragh Jul 19. Has his first look at 3200m here. In the mix.
6	PRESAGE NOCTURNE	Third run now in new stable/region. Warmed up nicely late at Caulfield at second run back when a noted market drifter.
14	HALF YOURS	Knuckled down well from midfield to salute at Caulfield. Rise to 3200m a new challenge.
2	BUCKAROO	Terrific effort when just shaded at Moonee Valley Oct 25. Take beating.
17	FURTHUR	Let-up (52-days). Stakes winning stayer- International. First try at 3200m. Consider.

RACE 8 12:50 PM | \$200,000 | FLEMINGTON | 1400m

2	NAVY PILOT	Sandown-Hillside winner two back. Just wacked away without threatening over 1600m Caulfield Guineas at Caulfield. A distance specialist. Could get into the placings.
5	VEGA FOR LUCK	Let-up (45-days). Went down narrowly in the small field at Caulfield at this distance. New to Flemington. Only for wider exotics.
1	HIDDEN ACHIEVEMENT	Let-up (52-days). Ridden back and never a factor at Rosehill first up. Since trialled at Randwick Oct 20. Rates a risky proposition.
3	GRAND PRAIRIE	Let-up (52-days). Rosehill winner two back. Trimmed margin late at Rosehill at this trip. Since trialled at Rosehill Oct 24.
15	LUDLUM	Just missed at Ballarat Sep 19. Made short work of the small field in the 3yo Mdn Plate at Seymour at his second race start. Jordan Childs retains the ride. Minor money hope at best.

RACE 9 1:35 PM | \$240,000 | FLEMINGTON | 1400m

7	ELECTRIC IMPULSE	Resuming (48-weeks). Won the MCC Country Final Flemington Nov 7. Has performed well previously first-up without winning. Rough place prospect fresh in this line-up.
10	GUMDROPS	Went close at Gold Coast two back. Couldn't quite peg back winner at Caulfield. Can play a role.
11	KEEP YOUR COOL	Trailed pace and ran on gamely at Caulfield. At optimum distance. Experienced rider replaces apprentice. Can run a drum.
15	SURFIN' BIRD	In stellar form. Streeted them at Caulfield. Take beating again.
18	KIRRIBILLI	Lightly raced 4yo. Just got the nod in at Pakenham second-up. Tackling stronger company.

RACE 10 2:15 PM | \$150,000 | FLEMINGTON | 1400m

7	SUNSHINEINMYPOCKET	Went close at Moonee Valley two back. Brave in defeat 1 length third 3yo+ (Bm84) at Caulfield at second run back. At optimum distance. Experienced rider replaces apprentice.
12	PERSIAN SPIRIT	Snagged back and worked home okay in 3yo+ (Bm84) at Geelong. Rough place prospect.
5	COTEHELE	Last win was May 20 2023. Ran on fairly from back half at Gawler. First time around Flemington. Hard to warm to.
18	TEN COMMANDMENTS	Went home tamely at Moonee Valley at \$51. This isn't easy. Place.
8	SABAJ	Raced well in Stakes company. Not disgraced in Silver Eagle at Randwick at first run for new trainer at \$4.80. Strips fitter second run back. Highly rated in this line-up.

RACE 11 2:38 PM | \$30,000 | ASCOT | 1800m

6	MONTY ZOOMER	Dictated terms in recording a gritty 0.4 lengths win at Kalgoorlie. Trip unknown, but include with W Pike.
8	KNOCKONEBACK	Looked likely but just missed at Northam. Has form this track and distance. Each-way.
3	GRANDAD'S ADICTION	Kept coming to place third at Belmont Park. Not sure about the trip. Place hope.
1	SAULOK	Went close at Northam two back. Then went home tamely this venue at \$18. Can bounce back.
5	ALMAYA	Fought on well to triumph this track over this distance. Bit harder here but chance if he holds.

RACE 12 3:15 PM | \$30,000 | ASCOT | 1200m

9	SAVAGE DANCER	Hit line with a full head of steam at Belmont. Jumps from better barrier. This looks very winnable.
10	HARD SOLO	Easy kill at Geraldton Oct 12, then outclassed last start. With C Parnham on is a wildcard here.
3	ALASKALOT	Resuming after a (138-weeks) spell. Ex Joshua Krispyn. Recent trial win suggests he's ready to go.
7	DUBAI'S DAUGHTER	Just missed at Kalgoorlie Oct 2, and same again in town when led up. Chance if she can overcome gate.
1	AWESOME BOY	Resuming (20-weeks). Form sound last campaign including a 1st-up win. Makes own luck on pace.

RACE 13 3:50 PM | \$30,000 | ASCOT | 1400m

5	STRAPPING PROPHET	Now 5 weeks between runs. Lightly-raced 4yo with upside. 1400m is perfect. Must include.
8	LADIES PRO	Made immediate impact with a convincing win at Belmont Park. No reason she can't go on with it.
1	TOO MUCH TALK	Only battled home at Northam under the big weight. Can go better here with the claim & sweet draw.
2	MANJERI	On target for hat-trick. Needs luck from the outside pole, but has a winning attitude.
4	HEWILLDOUS	Gave a fair account at Geraldton in 2nd run from spell. Hard here, so minor claims look best.

RACE 14 4:30 PM | \$125,000 | ASCOT | 1400m

6	ZOURUN RUN	Early form good. Nice opener in the Belgravia. Can go on with it over better trip.
1	TALKANCO	Carries the penalty but she's earned it. Can sit closer from gate, and bounce back.
2	PLAYIN'IT SWEET	Consummate professional. Ran home well when soft in betting. Good hope with some luck.
5	FINE STAR	Beautifully handled by the trainer to build confidence. Harder here but not knocking.
11	KAZANA	Made immediate impact with a convincing win at Northam. Tackling stronger line-up.

RACE 15 5:10 PM | \$30,000 | ASCOT | 1600m

5	DOMINATUS	Responded well from back half to get the prize at Northam. Looking for this trip now. Can win again.
4	REEL SERENITY	Picked up strongly from back half to fill the minors at Belmont. May have improved over spell. Each-way.
2	ACROSS GENERATIONS	Close-up of late. Narrow miss in the Hcp (C1) this track Oct 15. Ready to show best now 3rd-up.
3	MISS VEUVE	Closed with raking strides for second Hcp (C1) at Northam over this distance. Makes strong appeal.
7	BATTLE FLEET	Average at this venue at second run back. Only for wider exotics.
