

RACE 1 11:00 AM | \$27,000 | MORNINGTON | 1200m

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| 6 | MEDIEVAL WARRIOR | Freshened. Fair effort without threatening at Sandown-Lakeside on debut. Recent jumpout winner and gets blinkers on. Key player. |
| 5 | MASTER ZOUS | \$70k Inglis Classic yearling. First and third in recent Pakenham jumpouts. Among the better chances on debut. |
| 12 | SWOBODA | Wide and little hope at Warrnambool at latest. A softer run has her competitive here. |
| 10 | MORGANA | Prominent but no match for winner last time out. Drawn to effect. Can give some cheek from the front. |
| 2 | HEIWANA TAMASHI | Resuming. Formerly with R E Laing. Moderate debut and but unlucky not to have won all three jumpouts ahead of resumption. Tricky draw but can improve. |

RACE 2 11:30 AM | \$27,000 | MORNINGTON | 1000m

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| 6 | TREMBLES | Resumes from long spell. Out of a Blue Diamond winner and started \$3 in a Listed race on debut. Jumped out well for this. Clear top pick. |
| 3 | CARTIER ISLAND | Trials: (1:0-0-0). \$1750 Inglis Digital purchase. Has jumped out well ahead of debut and drawn well. Anticipating a positive showing on debut. |
| 1 | CENTRAL BANK | Led and only nailed late last outing. Favourable racing pattern but is starting to become costly for punters. Should be thereabouts again. |
| 5 | STAHNADO | Beaten by a few smart gallopers and margin unfair at Pakenham first-up. Fitter and back to the home track. Knockout chance. |
| 2 | RUBY AVENUE | Resuming. Previously trained by Ms S Ferchie. Safely held at both runs to date but has run second and first in recent jumpouts. Market the best guide. |

RACE 3 12:00 PM | \$27,000 | MORNINGTON | 2040m

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| 7 | AMANOAH | Handy and boxed on fairly to fill the minors at short odds at Moe last outing. Strong SP profile and blinkers go on. Needs to put her hand up here. |
| 3 | MR BANNOCK | Capable type. Went to line only fairly at Ballarat last start. Ready for this trip now and drawn a good gate. Strong claims. |
| 9 | DIBABA | Couldn't show a turn of foot at Sale last start. Returns to the home track and drawn a good gate. One for multiples. |
| 8 | CHAUSSETTE | Lacked a pick-up and only plugged to line here last start. Place best. |
| 10 | FLASH OF DALLAS | Closed intently to just miss at Geelong first-up. Strips fitter. Looks one of the main chances. |

RACE 4 12:30 PM | \$27,000 | MORNINGTON | 1200m

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| 9 | MOHEGAN GODDESS | Resuming. Trialled and jumped out well for return. Tricky gate but the one to beat. |
| 3 | HEEZ DE MAN | Third and fourth in recent jumpouts. Assess on her jumpout two back and he can put in a forward showing on debut. |
| 4 | OLIVE BAGUETTE | Capable type. Failed to threaten in initial campaign but indicated improvement at first run back. Fitter and drawn a decent alley. Can play a key role. |
| 2 | EL CALAFATE | Will be fitter for her first-up run. Awkwardly drawn. Blinkers will need to spark some improvement. |
| 5 | SMARTICON | Freshened. Wasn't all that far away at Seymour last outing. One of the major players on the home track. |

RACE 5 1:00 PM | \$27,000 | **MORNINGTON** | 1200m

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| 3 | SECOND FIX | Back to country level after starting favourite in Adelaide last start. Strong claims. |
| 2 | WARPARTY | First-up. 3YO who takes on the older horses. Jumped out well ahead of return and has come up with a good gate. Must be considered. |
| 4 | SOUTHERN MONEY | Fair effort without threatening at Sandown-Lakeside last start. Drawn favourably. Back to country level. Consider. |
| 5 | VERSAILLE | Coming off an average run in the wet in Saturday grade at Moonee Valley last start. Place hope. |
| 1 | TOO VIENNESE | Freshened. Coming off an average run this level at Sale first-up. One for multiples. |

RACE 6 1:30 PM | \$27,000 | **MORNINGTON** | 1500m

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| 6 | WOMEN IN UNIFORM | Second but good gap back to third here at latest. Has a good record at this track. Among the better chances. |
| 7 | MORISA | Ran home respectably here at latest. Fitter and has scope to improve. Big danger. |
| 2 | WILLIAMSTOWN | Freshened. Battled on fairly at Caulfield Heath at latest. Has raced well this track previously and has drawn a nice gate. Among the better chances. |
| 1 | UNFAIR DISMISSAL | Seasoned campaigner. No match for winner but kept boxing away to to place here last outing. Place preferred. |
| 3 | CUDMORE STREET | Freshened. Impressive win at Sale last outing. Needs to step up a level again but is lightly raced. |

| 8 | MYSTERY BLONDE | Ran home respectably at Sale last outing. Worth some thought. |
| 2 | MELIDESH | Freshened. Found line well to place at Kerang last start. 2kg claimer engaged. Rates highly. |
| 1 | CONDOR | Closed intently to just miss at Bendigo last time out. 2kg claimer engaged. In the mix. |

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| 2 | WEST INDIES | 3YO who started \$5 in the listed St Ledger last start. Form prior more than competitive enough for this. |
| 1 | GIFT OF ORATORY | Commanding all-the-way winner in similar class at Bendigo last time out. One of the major players. |
| 5 | EYE FOR AN EYE | Just behind the placegetters during the Warrnambool carnival last start. Has upside. |
| 9 | TAVINO BAY | Wasn't all that far away here last outing. Senior jockey takes over and can improve. |
| 4 | LUNAR POWERED | Impressive win at Moe first-up. Strips fitter and is an each-way hope. |
