

RACE 1 11:20 AM | \$32,000 | KILMORE | 1100m

1	HIGH ON THE HILL	Set for second campaign (38-weeks). Likely to have benefitted from the spell. Better for his encouraging 1.3 lengths 4th at Sandown-Hillside at first race appearance. Back in a country Maiden. Makes strong appeal fresh in this line-up.
5	WATTEN ASSETT	Still a maiden but surely close to putting that right. Just missed at Echuca 31 Dec. Terrific effort when just shaded at Wangaratta 18 Jan. This looks a nice race for the colt.
4	VORONYA	Safely contained at Pakenham on debut when in the market 29 Jan. Better for race experience. Has scope.
7	KADESH	Posted some decent efforts from three appearances. handily placed and gave her all running on for third at Kyneton when in the market. Worth a look.
6	GLAMOUR MODEL	Been supported at each run. Couldn't match winner but held on for third at Pakenham in only her second race appearance. Scope for improvement. Can make her presence felt.

RACE 2 11:55 AM | \$32,000 | KILMORE | 1200m

8	DAMA ROYALE	Form reads well for this. No match but still very brave in defeat in 3yo Mdn Plate over 1000 at Cranbourne at her second race start. Fancy the extra trip will suit. Fitter, has scope to progress.
5	RACEY CASEY	Got the wobbles late after leading at Sandown-Hillside. Gets the gun run. Can play a role.
14	WILD ROSES GROW	Ran on late from the back at Sandown-Hillside second-up. Can fill the minors here.
3	HATALOOK	Okay at latest when settled back. Has an adverse draw. Minor money hope at best.

2 FLASH ALICE Returns for second campaign (22-weeks). Been thereabouts. Brought on with two trial hitouts. Among the dangers fresh in this line-up.

2	NEVERENOUGHLEGO	Let-up (61-days). In the market all runs. Narrow miss in the 3yo+ Mdn Plate at Tatura 14 Dec. Breaks from a low barrier.
8	SHARE THE STARS	Wins are proving elusive but does look well placed. No match but kept on for a distant third in the 3,4,5yo Mdn Plate at Cranbourne in second run from spell. Should appreciate stepping up in distance. Improver, fitter third-up.
7	DAISY DUCK	Not disgraced in 3yo+ Mdn Plate at Sandown-Hillside at first run off a long break at \$14. Expect a much stronger performance here.
1	CRESPIANO	Let-up (68-days). In the placings two of three runs to date. Finished well down the track in Mdn Plate at Stony Creek last outing. Good gate speed, soft draw.
12	IMMORTAL JUSTICE	No answer when first two cleared out but ran on bravely for third in the 4yo+ Mdn Plate at Great Western. On pacer. Rough place prospect.

1	ELVIS	Solid performer. Pushed forward and fought on solidly for third 3yo+ Hcp (56). Breaks from a low barrier. Highly rated in this line-up.
13	THEO FIVE	Just wacked away without threatening over 1300m Trophy Race at Yea at first run for new trainer. Right down in the weights. Back from picnics.
4	VERY GRATEFUL	Started \$7.50 when safely held in Restricted 56 company at Kyneton at resumption. Strips fitter second run back and takes a 1.5kg claim. Drawn to effect. Sound claims.
5	KNOCK OF BEERS	Let-up (43-days). Won from just off the pace-setters at Burumbeet. C Atkinson retains the ride. Drawn to receive every chance.

14 OUR DAWNY Brave in defeat 1 length second Spec Cond (28) at Healesville. First time around Kilmore. Picnic form.

RACE 5 1:50 PM | \$22,000 | KILMORE | 1600m

10	KING ALLA	On a quick back-up. Sound form. Put in some big strides late to place at Ararat at this distance when in the market. Form good enough for this.
2	SLATE RIPPER	Solid performer. Led, dug deep into his reserves but shaded late over 1618m in the Hcp (56) at Werribee. Good draw and big weights don't seem to worry him. Makes strong appeal.
9	HIDDEN WITNESS	Honest competitor. Gave good account when 1.4 lengths 4th at Great Western at this distance when drifted in betting. Among the dangers.
13	DOWNTOWN MAN	On a quick back-up. Solid performance in defeat in the Woolamai Cup at Woolamai. Has a light weight. Good gate and gets 4kg off for Liana Wood.
4	YAKI ISHI	Just wacked away without threatening over 1400m (Bm58) at Albury. New to Kilmore. Looks up against it.

RACE 6 2:30 PM | \$22,000 | KILMORE | 1200m

16	MEXICAN FIDDLER	On target for hat-trick. Solid 64kg winner at Alexandra 27 Dec. Determined winner at Yea when in the market. Breaks from a low barrier and a nice weight drop.
4	LADY MAESTRO	Finished out the back at Sandown-Hillside when a noted market drifter. Winner at only other start at Kilmore. Proven record wet/track. Warrants attention.
9	FUGACITY	Raced in back half and was never in a position to mount a serious challenge at Werribee. Form good enough for this.
7	TRADEWORX	Resuming (20-weeks). Will improve on whatever he does here.
6	QUEUE JUMPER	Fought bravely to the wire 1.9 lengths second Hcp (C1) at Tumbarumba at this distance. Drawn favourably. Minor money hope at best.

RACE 7 3:15 PM | \$60,000 | CRANBOURNE | 1000m

3	HEADBANGER	Been supported at each run. Led and boxed on to place in the small field for 0.5 lengths second at Sandown-Hillside. This looks a nice race for the filly.
2	FANFIRE	Set for second campaign (25-weeks). Likely to have benefitted from the spell. Slotted mid-field and was safely held at bay on debut at Ballarat Synthetic when in the market 19 Aug. Secures inside draw in small field. Should have more to offer this time in
4	INVINCIBLE LOVER	Both runs have contained merit. Went close at Cranbourne two back. Settled close and ran an honest race at Pakenham at her second race start. Good gate helps.
6	SASSIDORA	Led, unable to sustain bid and faded to finish 7 lengths at Sandown-Hillside. Coming back in distance. Disappointing first-up but should improve here.
1	CONGRESS OF VIENNA	By Royal Meeting and making debut without an official trial. Follow any betting leads.

RACE 8 3:45 PM | \$60,000 | CRANBOURNE | 1400m

5	IRREVERENT	Promising and deserves that maiden win. Picked up strongly from back half to fill the minors at Sandown-Hillside when in the market. Will be fitter second-up. Has found a very winnable race.
1	CINTURATO	Returns for second campaign (20-weeks). Lightly raced Shamus Award 3yo showing potential. Drawn to receive every chance. Bold first-up showing anticipated.
2	COSTA PAROS	Shown patches of ability. Worked hard both ends and narrowly outpointed. Among the dangers.
6	LA DIVINA	Strong SP profile. Did little 8.5 lengths 5th at Geelong in only her second race appearance when in the market. Can play a role.
7	PLATINUM RUSH	Out of the money at Pakenham in only her second race appearance when in the market. Fitter, open to improvement up in distance. Only for wider exotics.

RACE 9 4:15 PM | \$60,000 | CRANBOURNE | 2520m

2	STEEL RUN	Won the 3yo Qlty Flemington 6 Jul 2024. Trimmed margin late at Caulfield at first run off a long break. Fitter second-up. Highly rated in this line-up.
1	AMERICAN WOLF	Off pace, worked his way into the minors without threatening winner at Caulfield 31 Jan. Drops in grade. Rates highly.
5	MOZU MARCASSIN	Fought bravely to the wire 1.5 lengths second 3yo+ (Bm66) this venue. Should appreciate stepping up in distance and under less weight. Key player.
3	URBAN OUTLOOK	Comes into this off a dominant win in the 3yo+ (Bm70) at Sandown-Hillside at \$4.40. Switching to 2520m. Super fit from racing and worth a look.
6	HOLLY'S STAR	Winner too strong but ran on for the minors here. Top three chance.

RACE 10 4:45 PM | \$60,000 | CRANBOURNE | 1600m

5	JARETH	Resuming (20-weeks). Went close at Caulfield two back. Secures inside draw in small field. Expecting a prominent showing fresh in this line-up.
4	ASTRAL FLAME	Let-up (62-days). Just missed at Cranbourne 22 Nov. Started \$6.50 when safely held in Benchmark 78 company at Pakenham at this trip. Can lead or take a sit.
6	TIME ALLOWED	Second run now in Australia. Let down fiercely from midfield to grab third this track at first run for new trainer. Fitter second-up. Among the dangers.
7	JEWEL BAY	In touch but couldn't find anything when pressured finishing 4.6 lengths 6th at Pakenham. First go 1600m and under less weight. Key player.
1	SHOELESS	Never a threat after showing no early speed from the barriers at Caulfield first up. Fitter second-up. Rough place prospect.

RACE 11 5:15 PM | \$60,000 | CRANBOURNE | 955m

1	EGERTON	Won 3yo+ (Bm66) Benchmark 66 Flemington 31 Dec. Well back and never a factor at Flemington. Drops in grade. Commands serious attention.
5	FULLY CALCULATED	Trimmed margin late this venue. Key player.
4	SYMPHONY OF COLOUR	Sent back to the tail when 3.6 lengths last of 6 at Sandown-Hillside at first run for new trainer. Fitter second-up. Warrants attention.
9	HI TIAGO	Sent forward from the wide gate and slipped clear to a decisive victory at Hanging Rock. Leads, handy. Has claims.
3	SUPERVISE	First-up (29-weeks). Lightly raced and still learning the caper. Just missed at Ballarat Synthetic 8 Jul. Ridden confidently from the wide gate and got the job done at Ballarat Synthetic.

RACE 12 5:45 PM | \$60,000 | CRANBOURNE | 1400m

8	CONCHIERO	Strode forward off wide gate, fought on bravely to just miss at Caulfield at first run off a long break. Will be fitter second-up. Tactical speed, inside draw. Form good enough for this.
13	TARZING	4 weeks since last run. Bided his time at the back and let down smartly for a 0.5 lengths win at Geelong. Definitely looks city class and can figure again.
12	BETWITCHERY	Worked across into prominent position and found plenty for 1.8 lengths victory at Pakenham 29 Jan. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Can go back to back.
5	PRINCESS QUE	Just shaded in the small field at Murray Bridge Gh at first run back. Has her first look at 1400m here. Unbeaten second-up. Has claims.
10	WARRIOR WITHIN	On a winning streak. Determined winner this venue over this trip as an odds drifter. Home track advantage but awkwardly drawn. Only for wider exotics.

RACE 13 6:15 PM | \$60,000 | CRANBOURNE | 1400m

2	ROCK THEM JOOLS	Gave good account when 1.4 lengths 4th at Sandown-Hillside at resumption. Fitter second-up. Form good enough for this.
5	RYANMAN	On pace, not beaten far at Sandown-Hillside when drifted in betting. More suitable draw. Rates highly.
3	TOPMOST	Finally shed his maiden tag with a 0.5 lengths win this track at this distance. Among the dangers.
4	LAUNCESTON	Returns for second campaign (25-weeks). Broke his maiden at Pakenham Synthetic last campaign. Right in the mix fresh in this affair.
1	NOSTRO ROCCIA	Gritty on pace victory 3yo Mdn Plate here in second run from spell. Winner at only other start at Cranbourne. C Newitt retains the ride. Sticky gate but has early zip.
