

**RACE 1 10:20 AM | \$100,000 | PAKENHAM | 1600m**

6	MISS PLAYLOUNGE	Progressive 4year-old. Responded well from back half to get the prize at Mornington. Winner at track and distance and a nice weight drop. Stays under strong notice for this.
9	JENNI GONE BONKERS	Has decent Stakes form. Broke maiden at Pakenham 7 Nov. Stationed around midfield, positive response gaining late ground for second at Caulfield in second run from spell. Gets in light.
2	ASTRAL FLAME	Settled handy and responded well to fill the minors at Cranbourne. First try over a mile. Rates highly.
8	I ONLY WISH	Freshened. Got back, cut loose late to fill the minors at Flemington. At optimum distance. Drawn to get a conservative run and under less weight.
3	REAL ALLIANCE	On a quick back-up. Has a picket fence form line. Extended her winning streak to 4 with a 0.8 lengths victory in the 3yo+ (Bm66) at Werribee over this distance. Nice gate.

5	BELLA ANGELICA	Strong SP profile. No answer when first two cleared out but ran on bravely for third in the 3yo+ Mdn at Mt Gambier. Can make her presence felt.
15	LONG REIGN	Against own gender when went home tamely at Kyneton at \$8.50. Good gate. Could get into the placings.
6	HELLISH LEE	Freshened. Will have gained valuable experience by debut placing at Dunkeld in soft going when in the market. Drawn well. Could give some cheek at odds.
14	DAD BOD	Prominent to 400m but threw the towel in quickly 10.3 lengths last at Warrnambool. Awkwardly drawn. Form points elsewhere.

11	JUST LIKE GABY	Freshened. Didn't quite finish it off the last bit in Benchmark 74 company at Caulfield. At optimum distance. Has early speed.
6	SWEETHEARTED	5 weeks since last run. Wasn't beaten far in the slosh at Flemington at second run back. Fitter for those two runs and ready to show best. Good gate.
7	BIANCELLI	Lightly raced 4yo. Raced midfield, let down powerfully into second at Cranbourne when off an extended spell. Fitter second-up and takes a 2kg claim. Right in the mix.

11	VEGAS DANCER	Coming off a career best placing. Close-up and gave her all to just at Swan Hill when off an extended spell. Strips fitter second run back. Nice gate.
3	RUSCELLO	Let-up (57-days). Ex C J Waller in Victoria. Boxed on for a distant second in the small field at Pakenham over a longer test. Market watch advised in first run for new stable.

**RACE 5 11:30 AM | \$80,000 | PAKENHAM | 2000m**

6	HURRY CURRY	Off the speed, picked up soundly and wasn't beaten far at Cranbourne in second run from spell. Fitter for those two runs and ready to show best. Key player.
11	SUNTORA	Smoking her pipe at the back then let down with a powerful drive at Caulfield Heath. Should appreciate stepping up in distance and under less weight. This looks very winnable.
13	SHULTZY	Veteran who retains zest for racing. The post came too quickly when closing intently in soft going at Caulfield over a longer test. Switching to 2000m. Nicely weighted.
1	KHOEKHOE	4 weeks since last run. Made running, no answer when challenged but held on for third in the Dunkeld Cup at Dunkeld. Could give some cheek at odds.
10	EYE FOR AN EYE	Lining up for three wins on the trot here. Pushed forward and found enough to score as a \$5 chance at second run back. Has built in speed and has a great record under Lachlan Neindorf here. Each-way.

8	NATION'S CALL	Now 4 weeks between runs. Sent forward but flat-footed when things got serious at Caulfield. Drawn to get an economic trail. Makes a strong case in this company.
2	WAIMARIE	On a quick back-up. Ridden positively and showed plenty of mettle to win at Ballarat. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Can lead or take a sit.
1	FARHH FLUNG	No match but enough in the tank to place in rain affected going at Kilmore at last start this journey. Form sound at this course and journey and a proven weight carrier. Warrants attention.
3	ALTIVO	Well back and never sighted at Rosehill at second run back. One for exotics.

5	MANGIONE	Grand campaigner. Urged across to lead and brave in defeat in the Restricted 64 Hcp (64) at Morphettville Parks. Switching to 2000m. Jump-and-run gelding.
2	VAN ROY	Forwardly placed, continued to stick on for second 3yo+ (Bm62) at Warrnambool. Looking for this trip now. Can show early speed. Makes a strong case in this company.
1	EDDYSTONE	Puts in every start. Wasn't beaten far in rain affected going at Warrnambool at first run for new trainer. One for multiples.
8	ZIBULON	Got back, ran on late with purpose to claim second at Mt Gambier. Right in the mix.
6	ADMIRE ACE	Wore them down late at Kilmore at his second race start. This looks stronger.

16	SKIPPERS CANYON	Won (Bm74) Benchmark 74 Caulfield 15 Nov. Last at turn, ran on late at Caulfield at second run back. Should relish the rise in distance and a nice weight drop. Has a light weight.
12	FIRM AGREEMENT	On a quick back-up. Long time since last saluted. Handily placed but lacked the necessary pick-up and battled to line at Ballarat. New to Pakenham.
15	ZIRYAB	Very game at Caulfield when raced off pace and quickened willingly to just miss the major prize at \$6. Gets in light. Each-way.

11	PROVED	Fresh. Just got there in a gripping finish at at Caulfield in second run from spell. Stiff task.

3	QUIZLET	Freshened. Wasn't beaten far at Mildura. Can challenge.
5	DIVINE TURF	Raced in back half and was never in a position to mount a serious challenge at Kyneton. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Worth a look.

1	JIMMY THE BEAR	First-up (20-weeks). Wonderful competitor. Winner fresh and 2 trials will have him ready for this. Good draw and a proven weight carrier.
2	REGAL ZEUS	Led, toyed with his rivals in the small field at Kilmore when in the market. Coming back in distance. Has early speed. Right in the mix.
5	RUN HARRY RUN	4 weeks since last run. Responded well from just off leaders to snare a final bound win at Ararat. Sound claims.

7	METEORITE	Ran on well to bag a 1.5 lengths win in the 3yo+ (Bm52) at Penshurst. Makes a strong case in this company.
11	SWEET CITY DANCER	Went home tamely at Swan Hill at \$10. Will be fitter second-up. Only for wider exotics.

1	BIG SWINGER	Has struck a purple patch of form. Outgunned but did enough for third at \$4.40 at Caulfield second-up. Winner at track and distance. Ready to peak third-up.
9	DIRTY GRIN	Bided his time at the back and let down smartly for a 0.8 lengths win at Geelong. A distance specialist. Fitter, proven second-up. Among the dangers.
10	MYTEMPTATION	Just missed at Ararat 9 Nov. Ridden cold and never in the picture at Cranbourne at last start this journey. Each-way.
16	HEART OF GLASS	First-up (36-weeks). Went close at Caulfield two back. Hits straps quickly. Worth a look fresh in this company.
17	RECON	Lining up for three wins on the trot. Solid 60.5kg winner at Mornington 2 Nov. Responded strongly to score in small field at Moe over this distance. Drawn favourably. Place preferred here.
