

**RACE 1 11:00 AM | \$42,500 | SEYMOUR | 1000m**

9	<b>BOURDETO</b>	Trials (1:0-0-0). Prepared with a 900m barrier trial at Caulfield Heath on 13 Aug. M J Dee sticks from latest trial. Markets may prove best pointer.
3	<b>GAEILGE</b>	Resuming (41-weeks). First run this region for new stable. Promising and deserves that maiden win. Has early speed.
10	<b>TALLINGAS IMMORTAL</b>	Wins are proving elusive but does look well placed. Just missed at Yarra Glen 25 Oct. Led, dug deep into her reserves but shaded late over 1100m in the 3yo+ Mdn at Wodonga at second run back. Fitter, has scope to progress.
5	<b>WEMBLEY STADIUM</b>	Settled close and ran an honest race at Terang in only his second race appearance. Drops to shorter trip. Minor money hope at best.
8	<b>WAYNE'S DREAM</b>	Wasn't beaten far at Hanging Rock over this distance. Looks vulnerable.

10	<b>SHARE THE STARS</b>	Form to date sound. Gave good account when 1.4 lengths 4th at Terang when off an extended spell when in the market. Fitter second-up. Decent alley.
7	<b>SILVER BULLET</b>	In the market all runs. Showed a fine turn of foot from the back to snare second place at Mornington. Can challenge.
3	<b>COSTA PAROS</b>	Let-up (51-days). Courageous when defeated 1.4 lengths third 3yo+ Mdn at Ararat at his second race start. One for multiples.
14	<b>SWEET FARNAN</b>	Solid performance in defeat in the 3yo F Mdn Plate at Yarra Glen. Drawn favourably. Makes a strong case in this company.
8	<b>WINTER HAIL</b>	Sent back and finished with a full head of steam in Maiden company at Wangaratta. One for exotics.

**RACE 3 12:00 PM | \$42,500 | SEYMOUR | 1600m**

3	<b>NAN'S REBEL</b>	Towards rear and safely contained at Stony Creek on debut 30 Dec. Drawn favourably. Better for race experience. Has scope.
7	<b>OCTANE REIGN</b>	Started \$2.30 when battled home in Maiden company at Yarra Glen. Has found a very winnable race.
8	<b>SUNGAZER</b>	Handy but gave away tamely here at first run off a long break. Sticking to this trip a positive. Makes strong appeal.
9	<b>KADDARI</b>	On a quick back-up. Midfield, no rally and went to line tamely 4.1 lengths 5th at Pakenham at this trip. Good draw. Rates highly.
5	<b>STORMYFRIENDSHIP</b>	Just beaten in the Mdn Plate at Merton over this distance. Sound claims.

**RACE 4 12:30 PM | \$35,000 | SEYMOUR | 1600m**

7	<b>MACEDON ROSE</b>	4 weeks since last run. Came home with a wet sail to grab second (Bm70) at Mornington at odds of \$7. Ticks the track and distance win box. This looks very winnable.
8	<b>PENNINE WAY</b>	Let-up (69-days). Just missed at Ballarat 25 May. Failed to run on in the small field at Pakenham when off an extended spell. Can forgive latest, run prior was good.
1	<b>MAGARTEN</b>	Was hopeless at Geelong in second run from spell. Sound claims.
2	<b>MAKTOOB</b>	Went home tamely at Flemington at \$26. Drops to shorter trip. Can be thereabouts.
9	<b>JUST JENNI</b>	Settled midfield, ran on fairly without threatening 3.5 lengths 5th at Sandown-Lakeside. Should appreciate stepping up in distance. Worth a look.

6	<b>DIVINE THOUGHTS</b>	Weakened in run home finishing 3.2 lengths 6th at Cranbourne. Fancy the extra trip will suit. Jump-and-run mare. Makes a strong case in this company.
10	<b>TALENT SCOUT</b>	Gave good account when 1.2 lengths 4th this track when in the market. Has built in speed. Can play a role.
7	<b>SINHALESE</b>	Ridden cold then reeled them in swiftly to score at Yarra Glen. Rise to 2021m a new challenge. Harder now.
13	<b>CONVO</b>	Produced a searching finish into the minors at Mornington at second run back. Rough place prospect.
2	<b>MACY MOON</b>	Solid performer. Sent forward and fought on dauntlessly to just miss at Wodonga. Leads, handy. Rates highly.

7	<b>DIMORA QUEEN</b>	First-up (42-weeks). Handy form when last seen. Can lead or take a sit. Can play a role.
9	<b>RHIA</b>	Freshened after resuming from a break. Let down with a fine turn of speed from the back half to win at first run off a long break. Decent alley. Warrants attention.
4	<b>AKICITA</b>	First-up (36-weeks). Saluted at Sale first-up last time in. Beaten out of sight 2yo+ (Bm70) at Sale when in the market. Usually gets back.
13	<b>COCO DE LUXE</b>	Kicked off career with a narrow victory at Echuca when in the market. J Duffy retains the ride. Right in the mix.
8	<b>HOLLYWOODBOULEVARD</b>	Kicks off second campaign (18-weeks). Did a terrific job in his first campaign. Indicated talent winning twice in his debut campaign. Has a tricky draw to contend with this time.

6	<b>SHOW OF GOLD</b>	First-up (36-weeks). Broke maiden at Caulfield Heath 16 Apr. Can show early speed. Each-way.
9	<b>THUNDER HAWK</b>	Went home tamely at Flemington at \$9. Drops to shorter trip. Ready to peak third-up. Drawn well.
13	<b>SUNSHINE JENNI</b>	First-up (29-weeks). Ex Ben, Will & Jd Hayes in Victoria. Broke maiden at Sale 4 May. Won at at Sale when fresh last campaign.
2	<b>HOT CHIPS</b>	Seldom puts in a bad one. Gave a good sight making the frame at Mornington at resumption when in the market. Fitter second-up and takes a 2kg claim. Can lead or take a sit.
