

**RACE 1** 10:35 AM | \$23,000 | **PORT LINCOLN** | 1210m

6	<b>MISS BOOM</b>	Lightly raced and still learning the caper. No threat to winner but ran on for the minors at Murray Bridge Gh at first run for new trainer as an odds drifter. Will be fitter second-up. Decent alley.
5	<b>MAKENZIE</b>	Was a long way from the action in 1208m 3yo+ Mdn Plate at Gawler. Could give some cheek at odds.
1	<b>ALABAMA AWARD</b>	Fought bravely to the wire in the 3yo+ Mdn at Ceduna. Drawn more favourably. Can make her presence felt.
8	<b>SOCIAL DANCER</b>	Ex Waylon Hornhardt in SA. Very tame performance at Clare. Has form this track and distance. Betting watch advised.
4	<b>GRINZINGER GOLD</b>	Now 4 weeks between runs. Issued decent challenge 2yo+ Mdn Plate here over this trip. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Can play a role.

11	<b>REIBY PRINCESS</b>	Let-up (45-days). On speed, outgunned late but had enough in the tank for second 3yo+ Mdn Plate here over a longer test. Drawn to receive every chance. Makes strong appeal.
4	<b>UNCLE BARRY</b>	Resuming (12-weeks). Ex Mitchell Beer & George Carpenter in NSW. Good gate. Bold first-up showing anticipated.
6	<b>PETIT CHAUTAUQ</b>	Steps out for third run new stable/region. Sent out \$7.50 when unable to threaten at Clare in second run from spell. Can play a role.
2	<b>SIR DALAPENA</b>	Refused to shirk task in 3yo+ Mdn at Lock. Switching to 1000m. Has some claims.
8	<b>LOVE SO SWEET</b>	Tame to line in small field at Clare. Looks up against it.

**RACE 3** 11:45 AM | \$23,000 | **PORT LINCOLN** | 1750m

3	<b>ELEGANT MAN</b>	4 weeks since last run. First run new state/stable. Battled home at Great Western. Form good enough for this.
8	<b>AGREEANCE</b>	Fresh. Not disgraced in Open Hcp this track at last start this journey at \$71. Has plenty to offer.
9	<b>SHINOHARA</b>	Just missed at Port Lincoln 23 Jan. Failed to run on in the small field at Gawler. Form sound at this course and journey and gets 3kg off for Polly Brewster. Has some claims.

5	<b>GRECIAN STORM</b>	Fresh. Dictated terms in recording a gritty win in the 2yo+ Mdn Plate this track. Locally trained but awkwardly drawn this time. Could give some cheek at odds.
1	<b>TRIPOD TERROR</b>	Really good run coming from well back to just miss at Gawler. Winner at track and distance. Harder they go, better suited. Key player.

4	<b>LEOPARD SHARK</b>	Made short work of the small field in the 2yo Mdn Plate at Pakenham last start. Jye McNeil retains the ride. Well placed for a repeat.
3	<b>OPTIMUS</b>	Unraced 2yo by champion sire I Am Invincible and out of the Fastnet Rock mare Sia. Look to betting for a further guide.
6	<b>TUZEMAK</b>	Should relish the rise in distance. Warrants attention.
2	<b>HYDROBOMB</b>	First starter by Shamus Award and out of the More Than Ready mare Splat. Not seen at barrier trials. Can make an immediate impact here.
5	<b>STOMPING GROUND</b>	Well down the track at Pakenham on debut. Better for race experience. Has scope.

9	<b>IN YOUR WORDS</b>	On a quick back-up. Latest attempt this journey when went home tamely at Strathalbyn at \$11. Good gate. Hard fit and among the dangers.
4	<b>STAR VALOUR</b>	Sent out \$9 when unable to threaten at Lock. Effective this track and distance. Breaks from a low barrier. Can make his presence felt.
5	<b>LICHESTER</b>	Freshened. First run new state/stable. Gave good account at Great Western. Drawn to get a conservative run.
1	<b>DARK LAGER</b>	Started \$31 when safely held in Benchmark 58 company at Lock. Has some claims.

3	<b>SIR PANAMA</b>	Terrific effort when just shaded at Ceduna 31 Jan. Effective this track and distance. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Makes strong appeal.
6	<b>BONA FIDE STAR</b>	Ex G Richards & D Moyle in SA. Failed to threaten at Morphettville over a longer test. Coming back in distance. Market watch advised.
7	<b>HE'S ABEL</b>	Seasoned performer. Wasn't beaten far at Lock. Form sound this track and distance and takes a large claim. Claiming apprentice engaged again.

**RACE 9** 1:50 PM | \$55,000 | **SANDOWN** | 1500m

10	<b>RUSSIAN CHOICE</b>	Ran on soundly into second in the small field this track. Makes a strong case in this company.
4	<b>BEL MEZYAAN</b>	Confidently ridden from the back and flew home at Ballarat at Ballarat. Should appreciate stepping up in distance. Lachlan Neindorf retains the ride. Can make his presence felt.
7	<b>MUSKITO</b>	Made an absolute mess of them on debut at Ararat when in the market. Has a touch of quality and deserves a shot in metro company.
8	<b>ORNOS</b>	Not disgraced in 3yo (Bm64) here first up at \$3.70. Strips fitter second run back. Can make his presence felt.
6	<b>HOTEI SENSHI</b>	Straight into the black book after a terrific debut at Wangaratta 8 Feb. Untapped and deserves a crack in town.

8	<b>THINKINGNINTYNINE</b>	Winner packed too many punches but he kept on bravely at Murray Bridge Gh. Switching to 1750m. Can lead or take a sit. Form good enough for this.
3	<b>SUPER VALENTINE</b>	Went close at Port Lincoln two back. Went home tamely at Morphettville Parks at \$51. Form sound this track and distance and has a good history under Rochelle Milnes this track. Key player.
2	<b>THERE GOES MY HERO</b>	Ex Aaron Bain & Ned Taylor in SA. Close-up at Gawler 3 Jan. Raced in back half and was never in a position to mount a serious challenge at Strathalbyn. Key player.
6	<b>LUMBER DREAM</b>	\$14 chance, handy and put them to the sword in the Hcp (56) at Gawler. Can add to tally.
7	<b>ZAIN PRINCE</b>	Sent forward but flat-footed when things got serious at Morphettville. Drops to shorter trip. Hard to warm to.

**RACE 11** 2:25 PM | \$55,000 | **SANDOWN** | 1400m

5	<b>TERILEE</b>	Fresh. Made some headway without troubling at Pakenham at second run back. Fitter for those two runs and ready to show something. Breaks from a low barrier and under less weight.
4	<b>ALL BUSINESS</b>	Ran home into the minors 3yo+ F&M (Bm74) at Caulfield Heath. Coming back in distance. Rates highly.
7	<b>FLOWERDALE</b>	Off midfield when flew home to score at Sale at first run off a long break. Strips fitter second run back. Among the dangers.
9	<b>DANCINGONMYOWN</b>	Well back and never a factor at Caulfield Heath first up. Strips fitter second run back. Can play a role.
2	<b>THIS TIME GIRL</b>	Resuming (19-weeks). Ex Hollie Wynyard in New Zealand. NZer having first run across the ditch. Look to betting.

**RACE 12** 2:40 PM | \$23,000 | **PORT LINCOLN** | 1000m

5	<b>STRAWBERRY SWING</b>	Model of consistency. Handily placed and gave her all at Clare. Has form this track and distance and 3kg helps the cause. Nice gate and gets 3kg off for S H Sit.
1	<b>SETTEVELI</b>	Let-up (70-days). Got the wobbles late after leading here over a longer test. This looks very winnable.
2	<b>PRESCIENT</b>	Alertly away to lead, stuck on solidly Hcp (54) at Clare. Form sound at this course and journey. Can lead or take a sit. Sound claims.
6	<b>SPIRITUAL GAL</b>	4 weeks since last run. Short course specialist. Run down in the shadows after a giving a kick from on pace in the Hcp (54) here at this trip. On pacer.
4	<b>THE LAST STAND</b>	Very tame performance at Ceduna at last start this journey. Trained on track but awkwardly drawn. Could surprise.

**RACE 13 3:00 PM | \$55,000 | SANDOWN | 2400m**

5	<b>TRAPALANDA</b>	Not disgraced in (Bm78) at Flemington at \$8.50. Should appreciate stepping up in distance. Makes a strong case in this company.
2	<b>AMERICAN WOLF</b>	Enough in the tank to place at Cranbourne. Coming back in distance. Right in the mix.
1	<b>URBAN OUTLOOK</b>	Chasing hat-trick. Patiently handled and reeled them in smartly to win the 3yo+ (Bm74) at Cranbourne. Coming back in distance. Up in weight for that win but doubt that will be enough to prevent another bold performance.
3	<b>BLUESTONE</b>	Was super closing at Caulfield when off an extended spell. Form sound this track and distance. Unbeaten second-up and takes a 2kg claim. Can challenge.
4	<b>EAGLE ANGEL</b>	On pace, boxed away behind tearaway winner here over a longer test. Switching to 2400m. Experienced rider replaces apprentice. Goes forward.

**RACE 14 3:30 PM | \$55,000 | SANDOWN | 1300m**

10	<b>SAVITRI</b>	Showed a fine turn of foot from the back at Caulfield Heath in only her second race appearance. Worth a look.
7	<b>ENAMORADA</b>	Just wacked away without threatening over 1300m 3yo+ (Bm66) here at first run for new trainer. Won second-up last campaign. Drawn more favourably. Right in the mix.
8	<b>TRAPDOOR</b>	Set for second campaign (26-weeks). Likely to have benefitted from the spell. Broke maiden at Geelong in his first preparation. Proven fresh and looks fit for return to racing. Drawn favourably.
2	<b>OVERACTIVE</b>	First-up (19-weeks). Tends to race well first-up without winning. Back in easier class. Among the dangers fresh in this line-up.
6	<b>HOT CHIPS</b>	Tame to line in small field here. One for exotics.

**RACE 15 4:00 PM | \$55,000 | SANDOWN | 1400m**

3	<b>HEDONIST</b>	Bolted in at Warrnambool two back. Made all and just picked off late at Caulfield at last start this journey. Senior rider takes over. Leader.
5	<b>TEST OF LOVE</b>	Second run now in Australia. Pressed forward and kept on determinedly at Sale at first run for new trainer. Will be fitter second-up. Stays under strong notice for this.
6	<b>WINSOME STAR</b>	Knuckled down well from midfield to salute here. Won only other time at Sandown-Hillside. Nice gate. Can go back to back.
9	<b>KAAZI</b>	Kicks off second campaign (22-weeks). Won 2 of 4 starts in first campaign. Worth a look fresh in this line-up.
4	<b>KURAKKA</b>	Resuming (30-weeks). Ex Alan King in Europe. International import with new trainer. Betting may provide best clue.

2	<b>FIGLIO D'ARGENTO</b>	Last assignment this trip when fired up to lead and kept on valiantly here. Leads, handy. Highly rated in this line-up.
3	<b>SAVISANTA</b>	Comes here off a pretty dominant at Sale win in Maiden company at \$1.24. Strips fitter second run back. Among the dangers.
5	<b>PERFECT ENDING</b>	Fresh. Led, gave away final stages at Geelong in second run from spell. Fitter now and ready to improve. Leads, handy.
12	<b>SO SUAVE</b>	Couldn't get near winner but found enough for the minors at Caulfield Heath. Sound claims.
1	<b>BRING FORTH</b>	Went home tamely at Sale at \$2.15. Will be fitter second-up and takes a 2kg claim. Sound claims.
