

RACE 1 3:15 PM | \$60,000 | CRANBOURNE | 1500m

1	ANIMAL	Wins are proving elusive but does look well placed. Worked hard both ends and narrowly outpointed. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Has found a very winnable race.
9	LISA LASS	Indicated early potential. Let down fiercely from midfield to grab second this venue at first run back. Fitter second-up. Drawn to receive every chance.
10	VIEUX RICHE	No match but ran on for the minors at Pakenham on debut. Has scope. Drawn to get a conservative run. Key player.
5	COSTA PAROS	Kept finding the line without threatening this track last outing. Each-way.

RACE 2 3:45 PM | \$60,000 | CRANBOURNE | 1200m

4	IRONIC FORTUNE	In the money at his only start at Seymour 15 Jan. Better for race experience. Fancy the extra trip will suit. Decent alley. Form good enough for this.
10	XUXA KISS	Towards rear and battled home at Sandown-Lakeside on debut. Fancy the extra trip will suit. Drawn to get a conservative run. Worth a look.
2	FLY BY LIGHT	Flying Artie gelding heading to the races without a public trial. Look to betting for further clues.
9	FROSTED MISS	Better for her encouraging 1.5 lengths second at Yarra Glen at first race appearance. Looking for this trip now. Breaks from a low barrier. Rates highly.
3	FULL OF KNOWLEDGE	Handily placed but lacked the necessary pick-up and battled to line this track. Fitter, has scope to progress stepping up in trip. Drawn well. Sound claims.

RACE 3 4:15 PM | \$60,000 | CRANBOURNE | 1200m

6	ARTIE'S STORM	Sent forward and found plenty at Yarra Glen in only her second race appearance. Fancy the extra trip will suit. Form good enough for this.
1	EXIT	First-up (22-weeks). Won at at Sandown-Hillside when fresh last campaign. Rates highly fresh in this affair.
5	SHEANADH	Fresh. Excellent debut performance posting a 1 length win at Mornington 1 Jan. M J Dee retains the ride. Worth a look.
8	BIG STAR	Scrubbed up from the wide gate and boxed on bravely for a 0.1 lengths win at Wangaratta. Lachlan King retains the ride. On pacer. Worth a look.
3	TORONADO QUEEN	Resuming (40-weeks). Will have matured since her initial campaign. Winner at Geelong in her first prep. Can challenge fresh in this affair.

9	CONVO	Primed to strike. Fought bravely to the wire 1.5 lengths second 3yo+ (Bm62) at Seymour. Makes strong appeal.
1	WARCHIME	Forwardly placed and responded strongly to secure victory in Benchmark 62 company at Seymour. Can add to tally.
4	MOZU MARCASSIN	Wasn't beaten far at Sandown-Lakeside. Can challenge.
3	THINKING GOLD	Won (Bm62) Benchmark 62 Seymour 28 Dec. Failed to threaten at Flemington when drifted in betting. Worth a look.

RACE 5 5:15 PM | \$60,000 | **CRANBOURNE** | 1000m

2	COMMANDS SUCCESS	Genuine short-course sprinter. Excellent effort chiming in late for second at Geelong. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Good draw and 3kg helps the cause.
6	FULLY CALCULATED	Honest performance without menacing winner in the small field at Sale at this trip. Senior rider takes over. Decent alley. Rates highly.
1	TOOKAY PETE	On target for hat-trick. Gave solid kick from handy position and fought on well to triumph this venue at last start this journey. Won only other time at Cranbourne. Claiming apprentice engaged again.
9	EDUCATED	Kicks off second campaign (20-weeks). The money was spot on \$1.55 when saluted in the 3yo Mdn Plate at Tatura, 8 Sep. Celine Gaudray retains the ride. Drawn to receive every chance.
7	COOL CHARLIE	Led, gave away late finishing 1.9 lengths astern of winner at Pakenham. First time around Cranbourne. Rough place prospect.

RACE 6 5:45 PM | \$60,000 | **CRANBOURNE** | 955m

3	RUNLIKENENCRYPTION	Sandown-Lakeside winner two back. Gave good account when 1.2 lengths 4th at Flemington. Form good enough for this.
2	MYSTIC REIGN	Ranged up but punctured late at Flemington in second run from spell. Fitter for those two runs and ready to show best. Has early speed. Key player.
1	JENNYANYDOTS	First-up (18-weeks). Form sound last campaign. Consistent first-up form. Can challenge fresh in this line-up.
5	PURE BLISS	Mare specialises under 6-furlongs. Not disgraced at Flemington. Each-way.
7	SHARING MOMENTS	Kicks off second campaign (47-weeks). Winner at Pakenham in her first prep. Breaks from an outside gate. Goes to another level.

RACE 7 6:15 PM | \$60,000 | **CRANBOURNE** | 1200m

1	MR ASSERTIVE	Comes here off a pretty dominant at Geelong win in Benchmark 62 company at \$2.50. Draws to do no work. Form good enough for this.
13	BOHEMIAN ANGEL	Just missed at Moe 4 Sep. Had all before her at turn and went home tamely at Geelong at resumption. Will be fitter second-up. Below par first-up but expect a more competitive showing here.
12	BLUE HAWAIIAN	First-up (18-weeks). Lone career win was at Cranbourne in last campaign. Consistent first-up form and proven here. Leads, handy.
10	ESCARPA	Sent back (outside alley) and finished with a full head of steam in Benchmark 66 company at Sandown-Lakeside at last start this journey. Better draw here. Has claims.
7	SUPIDO'S CHOICE	Failed to run on in the small field at Sale at first run for new trainer. Will be fitter second-up and takes a 2kg claim. Improvement wouldn't shock after a dusting off the cobwebs first-up.

10	EDEN ROSE	Broke maiden at Burrumbeet 1 Jan. And only overhauled late at Flemington. Possesses high speed. Easier here.
4	VALEDICTORIAN	Finally in the winner's circle with a 3.3 lengths victory this venue. On pacer. Key player.
3	WONDERING SPIRIT	Resuming (16-weeks). Ex M Price & M Kent Jnr in Victoria. Lone career win was at Mornington in last campaign. Broke maiden at Mornington 18 Sep.
7	MORAL TURPITUDE	Just missed at Terang 16 Dec. Finally shed his maiden tag with a 2.3 lengths win at Wodonga. Sound claims.
8	NAVY NINA	Lightly raced and still learning the caper. Never a threat after showing no early speed from the barriers at Geelong at first run off a long break. Fitter second-up. Below par first-up but expect a more competitive showing here.
