7	STYLISH SECRET	On a quick back-up. Ran on without troubling winner in the 3yo+ (Bm78) here. Up in trip a plus but tempo the key. Among the dangers.
9	NAVY HEART	Game effort at Flemington. Hard fit and among the dangers.
5	SAMUEL LANGHORNE	First-up (26-weeks). Tends to race well first-up without winning. At optimum distance. Warrants attention fresh in this affair.

5	MIRADOR	No match but ran on for the minors at Flemington on debut when in the market. Has scope. Rates highly.
7	JADZIA	Trials (1:1-0-0). Ole Kirk filly who indicated ability winning a Sandown-Hillside barrier trial 15 Jan. Jordan Childs sticks from latest trial. Can make a winning debut.
2	INVINCIBLE SON	Let-up (42-days). Around mid-field and not too far off them at Caulfield Heath when in the market on debut 20 Dec. Right in the mix.
4	LADY OF FIVE	Fronting up for second campaign (14-weeks). Broke maiden at Eagle Farm in her first preparation. Can challenge fresh in this company.

RACE 9 12:26 PM | \$22,000 | KYNETON | 1856m

3	UNQUESTIONABLY	Reserved midfield and picked up intently for a 1.6 lengths third at Stony Creek. Switching to 1856m. This looks very winnable.
6	REMIGIUS	Useful money-spinner. Couldn't quite peg back winner at Stony Creek. Each-way.
9	OUTCASTER	Just missed at Yarra Glen 29 Dec. Trimmed margin late at Stony Creek. Switching to 1856m. Deep into her campaign and among the dangers.
2	TOP ARCTIC	4 weeks since last run. Just wacked away without threatening over 1600m 3yo+ (Bm56) at Hanging Rock in second run from spell. Ready to peak third-up. Can challenge.
7	AMERICAN GAS	Let-up (49-days). Ex Symon Wilde in Victoria. Raced in back half and never likely when 7.6 lengths 10th at Stawell. Betting watch advised at first run for new trainer.

3	DAMASK ROSE	Import returning for second Australian campaign (13-weeks). Comes to hand quickly. Breaks from a low barrier. Expecting a prominent showing fresh in this line-up.
8	CIGAR FLICK	Now 4 weeks between runs. Not disgraced at Randwick second-up. Experienced rider replaces apprentice. Can make her presence felt.
4	AVIATRESS	Last start this trip ran on fairly from back half at Flemington when in the market. Has form this track and distance. Jumps from better barrier. Form good enough for this.
7	A LITTLE DEEP	Freshened. Midfield and worked home solidly at Sandown-Lakeside in second run from spell. Form sound this track and distance and a nice weight drop. Fitter for those two runs and ready to show best.
2	PROVED	Let-up (49-days). Sent out \$31 when unable to threaten at Pakenham. Winner at only other start at Caulfield. Minor money hope at best.

8	LUVYA MUMMA	Solid performance in defeat in the F&M (Bm62) at Cranbourne at second run back. Ready to peak third-up. Gets in light. Highly rated in this line-up.
3	ASEVENTY SEVEN	Shouldered 64.5kg to victory at Colac. Went out too hard and surrendered quickly at Pakenham. Drawn to get an economic trail. Key player.
6	SECOND FIX	Stationed handy, tried hard but winner was simply too good at Murray Bridge Gh in second run from spell. Fancy the extra trip will suit. Makes strong appeal.
2	STAR BUYER	Started \$21 when battled home in Benchmark 66 company at Wangaratta. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Could get into the placings.

6	SWEETHEARTED	Made minor headway from back half for 3.6 lengths 6th at Flemington. Deep into his campaign and could get into the placings.
5	GRACIE'S RAIN	4 weeks since last run. Smart sprinter with a high cruising speed. Caulfield Heath winner two back. Got the wobbles and faded out of the placings at Geelong.
4	RUE DE ROYALE	Outsprinted but determined in defeat 0.8 lengths third 3yo+ (Bm74) down the Flemington straight 10 Jan. One for multiples.
7	CAPPER THIRTYNINE	Let-up (83-days). Only for wider exotics fresh in this affair.

RACE 13 1:41 PM | \$22,000 | KYNETON | 1454m

6	BROADHURST	4 weeks since last run. Real tradesman. Handy and acquitted herself fairly well at Terang second-up. Ready to peak third-up.
12	THE HAY FLYER	Seldom puts in a bad one. On speed, outgunned late but had enough in the tank for third 3yo+ Hcp (56) at Camperdown. Leads, handy. Right in the mix.
9	DUBAI FOUNTAIN	Forwardly placed, continued to stick on for third Hcp (C1) at Tumut. Drawn to effect. Hard to ignore.

7	MIDNITE STORM	Second run now in Australia. Showed plenty of fight to secure victory at Flemington at first run for new trainer. Will be fitter second-up. Looks a first four candidate.

11	SWEET CHEVAL	Went close at Colac two back. Was a valiant but vanquished third in the 3yo+ Hcp (56) at Stawell. On pacer, perfect gate. Highly rated in this line-up.
12	TURNQUID	Went close at Wangaratta two back. Got back and hit line with a full head of steam at Wodonga. Winner at only other start at Kyneton. One for multiples.
6	VERY GRATEFUL	Resuming (18-weeks). Good draw. Warrants attention fresh in this line-up.
7	BRUTAL WORLD	Now 4 weeks between runs. Useful money-spinner. Wasn't beaten far at Mornington. Drawn well.
4	LUNA FIELD	Mediocre performance after settling handy at Stony Creek. Can run a drum.

1	HARRY'S YACHT	Geelong winner two back. Tame to line in small field at Flemington. Won only other time at Caulfield. Form good enough for this.
15	CODIGO	Fresh. Last assignment this trip when led from pillar to near the post in the 3yo+ (Bm84) at Geelong. On pacer. Has claims.
16	STEALTH OF NIGHT	5 weeks since last run. Consummate professional. Scrubbed up from the wide gate and boxed on bravely for a 0.8 lengths win at Sandown-Lakeside. Good gate speed, soft draw.
9	PORTER	Went close at Cranbourne two back. Led and held sway to win at Flemington over this trip. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Can make own luck from the tricky draw.
6	ZOUPER FUND	Freshened. Shouldered 60.5kg to victory at Ballarat. Refused to shirk task in 3yo+ (Bm84) at Cranbourne. Can be thereabouts.
