

**RACE 1** 10:30 AM | AUD42,500 | **GEELONG** | 1212m

6	<b>PRAY FOR ELEGANCE</b>	Trials (1:0-1-0). Did enough to finish second in last trial. Can make an immediate impact.
3	<b>EXPLOIT</b>	Fronting up for second campaign (20-weeks). From top stable however returned a disappointing debut performance at Pakenham 9 Jan. Experience a positive. Since trialled and looks capable of progressing. Extra ground should favour.
7	<b>RESONANT</b>	Solid debut placing Vobis Gold Rush at Bendigo 2 May. Sent out \$4.40 when unable to threaten at Flemington at his second race start. Reverts to slightly shorter trip. All the better and will take stopping in this company.
1	<b>BOURNE LEGACY</b>	Not too far off them at Caulfield Heath on debut 20 May. Has scope. Has some claims.

**RACE 2** 11:00 AM | AUD42,500 | **GEELONG** | 1212m

2	<b>BOLD SECRET</b>	Out of the money but not totally disgraced in soft going at Pakenham at first run off a long break at skinny odds. Fitter second-up. Right in the mix.
6	<b>JUST LIKE JAGGER</b>	Impending gelding who has obviously needed time. No public trial on record. Gets a soft draw for first assignment. Betting may provide a clearer picture.
4	<b>FLYING CAPITAL</b>	Fresh. In the market all runs. Engaged pace when a valiant but vanquished second in the 4yo+ Mdn Plate at Warrnambool at his second race start. Progressive type.
7	<b>MISTY WHISPER</b>	Produced a searching finish into the minors this track in only his second race appearance. Could get into the placings.

**RACE 3** 11:30 AM | AUD42,500 | **GEELONG** | 1412m

10	<b>FOREVER JEUNE</b>	Kept coming and just fell short this track at first run off a long break. Has a tricky draw. Fitter second-up. Could get into the placings.
12	<b>JENNI BASSETT</b>	Resuming (23-weeks). Ex C Maher in Victoria. Placed at Geelong first-up last campaign while prepared for return with a Caulfield Heath trial. Flat-footed when the sprint went on at Sale.
7	<b>TRIUMVIRATE</b>	Close-up of late. Just missed at Wodonga in Maiden company. Placed only other run at Geelong. Makes a strong case in this field.
6	<b>SHALAAKEI</b>	Showing some early promise. Really good run coming from the back in 2yo+ Mdn Plate at Werribee. Worth a look.

**RACE 4** 12:00 PM | AUD42,500 | **GEELONG** | 1715m

16	<b>LEPRACANTO</b>	Ran on soundly from midfield at Werribee at first run off a long break. Could give some cheek at odds.
10	<b>PARI MOI</b>	Keeps knocking on the door. Good placing 3yo+ Mdn Caulfield Heath 29 Apr. Rode the speed and went down in head-bobber this track. Natural leader, gun draw.
14	<b>WHO'LLSTOPLORRAINE</b>	Weakened in run home at Seymour. Can lead or take a sit. Only for the minors here.
18	<b>MR VEGAS</b>	Finished well down the track in 3yo+ Mdn Plate at Stawell last outing. Coming back in distance. Place.

**RACE 5** 12:30 PM | AUD35,000 | **GEELONG** | 1715m

11	<b>BAYWATCH</b>	Let-up (47-days). Ran on late from the back at Mornington at second run back. Wet form - soft (1:1-0-0); untested heavy. All the better and highly rated in this line-up.
1	<b>RASP</b>	Warmed up nicely late on a soft deck at Pakenham after easing in betting. Drops to shorter trip. Profiles well.
5	<b>THE MANSMAN</b>	Trimmed margin late at Sale. Placed only other run at Geelong. Can play a role.
3	<b>GOVERNOR KING</b>	Went home just tamely in soft going at Ballarat at \$11. Could surprise.

**RACE 6** 1:00 PM | AUD35,000 | **GEELONG** | 2418m

2	<b>FLASHLIGHT</b>	Now 4 weeks between runs. Sent out \$31 when unable to threaten at Bendigo. Since trialled at Traralgon 20 May. Right in this.
3	<b>THURMOND</b>	In touch, no match but did enough for a minor prize this venue in Benchmark 62 company in second run from spell. Fitter for those two runs and ready to show best. Has terrific record on wet tracks. All the better and has some claims.
10	<b>JENNY THE BEAVER</b>	Long time since last saluted. Ground away fairly in the straight here. Very hard to enthuse.
14	<b>TRIORA</b>	Backing up quickly. Knuckled down on a soft deck for second at Werribee. Wet form - soft (5:1-0); untested heavy. Deep into her campaign and can make her presence felt.

**RACE 7** 1:30 PM | AUD35,000 | **GEELONG** | 1112m

5	<b>DYNAMITE DANCER</b>	Back for second campaign (23-weeks). Given time to mature. Ex Daniel Bowman in Victoria. Broke maiden at Horsham in his first preparation. In the minors at Warrnambool on debut last campaign.
2	<b>LUDLUM</b>	Set for second campaign (30-weeks). Strengthened up. Winner at Seymour in his first prep. Nearly won in Maiden company at Ballarat first-up last campaign. Highly fancied for a winning return.
1	<b>IN HASTE</b>	Given time to freshen up after 1st-up run. Steps out for second Aust start Ex-NZ. Raced in back half and was never in a position to mount a serious challenge at Caulfield Heath. Drawn to effect.
7	<b>WARRIOR SMILE</b>	Resuming (24-weeks). Merit in Stakes form. Expected to need this outing. Looking elsewhere.

**RACE 8** 2:00 PM | AUD35,000 | **GEELONG** | 1312m

7	<b>ROGUE WARRIOR</b>	Broke maiden at Sale 21 Dec. Picked up strongly from back half at Sale. Fitter second-up. Key player.
6	<b>JOIN THE QUE</b>	Donkey-licked them at Stawell two back. Ridden in back half, strong late to fill the minors 2yo+ Hcp (C1) at Bendigo. Highly rated in this line-up.
3	<b>GOLDEN SPRITZ</b>	Great run at Cranbourne 24 Apr. Just wacked away without threatening over 1300m 2yo+ Hcp (C1) at Bendigo in second run from spell. Among the dangers.
1	<b>COME ALONG JEFFREY</b>	Chasing hat-trick. Knuckled down well on a soft deck winning the 2yo+ (Bm56) under a big impost at Kilmore. Speedy and a proven weight carrier ,although expecting more pressure here. Acts on all surfaces.

**RACE 9** 2:30 PM | AUD35,000 | **GEELONG** | 1312m

11	<b>RUSSIAN DUCHESS</b>	Returns for second campaign (12-weeks). Broke maiden at Geelong in her first preparation. One for exotics fresh in this company.
1	<b>BRUTALINA</b>	Won a 1325m Benchmark 62 at Geelong two back. Couldn't find enough under the big weight 2yo+ (Bm62) at Pakenham. On pacer. Claiming apprentice engaged again.
4	<b>ZORRO'S FLIGHT</b>	Resuming (18-weeks). Ex Patrick & Michelle Payne in Victoria. Fresh form sound without winning. Keeping safe at stable debut.
5	<b>GODTFRED KIRK</b>	Reserved at back and gave late chase into second at Pakenham at first run for new trainer. Wet form - soft (4:1-1-0); untested heavy. Fitter second-up and the longer trip helps. Could give some cheek at odds.
