

**RACE 1 11:00 AM | AUD32,000 | SEYMOUR | 1000m**

<b>13</b>	<b>PROFILE</b>	Returns for second campaign (39-weeks). Should have matured. Encouraging debut performance on a soft deck at Gosford. Werribee jump-out winner 27/3. Major player.
<b>3</b>	<b>BOYD</b>	Promising I Am Invincible 3-year-old. Was a valiant but vanquished third in the 3yo+ Mdn at Yarra Glen. Strips fitter second run back. Good gate speed, soft draw. Must be considered.
<b>1</b>	<b>BAD BLOOD</b>	Trials (3:2-1-0). Dirty Work gelding making his debut. Recent winner of a Flemington jump-out. Can make a winning debut.
<b>10</b>	<b>WEASEL SEA</b>	Now 4 weeks between runs. Building nicely. Sent forward and stuck to the task bravely in the 3yo+ Mdn Plate at Yarra Glen at his second race start. Scope for improvement.

**RACE 2 11:30 AM | AUD32,000 | SEYMOUR | 1000m**

<b>7</b>	<b>BACK UP BARBIE</b>	Back to the track for second campaign (14-weeks). Acquitted self well with debut placing at Stony Creek 30 Dec. Improved by experience. Expecting a prominent showing fresh in this line-up.
<b>18</b>	<b>UNRIDDLER</b>	Honest maiden who continues to race competitively. Really good run coming from the back in 3yo+ Mdn Plate at Pakenham. Warrants attention.
<b>12</b>	<b>JUMPIN' JEWELLETTE</b>	Outgunned but did enough for third at \$10 at Pakenham at last start this journey. Can show early speed. Super fit from racing and right in the mix.
<b>14</b>	<b>SPIRIT OF GAIA</b>	Started \$9 when battled home in Maiden company at Pakenham. Placed only other visit to Seymour. Worth a look.

**RACE 3 12:00 PM | AUD32,000 | SEYMOUR | 1300m**

<b>3</b>	<b>DISCOVER LUPINO</b>	Encouraging debut performance at Cranbourne 20 Mar. Should come on. Commands attention here.
<b>10</b>	<b>AMEDEI</b>	Back for second campaign (24-weeks). Given time to mature. Tested in stakes company in first prep. Big show fresh in this affair.
<b>11</b>	<b>CHLOE FIRST</b>	Been supported at each run. Solid rally into the placings at Kyneton when in the market. Can make her presence felt with even luck.
<b>12</b>	<b>CUMULATE</b>	Gave a sight on debut at Echuca 21 Mar. Improved by experience. Can challenge.

**RACE 4 12:30 PM | AUD32,000 | SEYMOUR | 1600m**

<b>14</b>	<b>PANDA'S SPECTRUM</b>	Lightly raced Fiorente 3 year-old showing some potential. Ran on soundly into second in the small field at Cranbourne at her second race start. Drawn well. Stripping fitter and form good enough for this.
<b>3</b>	<b>WHATTA MAN</b>	No match but kept on for a distant third in the 4yo+ Mdn Plate at Sale when off an extended spell. Fitter second-up. Drawn to get an economic trail. Right in this.
<b>6</b>	<b>IRELAND'S TEARS</b>	Relinquished lead but did enough to place in the 3yo Mdn Plate at Kilmore. Can challenge.
<b>10</b>	<b>ENCHANTED LASS</b>	Odds of \$6.50 when made the frame at Kyneton 28 Mar. Among the dangers with even breaks.

**RACE 5 1:00 PM | AUD22,000 | SEYMOUR | 1600m**

4	<b>RYANMAN</b>	Just missed at Kyneton 13 Mar. No match but enough in the tank to place at Cranbourne at last start this journey. Gets the gun run. Highly rated in this line-up.
3	<b>PRO AUSSIE</b>	Run down in the shadows after giving a good kick at Kilmore in second run from spell. Ready to peak third-up. Leads, handy. Makes strong appeal.
7	<b>WAMBEEN</b>	Led, toyed with his rivals in the small field at Kilmore when in the market. Advantaged if soft. Leads, handy. Up in weight for that win but doubt that will be enough to prevent another bold performance.
1	<b>CRYPTIC CLUE</b>	Chasing hat-trick. Sheer display of grit and determination at Bairnsdale at this distance. Form sound this track and distance and a proven weight carrier. Among the dangers.

**RACE 6 1:30 PM | AUD22,000 | SEYMOUR | 1400m**

1	<b>FREAK OF NATURE</b>	Settled handy and responded well in choppy conditions to fill the minors at Sale. Right in this.
8	<b>SNAPPY PIERRO</b>	Got a stitch late after leading in the small field at Cranbourne. Nice gate. Rates highly.
5	<b>BEAUTIFULLY</b>	Fresh. Cleared maiden ranks at Terang 20 Feb. On pace and surrendered in the field of 7 at Sandown-Hillside at second run back. Has gate speed.
10	<b>MISS HIMALAYA</b>	Prominent and showed plenty of ticker to just go under in thrilling finish in the Hcp (56) at Kyneton. Nicely weighted. Drawn to effect. Worth a look.

**RACE 7 2:00 PM | AUD22,000 | SEYMOUR | 1200m**

4	<b>SNAPPY TYCOON</b>	Prominent and stuck to his guns at Kyneton. Leads, handy. Right in the mix.
1	<b>DANI CALIFORNIA</b>	First-up (12-weeks). Ex M Price & M Kent Jnr in Victoria. Just missed at Stony Creek 30 Dec. Won at Wangaratta when fresh last campaign while tuned with a 3rd at a Heath trial. In the mix.
8	<b>THE BANTAM</b>	Never a threat after showing no early speed from the barriers at Kyneton at first run back. Fitter second-up. Decent alley. Only win to date was this distance. In the mix.
7	<b>RATTLE'N'ROLL</b>	Let-up (63-days). Ex M, W & J Hawkes in Victoria. On pace but soon under pressure and he knocked up badly at Caulfield Heath over this trip. Drawn to get an economic trail. Worth a look.

**RACE 8 2:30 PM | AUD22,000 | SEYMOUR | 1200m**

3	<b>THUNDER HAWK</b>	4 weeks since last run. Went close at Cranbourne two back 27 Feb. Never a threat after showing no early speed from the barriers at Cranbourne. Look for a marked improvement here.
8	<b>ICHIBERU</b>	Genuine campaigner. Just missed at Stony Creek 8 Mar. Found enough to place at Cranbourne at this distance. Nice gate. Each way claims.
2	<b>SMARTICON</b>	Fresh. Knuckled down strongly from back half to salute in the 3yo+ Hcp (56) Restricted 56 1112m at Geelong. Right in this.
9	<b>WHERE'S MY SOCK</b>	Well rated in front and kept on to win at Ararat at second run back. Drawn to receive every chance. Neil Farley retains the ride. Warrants some thought.

**RACE 9 3:00 PM | AUD22,000 | SEYMOUR | 1000m**

5	<b>TORONADO BOOM</b>	First-up (15-weeks). Placed this course first-up last campaign. 2nd & 1st at recent Flemington jump-outs. Among the dangers on return.
7	<b>MAGIC LEPRECHAUN</b>	Worked home well at Kyneton last start. Backmarker who should be finding the line again. Each way.
2	<b>REWARD THA MASTER</b>	Unhurried early before letting down with some conviction at Bendigo over this distance. Strikes a race he can win.
8	<b>MOAKSUN</b>	Got back and wasn't totally disgraced at Ballarat at first run off a long break. Strips fitter second run back. Good gate. Placed only other visit to Seymour. Place claims.
