

**RACE 1** 10:28 AM | AUD23,000 | CAIRNS | 950m

6	<b>SWEET 'N' ELITE</b>	Let-up (64-days). Lightly raced and still learning the caper. Sent out \$61 when unable to threaten in choppy conditions this venue when off an extended spell. Capable of making an impact fresh in this affair with even luck.

2	<b>TOP CALIBRE</b>	Trailed, even finish at Seymour in second run from spell. Fitter for those two runs and ready to show best. Can bounce back into contention.
10	<b>ZUNNA</b>	First-up (29-weeks). Tried up super at Caulfield Heath 30 Apr and is a first-up winner. Right in the mix fresh in this line-up.
8	<b>MONGOLIAN GOBI</b>	Sets out for second campaign (24-weeks). Maturity upside. Ex D T O'Brien in Victoria. Easy winner at Sale first-up last prep while prepared for return with a Caulfield Heath trial.
