

**RACE 1 11:30 AM | AUD32,000 | SWAN HILL | 975m**

8	<b>YUUKI</b>	Surely not far from a first win. Sent forward, whacked away for the minors Mdn Plate at Bendigo. Strips fitter second run back. On pacer.
5	<b>SCOOBARTIE</b>	Back for second campaign (22-weeks). Will have furnished. Placed at Echuca first-up last campaign. Worth a look fresh in this line-up.
4	<b>PARAK</b>	First run under new trainer went home tamely at Seymour at \$18. Can play a role.
2	<b>HOPES 'N' DREAMS</b>	Trials (1:0-0-0). Soft in trial work but might show more under race conditions. Odds may prove best guide here.

**RACE 2 12:00 PM | AUD32,000 | SWAN HILL | 1200m**

8	<b>RED LIGHT RACHEL</b>	Now 4 weeks between runs. Ex G Portelli in NSW. Worked home solidly at Orange. Makes a strong case in this company.
2	<b>KILMER</b>	Let-up (75-days). Trimmed margin late at Albury second-up. Since trialed at Echuca 16 Feb. Can have a major say fresh in this line-up with even breaks.
6	<b>CELTIC LIGHT</b>	Raced in back half and was never in a position to mount a serious challenge at Stawell. Drops back a notch in trip. Among the dangers.
5	<b>APPLE EYES</b>	Set for second campaign (22-weeks). Strengthened up. Can find a few lengths in this line-up.

**RACE 3 12:30 PM | AUD32,000 | SWAN HILL | 1300m**

1	<b>BAIE DE SEINE</b>	Unraced 3yo by Omaha Beach and out of the Free Eagle mare Flash Of Light. Bears close watching.
3	<b>CHEERS TO US</b>	Latest attempt this journey when led from pillar to near the post in the Mdn Plate here. Claiming apprentice engaged again. On pacer. Hard fit and worth a look.
4	<b>CONISTON SPICE</b>	Inexperienced but promising Warhorse 4 year-old. Ran on late from the back at Hamilton in only her second race appearance. Sharper now and commands attention here.
7	<b>CAPE RADSTOCK</b>	Got back and wasn't totally disgraced at Bendigo in second run from spell. Jumps from better barrier. Can challenge.

**RACE 4 1:00 PM | AUD32,000 | SWAN HILL | 2400m**

7	<b>BAUDIN</b>	Went home tamely at Warracknabeal at \$16. First try at 2400m. Capable of making an impact.
8	<b>MY ROSALIE</b>	Started \$201 when safely held in Open company at Caulfield over this trip. Back from Stakes company. Rates highly.
4	<b>CELTIC PARK</b>	Debut effort fair in spread-out finish at Warracknabeal 4 Apr. Big hike in distance at second start. Highly rated in this line-up.
1	<b>LUCKY CHANCE</b>	Did little in choppy conditions at Hamilton over a longer test. Coming back in distance should suit. Big show.

**RACE 5 1:30 PM | AUD27,000 | SWAN HILL | 2400m**

1	<b>FLASHLIGHT</b>	Capable stayer. In touch and fought on dauntlessly this track at first run for new trainer. Unbeaten at track and distance. Form good enough for this.
2	<b>PRINCE PINOT</b>	Striving for hat-trick. Fought hard on the speed to bag the (Bm62) at Kilmore in second run from spell. Can lead or take a sit. Can continue on his winning way.
7	<b>DONEGAL SOUL</b>	Terrific effort when just shaded this track 12 Apr. Key player.
8	<b>FINAL QUARTER</b>	Handy and acquitted herself fairly well at Kyneton. Rise to 2400m a new challenge. Not out of this.
