

**RACE 1** 9:30 AM | AUD42,500 | **CRANBOURNE** | 1600m

3	<b>OBON</b>	On a short back-up. Displayed early promise. Competitive in metro company two back 27 May. In the minor spoils at Caulfield Heath Wednesday. Hard to beat if backs up.
1	<b>DETERMINATO</b>	Solid run Mdn Plate at Wodonga 16 May. Failed to threaten in rain affected going at Kilmore over a longer test when in the market. Good gate helps. Right in this.
7	<b>EXPANDING POWER</b>	Well back and made limited headway at Sale. Usually gets back. Distance increase suits. Well placed to make an impact here.
4	<b>REEL DEADLY</b>	From top stable however had a low-key debut at Moe 28 May. Wiser for it. Should have more to offer.

**RACE 2** 10:00 AM | AUD42,500 | **CRANBOURNE** | 1000m

12	<b>MIRADOR</b>	Returning for second campaign (20-weeks). In the minors at Flemington on debut last campaign. First time back in a country Maiden. Should take plenty of beating fresh.
9	<b>ETERNAL JOY</b>	Kicks off second campaign (28-weeks). Wasn't all that far from the action on debut at Geelong when in the market 4 Dec. Better for the run. Worth a look fresh in this affair.
15	<b>PORTINARI</b>	Fronting up for second campaign (19-weeks). Offered little to catch the eye when debut at Caulfield 7 Feb. Learnt plenty there. Can figure with expected progression.
1	<b>CAPITAL STORM</b>	Trials (2:1-0-1). With the astute Philip Stokes stable and it's all systems go for this colt after winning a 900m trial at Caulfield Heath. Lachlan Neindorf sticks from latest trial. Tough draw but should be highly competitive.

**RACE 3** 10:30 AM | AUD55,000 | **CRANBOURNE** | 1200m

2	<b>BLUE SHIELD</b>	Bursting to win. Run down in the shadows after a giving a kick from on pace in the 3yo Mdn Plate at Mornington over this distance. Tactical speed, inside draw. Commands respect here.
10	<b>LEVRIER</b>	Excellent debut performance when just nabbed at Moe at \$3.30. Has scope. Extra ground may help. Worth a look.
3	<b>CALEXPO</b>	Trials (1:0-0-0). Hasn't set the world on fire at the trials but might show more under race conditions. Nice gate for first outing. Worth a look on debut.
11	<b>MARCH ON BY</b>	Returns for second campaign (19-weeks). Well down the track at Caulfield on debut as a despised outsider. Learnt plenty there. Latest trial was solid enough. Can make his presence felt fresh in this line-up.

**RACE 4** 10:50 AM | AUD32,000 | **BALLARAT SYNTHETIC** | 1100m

11	<b>MIGHTY EMPRESS</b>	First starter by leading Victorian sire Written Tycoon and out of the Not A Single Doubt mare Mightily. Been good in jumpouts Nice race to kick off in.
12	<b>SPIRITED DEE</b>	Cost 40K. Unraced 2yo by Fierce Impact and out of the Written Tycoon mare Nota Bene. Won recent jumpout and looks to have talent.
2	<b>CALL ME MAURA</b>	Signalled some ability on debut at Swan Hill 5 Jun. Benefits from the experience. Top chance to go one better.
5	<b>FINNISH GIRL</b>	Chased in a good effort at Geelong. Handles the trip and finds a winnable race.

**RACE 5** 11:05 AM | AUD42,500 | **CRANBOURNE** | 2025m

5	<b>LILLARD</b>	Sent forward and stuck to the task bravely in soft going in the 3yo+ Mdn Plate at Werribee. Gets the gun run. Switching back to 2025m should suit. Right in this.
9	<b>SEINFELD</b>	Early form encouraging. Led, dug deep into his reserves but shaded late over 1600m in the Mdn Plate at Seymour in only his second race appearance. Significantly up in distance. Heading the right way and competitive here.
12	<b>I BELIEVE I BELONG</b>	Racing with merit. Picked up strongly from back half at Kilmore when in the market. Shapes as a major player.
1	<b>BANK HEIST</b>	Form around the mark. Every hope but the big weight told at Sale. Leads, handy. Stamina on trial here.

**RACE 6** 11:25 AM | AUD32,000 | **BALLARAT SYNTHETIC** | 1500m

7	<b>FOREVER JEUNE</b>	Great run at Geelong 22 May. Battled home in heavy ground (wide draw) at Geelong when in the market. First time synthetic. All the better and not out of it.
5	<b>SPOT THE GREY</b>	Okay at latest when settled back. Usually gets back. Others rate stronger.
12	<b>SARAYA</b>	Just missed at Corowa 1 Jun. Not disgraced in 4yo+ Mdn Plate at Swan Hill at \$8. Should be prominent. Chronic non-winner.
10	<b>L'I'L MISS DRAMA</b>	Shown promise in limited runs. Terrific effort when just shaded at Swan Hill 7 Jun. Comes back in trip a touch. Top chance to go one better.

**RACE 7** 11:40 AM | AUD42,500 | **CRANBOURNE** | 1400m

3	<b>IMPACTICAL</b>	Due for a win. Game effort at Hamilton when up to its hocks in mud over this trip. Rates highly in this affair.
5	<b>THE QUIET IMMORTAL</b>	On a quick back-up. Finished within striking distance Mdn Plate at Wangaratta in second run from spell under betting interest. Can have a major say.
1	<b>BARKING MAD</b>	First-up (21-weeks). Unplaced but has run some cheeky races. Drawn favourably. Among the dangers fresh in this company back at country level.
12	<b>CIRQUE DE COCO</b>	Fought on like a lion only to succumb late in the 2yo Mdn at Geelong in only her second race appearance. Better for experience and can build on that. Both totes.

**RACE 8** 12:00 PM | AUD32,000 | **BALLARAT SYNTHETIC** | 2100m

4	<b>KING'S ANCHOR</b>	Showing some promise. Great run at Bendigo 13 May. Stationed around midfield, positive response gaining late ground at Swan Hill at second run back. Added journey should assist.
1	<b>CAMELOT TIME</b>	4 weeks since last run. Showing some early promise and been in the market each outing. Great run at Ballarat 10 May. Upped in distance when ran on okay without troubling on a soft deck at Seymour.
7	<b>SPICY APPLE</b>	Competitive type. Brave in defeat 3yo+ Mdn Plate at Swan Hill over a longer test. First time synthetic. Switching to 2100m.
12	<b>SWAN DANCE</b>	London Bridge mare who has displayed some early ability. Prominent and went down fighting in rain affected ground in the Maiden company at Casterton at her second race start. Improver, fitter third-up. First real test of stamina here.

**RACE 9** 12:15 PM | AUD35,000 | **CRANBOURNE** | 1400m

2	<b>GOLDEN SPRITZ</b>	Fresh. Just missed at Cranbourne 24 Apr. Not disgraced in 2yo+ Hcp (C1) at Bendigo in second run from spell at \$5.50. Breaks from a low barrier.
4	<b>ILLUMINANCE</b>	First-up (23-weeks). Reasonably consistent. Saluted here first-up last prep. Senior rider takes over.
11	<b>YES MAXI</b>	Given time to freshen up after 1st-up run. Very tame performance on a soft deck at Seymour at first run back. Lone victory was over this trip. Can challenge.
12	<b>ALZARO</b>	Came home hot on their heels to grab third 2yo+ (Bm62) at Bendigo over this distance. This looks very achievable.

**RACE 10** 12:40 PM | AUD22,000 | **BALLARAT SYNTHETIC** | 2200m

1	<b>SOLDIER BOI</b>	Started \$12 when safely held in Open company in rain affected ground at Flemington. First time synthetic. More ground a plus. Will take stopping in this company.
2	<b>JAZ TYCOON</b>	Outgunned but did enough for third at \$14 at Mt Gambier. Rise to 2200m a new challenge. Hard to warm to.
7	<b>TRADEWORX</b>	Fresh. Made short work of the small field in the 3yo+ Hcp (56) at Wodonga. Proven synthetic performer. Can show up again at fair odds.
8	<b>VIVID BLOOMS</b>	4 weeks since last run. Shouldered 67.5kg to victory at Kyneton. Failed to flatter at Mildura. Unexposed at trip.

**RACE 11 12:55 PM | AUD35,000 | CRANBOURNE | 2025m**

4	<b>RAINSUN</b>	Settled close and responded strongly at Geelong at his second race start. Suited by the longer assignment now. All the better and looks a serious player.
1	<b>NEARCO FROD</b>	Issued decent challenge in sticky going 3yo+ (Bm62) at Pakenham when off an extended spell. Will be better for the outing and takes a 2kg claim. Right in this.
8	<b>OUTDRIVE</b>	Cleared maiden ranks at Pakenham 22 May. Handy and acquitted himself fairly well at Seymour. Right in the mix.
13	<b>ADIRA RIVER</b>	Better than ever. At her most dominant taking out the 2yo+ Mdn Plate on a H10 at Hamilton. Stamina on trial here. Among the dangers again.

**RACE 12 1:20 PM | AUD22,000 | BALLARAT SYNTHETIC | 1400m**

6	<b>ELVIS</b>	On pace but conceded late at Kilmore after speccing from \$14 into \$9.50. First time synthetic. Can make his presence felt if he gets the breaks.
18	<b>LUCKY COMPASS</b>	Let-up (58-days). Reasonably consistent. Just missed at Geelong 10 Apr. Valiant effort saw him just miss the placings at Werribee.
4	<b>BLACKLIP</b>	Cleared maiden ranks at Wodonga 16 May. Settled back and always among the cab-catchers at Kilmore. Can show more here.
11	<b>SHAY'S WAY</b>	Settled midfield, no meaningful impression at Mornington. Could surprise.

**RACE 13 1:35 PM | AUD35,000 | CRANBOURNE | 1600m**

11	<b>IMPONDERABLE</b>	Went close at Seymour 21 May. Led, clearly outgunned late but stuck on for third in the (Bm66) at Mornington. On pacer. Looks a serious player.
13	<b>OMNIC</b>	Just missed at Nowra 24 May. No threat to winner but ran on for the minors in rain affected going at Donald. Lands in a suitable contest.
8	<b>FEARLESS WRITER</b>	Well back and never a factor in sticky going at Pakenham. Added journey should assist. Among the dangers.
3	<b>ENCHANTED JENNI</b>	Let-up (52-days). Finished out the back at Ballarat over a longer assignment as an odds drifter. Since won a Caulfield Heath trial 11 Jun. A distance specialist.

**RACE 14 2:00 PM | AUD27,000 | BALLARAT SYNTHETIC | 1200m**

5	<b>AUDIO POP CAM</b>	Back for second campaign (23-weeks). Given time to mature. Did a terrific job in her first campaign. Key contender fresh in this line-up with even luck.
6	<b>BON'S BLING</b>	Fronting up for second campaign (32-weeks). Won 2 of 4 starts in first campaign. Indicated talent winning twice in her debut campaign. Winner at track and distance.
11	<b>ANGELOS</b>	Given time to freshen up after 1st-up run. Settled back and didn't figure in soft going when off an extended spell in the 2yo+ (Bm56) at Kilmore. Usually gets back.
9	<b>BAMA SLAMA</b>	Last start this trip went home tamely at Mornington at \$7.50. One for multiples.

**RACE 15 2:15 PM | AUD35,000 | CRANBOURNE | 1000m**

2	<b>KILLIANA</b>	Won the Vobis Gold Rush Bendigo 12 Apr 2025. Last start this trip reasonable effort without seriously threatening in rain affected going at Caulfield Heath. Ready to peak third-up. Sharper now and makes a strong case in this company.
9	<b>HUSTLE IN HEELS</b>	Rider found a forward spot at Mornington but she put in a very lacklustre finish at first run off a long break. Will be better for the outing. Winner at only other start at Cranbourne. Warrants attention.
13	<b>STELLAR MOFEED</b>	Went close at Pakenham 22 May. Worked on the speed and just missed in the Hcp (62) at Ballarat. On pacer, perfect gate. Well into preparation now and not out of this.
1	<b>HARMONETT</b>	Just missed at Mornington 18 Apr. Couldn't find enough under the big weight (Bm66) at Mornington at this trip. Barrier hurts but possesses early toe. Super fit from racing and worth a look.

**RACE 16** 2:35 PM | AUD22,000 | **BALLARAT SYNTHETIC** | 1000m

3	<b>SECRET HELL</b>	Fresh. Restrained and really let down late for an eye-catching second at Werribee at this distance. Could get into the placings.
1	<b>HUGHIE</b>	First-up (19-weeks). Form solid last time in. Fresh form solid without winning. Awkwardly drawn but has enough speed.
4	<b>DOC'S NIPPER</b>	Started \$5 when battled home in Benchmark 56 company on a soft deck at Werribee. Winner this trip. Can make his presence felt.
5	<b>FOX MAN</b>	Now 4 weeks between runs. Prominent to 400m but threw the towel in quickly at Stawell in second run from spell. Leads, handy. First time synthetic.
