

RACE 1 10:05 AM | \$120,000 | ROSEHILL | 1300m

6	SOLITARIO	First-up (23-weeks). Given two trials and has placed first-up. Suited by some give underfoot. Can make his presence felt.
8	HALO PHENOMENA	Quickly working through his grades. Crossed to race forward, gave solid kick and fought on bravely for 0.9 lengths victory at Tamworth 13 Feb. Drops in weight for this. Drawn to get an economic trail.
11	ROSE AYE	Gave good account when 1 length 4th at Randwick when in the market. Makes a strong case in this company.
1	HIGHWAY STRIP	Under a hold, only battled home at Randwick in second run from spell. Only for wider exotics.
15	SHEZAIN	Third run now in new stable/region. Lining up for three wins on the trot. Impressive coming from back half to score at Sapphire Coast in second run from spell. Gets in light.

RACE 2 10:40 AM | \$160,000 | ROSEHILL | 1100m

13	PRIDE TO FOLLOW	First-up (37-weeks). First run new state/stable. Drawn to get a conservative run and performs well at home. Market watch advised in first run for new stable.
6	EAGLE EXPRESS	Midfield, overhauled them for a strong win this track at first run back. Winner at only other start at Rosehill. Will be fitter second-up. Nice gate.
8	RUNLIKENENCRYPTION	Put in a long run from the back for second in a Benchmark 70 at Caulfield. Worth a look.
12	THAMES	Ridden back, battled home without threatening at Warwick Farm at first run for new trainer. Down significantly in weight. Will be fitter second-up. Can play a role.
1	BEV'S NINE	Given time to freshen up after 1st-up run. In stellar form. Ran on well to bag a 1.4 lengths win in the 4yo+ (Bm78) this track. Since trialed at Canterbury 6 Feb.

RACE 3 11:00 AM | \$30,000 | MUDGEES | 1100m

6	CURIE	Been supported at each run. Enough in the tank to place at Kembla Grange at first run back. Remains at 1100m. Fully primed. Strikes a winnable race.
2	CLAUDIO	Trials (1:0-0-0). Prepared with a 900m barrier trial at Rosehill on 23 Dec. Follow betting leads.
8	TIGLETTA	Displayed early promise. Picked up intently to just miss in the 2,3yo Mdn Plate at Gosford in second run from spell. Ready to peak third-up. Key player.
3	FOOLISH NOTION	Trials (2:0-1-0). Pierata gelding heading into debut with two lead-up trials. Betting may tell the tale.
5	MAGIC IRIS	Back to the track for second campaign (21-weeks). Has a tricky draw. Hard to warm to.

RACE 4 11:15 AM | \$160,000 | ROSEHILL | 1300m

4	EMIRATE	Resuming (16-weeks). Given two trials. Locally trained but awkwardly drawn. Minor money hope at best fresh in this affair.
17	STORMLAND	Couldn't quite peg back winner here. Right in the mix.
12	LA ROJA	Prominent and showed plenty of ticker to just go under in thrilling finish in the 4yo+ M (Bm78) at Randwick at second run back. Drawn to get a conservative run. Could get into the placings.
6	CAPTAIN FURAI	Given time to freshen up after 1st-up run. Brave in defeat 1 length third 3yo+ (Bm78) at Randwick at resumption. Adept heavy/proven track. Fitter second-up.
13	TRANSCEND	First-up (16-weeks). Second run now in Australia Ex-NZ. Given two trials and has placed first-up. One for exotics fresh in this affair.

RACE 5 11:35 AM | \$35,000 | **MUDGE** | 1200m

2	THE CONTRACTOR	Primed to strike. Sent forward and stuck to the task bravely in the Mdn at Dubbo in second run from spell. Better draw here. This looks within his reach.
5	FLYING TRUFFLES	On a quick back-up. Strong SP profile. Failed to run on in the small field at Beaumont in only her second race appearance. Among the dangers.
6	GYRA	Third run now in new stable/region. Knocking on the door. Ran home into the minors on a soft deck Country Boosted Mdn at Beaumont second-up. Good draw.
1	FOOLISH NOTION	Trials (2:0-1-0). Pierata gelding heading into debut with two lead-up trials. Market may prove a more fruitful guide.
3	VELKA	Started \$2.70, fighting out the finish at Muswellbrook. Could give some cheek at odds.

3	MAGNATEAR	Fresh. Latest attempt this journey when brave effort in busy finish at Gold Coast at this trip. Drawn to effect. Highly rated in this line-up.
2	LORD PENMAN	Import returning for second Australian campaign (16-weeks). Placed 100% first-up while fitted with 2 Rosehill trials. A distance specialist. Handles all conditions.
1	PALMETTO	Let-up (70-days). Sent back and finished with a full head of steam in Open company at Randwick over a longer assignment. Had two trials since. Minor money hope at best fresh in this line-up.
7	AGE OF SAIL	Went down narrowly in the small field at Warwick Farm over a longer test. Coming back in distance. Since trialled at Beaumont 12 Feb. Worth a look.
6	THUNDERLIPS	Went close at Randwick two back. Sent out \$9.50 when laboured to finish 6th at Randwick. At optimum distance. Can lead or take a sit.

RACE 7 12:10 PM | \$35,000 | **MUDGE** | 1200m

1	BOSCO	Broke maiden at Moruya 23 Jan. Wasn't beaten far at Goulburn. This looks very winnable.
10	STATE OF GRACE	Not disgraced at Dubbo. Drawn to receive every chance. Right in the mix.
3	WOLF BAY	Not disgraced in Country Boosted (Bm58) at Dubbo at first run off a long break at \$21. Will be fitter second-up. Can challenge.
4	DUSTY VERMEER	On a quick back-up. Started \$101 when safely held in Class 1 company at Dubbo second-up. Drawn to get a conservative run. Can be thereabouts.
6	BRAVE XENA	Made immediate impact on the track with a convincing win at Nowra 8 Feb. Solid hope if butters up from debut.

RACE 8 12:25 PM | \$300,000 | **ROSEHILL** | 1100m

2	HIDRIX	Burst onto the scene winning the Canonbury Stakes here last month. Exciting colt. Rates highly.
9	SHIKI	Now 5 weeks between runs. Form to date solid. Big debut win at the Gold Coast. Beat half the field home in the Magic Millions at \$6.50. Smart trial winner. Key player.
5	SAVAGE LOOK	Scone debut winner then no match for first two who cleared out but ran on bravely for third in the Lonhro. Each way.
1	INCOGNITO	Breeder's Plate winner. Prominent but unable to sustain bid (poor recovery) this venue in only his second race appearance. Can bounce back.
4	CONFEDERATION	Straight into the black book after a terrific debut placing behind Hidrix in the Canonbury Stakes. McDonald on again and drawn to receive every chance. Can turn the tables.

RACE 9 12:45 PM | \$30,000 | MUDGEY | 1850m

9	HOORINI	All honours in the small field at Dubbo over a longer assignment. Switching to 1850m. Highly rated in this line-up.
2	WILL TO EXCEL	Experienced campaigner. Secured third in a staggered finish at Orange. Switching to 1850m. Usually gets back.
5	EVER WAS	Honest battler. Quietly handled in back half, shaken up and finished full of running for 1.5 lengths 4th at Canberra. Rates highly.
4	TOULON FACTOR	Seasoned performer. And only overhauled late at Walcha. Claiming apprentice engaged again. Brings pace and stamina and 3kg helps the cause.
1	FLASHY ICON	Real tradesman. Kept coming and just fell short at Canberra. Very fit and among the dangers.

12	SIBAAQ	Freshened. Worked on the speed and just missed in the (Open) at Gold Coast. Experienced rider replaces apprentice. Brings pace and stamina and a nice weight drop.
16	UNLIMITED	Won a 2100m Benchmark 88 at Wyong two back. Mediocre performance after settling handy at Randwick. Has a few runs under his belt this campaign and warrants attention.
15	SAM HAWKENS	Resuming (18-weeks). Ex W J Haggas in NSW. Brought on with two trial hitouts and has placed first-up. Sound claims.
1	JUST FINE	First-up (44-weeks). Proven fresh and looks fit for return to racing. Handles all conditions. Leads, handy.
8	CAMPALDINO	Import returning for second Australian campaign (36-weeks). In stellar form. Has performed well previously first-up without winning although wasn't asked to do much in lead in trials. Highly fancied for a winning return.

1	HARBOUR GOLD	First run under new trainer on pace, not beaten far at Walcha when in the market. Will be fitter second-up and takes a 2kg claim. On pacer. Can make his presence felt.

3	WODETON	Gave a good sight making the frame at Randwick at resumption when in the market. Fitter second-up. Can make his presence felt.
2	ATTICA	Back to the track for second campaign (17-weeks). Broke through at the highest level winning the Group 1 Spring Champion last time in. Brought to race fitness with 3 trials. Did a terrific job in his first campaign.

12	COMMANDO JACK	Puts in every start. Sent forward and stuck to the task bravely in testing conditions in the Country Boosted (Bm58) at Muswellbrook. Has form this track and distance and races well at home. Proven record wet/track and performs well at home.
5	CROWN LEGEND	Gunnedah winner two back. Raced in back half and was never in a position to mount a serious challenge at Rosehill. Can make his presence felt.
13	GHAZNAVI	On a quick back-up. Went home tamely at Dubbo at \$4.40. Switching to 1400m. Sound claims.
1	WASTED DAYS	Got back and wasn't totally disgraced at Randwick. New to Mudgee. Awkwardly drawn and a hefty impost. Only for wider exotics.

RACE 14 2:15 PM | \$300,000 | ROSEHILL | 1300m

1	LAZZURA	Resuming (16-weeks). Proven fresh and looks fit for return to racing. Highly fancied for a winning return.
8	CINSAULT	Aiming for hat-trick. Scrubbed up from the wide gate and boxed on bravely for a 0.6 lengths win at Randwick. More suitable draw and races well at home. Key player.
11	MARETH	Let-up (55-days). Third outing for new trainer/ this region. Broke maiden at Canterbury 12 Dec. Ran on soundly into second in the small field at Gosford in second run from spell.
