

**RACE 1 10:20 AM | \$30,000 | BALLINA | 1300m**

3	DEODEE	Void of early speed but she let down strongly into the placings in Maiden company at Grafton. Since trialled at Grafton Sep 30. Drawn to receive every chance. One for exotics.
2	FLAMING GENESIS	Back to the track for second campaign (21-weeks). First run new state/stable. Bears close watching at first country assignment.
9	TRAVELLER	Got back and ran on late for 3.2 lengths 4th at Grafton. Awkwardly drawn. Minor money hope at best.
5	MISS GRAYSEA	Went home tamely at Taree at \$26. Very fit and warrants attention.

4	JEWELS STATEMENT	Seldom puts in a bad one. Led and held sway to win at Grafton. Gate a worry. Can be thereabouts.
7	IOBJECT	Battled home at Grafton. Not as well drawn this time. Sound claims.
5	MISSY NO NAY	Gold Coast winner two back. On pace but folded up quickly at Beaudesert. On pacer. Each-way.

3	RISK FOR REWARD	Got back and ran on late for 3.1 lengths 6th at Grafton. Proven record wet/track. Can be thereabouts.
2	VIADELAMORE	Not disgraced in 3yo+ (Bm58) at Grafton over a longer test at \$7. Drops to shorter trip. This looks very winnable.
6	GIOIA RIVER	First run for new trainer went home tamely at Grafton at \$12. Better draw here. Has a few runs under her belt this campaign and can challenge.

**RACE 4 12:05 PM | \$27,000 | BALLINA | 1590m**

1	LAUNCHER	Steps out for third run new stable/region. Close-up of late. Engaged pace when a valiant but vanquished second in the Mdn Plate at Eagle Farm at second run back. Fitter, has scope to progress.
14	SHARE TRADER	Never looked a serious threat in the small field at Doomben. Drops to shorter trip. Breaks from a low barrier. Can be thereabouts.
12	RIGHTEOUS BROTHER	Ran on late from the back at Lismore. Usually gets back. Can play a role.
4	ICEWATER	Coming off a career best placing. Came home with a wet sail to grab third Showcase Mdn at Lismore at odds of \$4.80. Fit from racing and right in the mix.
13	SEA ME DANCE	Form sound without seriously threatening. Got back and wasn't totally disgraced at Doomben at first run for new trainer. Fitter second-up. Drawn to get a conservative run.

<b>2</b>	<b>BETTA THAN PRESLEY</b>	Winner too strong but ran on for the minors at Lismore. Drops to shorter trip. Gets a nice sit from gate 2. Warrants attention.
<b>11</b>	<b>LOVECATS</b>	Let-up (47-days). First run new state/stable. Strong SP profile. Failed to run on in the small field at Ballarat Synthetic in second run from spell.
<b>7</b>	<b>ANOTHER CASHIE</b>	Trials (5:0-1-4). By Castelvechio and making his career debut after showing fair ability in latest Doomben trial. Nice race to kick off in.
<b>1</b>	<b>BABY RYAN</b>	Kicks off second campaign (19-weeks). Can fill the minors here fresh in this affair.
<b>3</b>	<b>BOOMTIME NOW</b>	Resuming after a (73-weeks) spell. First run new state/stable. Improved by tidy debut performance at Warwick May 9 2024. Only for wider exotics fresh in this affair.

<b>12</b>	<b>KEIKO SAY</b>	On target for hat-trick. Prominent and scooted clear to a 2.3 lengths victory at Coffs Harbour Sep 14. Possesses high speed. Rates highly.
<b>1</b>	<b>LOVEWILLCOMELATER</b>	Steps out for third run new stable/region. Couldn't quite peg back winner at Grafton. Locally trained but awkwardly drawn this time. Has a few runs under his belt this campaign and one for multiples.
<b>2</b>	<b>WRITTEN FAME</b>	5 weeks since last run. Knocking on the door of late. Settled handy and knuckled down with purpose to fill the minors at Ipswich when drifted in betting. Experienced rider replaces apprentice.
<b>9</b>	<b>VACILLATION</b>	Puts in every start. Prominent and went down fighting in the Class 3 company at Beaudesert first up. Strips fitter second run back. Can lead or take a sit.
<b>13</b>	<b>NEED FOR SPIETH</b>	Fired up to lead and kept on valiantly at Grafton. Has a tricky draw. This looks stronger.

<b>6</b>	<b>VIVALDA</b>	Making good progress. Just missed at Northam Sep 4. Bided time at back and closed powerfully into the minors on a soft deck 3yo Mdn at Bunbury in only her second race appearance. Scope for improvement.
<b>4</b>	<b>SALTY MISS</b>	Resuming (29-weeks). Went close at Bunbury two back. Tuned up with a couple trials and has placed first-up. Makes strong appeal fresh in this line-up.
<b>9</b>	<b>GABEX</b>	Trials (3:1-0-0). Gave some encouragement with an earlier trial win at Ascot. W Pike sticks for debut. Good draw for career opener.
<b>3</b>	<b>PYGMALION</b>	Resuming (26-weeks). Will have matured since his initial campaign. Signalled potential in his in first campaign. Trialled well for return. Nice gate.
<b>1</b>	<b>HYPERREAL</b>	Got back and wasn't totally disgraced at Belmont Park second-up. Has claims.

<b>8</b>	<b>NATIONAL INTEREST</b>	Finally shed his maiden tag with a 1.1 lengths win at Grafton at first run for new trainer. Fitter second-up. Decent alley. Right in the mix.
<b>3</b>	<b>TIETAR</b>	First-up (25-weeks). Brought on with two trial hitouts and has placed first-up. Can lead or take a sit. Highly fancied for a winning return.
<b>2</b>	<b>EVERY HEART</b>	Given time to freshen up after 1st-up run. Handy and acquitted herself fairly well at Doomben at first run back. Warrants attention.
<b>6</b>	<b>OLIVERSHARE</b>	Resuming (21-weeks). Ex D A McColm in NSW. Broke maiden at Grafton Apr 13. Won at at Grafton when fresh last campaign.
<b>16</b>	<b>NEED FOR SPIETH</b>	Fired up to lead and kept on valiantly at Grafton. Up in class but looks capable.

2	SPIRITED STRIKE	Early form encouraging. Gave honest account in the small field at Bunbury. Remains at 1000m. Fully primed. This looks very winnable.
6	VALANNE DAWN	Set for second campaign (22-weeks). Likely to have benefitted from the spell. Can run a drum fresh in this company.

9	TWO TIME CHARLIE	Let-up (43-days). Around mid-field and was safely held at bay on debut at Belmont Park Aug 23. Likely to improve from there.
4	BUON AMICI	Back to the track for second campaign (21-weeks). Contended stronger company last time in. Rates highly fresh in this affair.
1	PROFOUND BENEFIT	Trailed pace and ran on gamely this track at this trip. Each-way.

12	VIENNA CALLING	Got back and wasn't totally disgraced at Belmont Park at her second race start. Should relish the rise in distance. Fitter third-up and added trip may help. Good draw.
2	SAFARI BOY	Made the pace but got a stitch late on a soft deck 3yo+ Mdn at Bunbury at first run off a long break. Fitter second-up. Can run a drum.
8	GOD'S GRIN	Posted some decent efforts from three appearances. Just missed at Geraldton Apr 6. Trailed pace and ran on gamely at Bunbury when off an extended spell. Placed in Maiden company at Ascot second-up last campaign.
1	SPEAK OF THE DEVIL	Shown patches of ability. Settled close, couldn't match winner but ran on for third at Bunbury. One for multiples.

**RACE 12 3:55 PM | \$30,000 | NORTHAM | 1600m**

1	EL PATRON	Gave good sight at Belmont Park Sep 13. Positive ride but emptied late at Belmont Park over this distance. Deep into his campaign and among the dangers.
6	AGE OF GRACE	Last at turn, ran on late at Bunbury at first run back. Will be fitter second-up. Can play a role.
4	BERNBRAE	First-up (23-weeks). Tends to race well first-up without winning while fitted with 1 Lark Hill trials. Makes strong appeal fresh in this line-up.
5	SAULOK	Sent out \$5.50 when unable to threaten in rain affected ground at Belmont Park second-up. Jumps from better barrier and gets 3kg off for Holly Nottle. This looks very winnable.
2	OMERTA GRACE	Won only other time at Northam. Fitter second-up and takes a 2kg claim. Can make his presence felt.

**RACE 13 4:30 PM | \$30,000 | NORTHAM | 1400m**

2	<b>TORONADO ROCKET</b>	Went close at Bunbury two back. Finished well to take the 3yo+ Mdn over 1200m second-up. Should appreciate stepping up in distance. W Pike retains the ride.
4	<b>SHAULA</b>	Let-up (52-days). Tame to line in small field in soft going at Bunbury at this distance. Key player.
7	<b>IDODOMYA</b>	Returns for second campaign (26-weeks). Winner at Pinjarra in her first prep. Broke maiden at Pinjarra Mar 23. Drawn favourably.
6	<b>BRIEF ROMANCE</b>	Warmed up nicely late at Bunbury at first run for new trainer when in the market. Fitter second-up. Warrants attention.
8	<b>TASSORT WE WANT</b>	Let-up (45-days). Sent forward and found plenty at Bunbury Fibre Sand in only his second race appearance. T Turner retains the ride. Nice gate.

**RACE 14 5:05 PM | \$30,000 | NORTHAM | 1100m**

5	<b>PRINCE</b>	Won a 1000m Class 3 at Northam two back. Settled back and didn't figure in rain affected ground in the 3yo+ (Rs0ly) at Belmont Park. Won only other time at Northam. Worth a look.
7	<b>THIS'LL SHOW YA</b>	Genuine short-course sprinter. Gave good sight at Belmont Park Aug 30. Ran home into the minors 3yo+ Hcp (C5) at Bunbury over this distance. Ticks the track and distance win box and has a good history under Holly Watson this track.
4	<b>GOLD VANCOUVER</b>	Mare specialises under 6-furlongs. Bunbury winner two back. Sent forward but flat-footed when things got serious at Belmont Park. Drawn to receive every chance.
1	<b>PIN DEEP</b>	Smart sprinter who likes to dominate up on the speed. Made all the running and only shaded on wire at Belmont Park at second run back. Ready to peak third-up. Has early speed.
8	<b>COUNTESS OF KENNA</b>	Let-up (64-days). Won 2yo+ Hcp (C1) Class 1 Northam Jul 16. Not disgraced in sticky going at Pinjarra Scarpside. Winner at track and distance.
