

**RACE 1** 11:07 AM | \$20,000 | **WARWICK** | 1200m

3	<b>ZOUCHASE</b>	Finally in the winner's circle with a 4.1 len victory at Dalby. Leslie Tilley retains the ride. On pacer. Take beating again.
