1	<b>STREETCAR APOLLO</b>	4 weeks since last run. Solid 60.5kg winner at Morphettville Parks 21 Mar. Fought bravely to the wire in the Open Hcp at Oakbank. Has early speed.

5	<b>CLEAR APPROVAL</b>	Gave nothing else a chance when led all the way at Pinj S in quick time. Has the 1400m win ticked off. Great map.
10	<b>JEDI DREAM</b>	Given a cold ride in the Karrakatta when stormed home late in fine style. Should relish 1400m on that. In the mix.

2	<b>RALLY THE TROOPS</b>	On target for hat-trick. Loving the 1400m and cold rides. Up in weight but no reason he won't go close again.
