R1 - BEAUDESERT 12:40 AUD \$17,000 PRYDE'S EASIFEED ENERGYPAK-58		
3 SKYE AND ME	Went down by just 0.8 lengths when fourth at Toowoomba over 1625m last time out. Tough to beat.	
9 REAL DIVINE	Finally broke through for a maiden win two starts back after 9 attempts, before finishing in the placings last time at Gold Coast. Best form puts her right in this.	
1 CHEVRONS'N'ROCKERS	Has been knocking on the door including a last start sixth over 1600m at Sunshine Coast when only 2.75 lengths from the winner. Has ability and is one of the major players.	
7 BEAT IT	Broke a drought when he scored last start over 1600m at Nanango. Back in form and is a solid top-three chance.	
2 AWARD KNIGHT	Yet to fill a placing in two runs since resuming from a spell, the latest effort a 11th over 1400m at Gold Coast a week-and-a-half ago. In the mix.

3	THE BIG EATER	Found the line strongly last time over 1615m at Doomben, finishing tenth. Nicely placed and is capable of taking this out.
5	THE KNIGHT	Last start finished second over 1400m at Gold Coast. Has recorded just 3 victories from 33 starts. Well placed this time and expected to go well.
7	WICKMO	Has struggled in recent runs including last time out when 13th over 1400m at Gold Coast a week-and-a-half ago, beaten 11 lengths. Capable of sharp improvement.
11	SIZZLING DIAMOND	Poor winning strike rate overall with just one win from 31 starts. Last start finished fifth over 1666m at Ipswich. Well placed this time and expected to be in the finish.
9	GALA RAIN	Poor winning strike rate overall with just one win from 14 starts. Last start finished sixth over 1400m at Sunshine Coast. Has ability and can measure up.

R3 - BEAUDESERT | 13:50 | AUD \$17,000 | PRYDE'S BIOMARE CUBES (BM60)

6	BRILLIANTLY	Consistent mare. Broke through for maiden win at Sunshine Coast last time out. Should be close to peak fitness. Winning chance here.
7	CHERRY SODA	Resumes from a spell of five months and has recently finished second in a Doomben trial. Must be respected.
4	MISS BARTY	Racing well below her best this campaign, last start finishing 2.75 lengths away in fifth over 1110m at Doomben. Well placed and can improve sharply.
1	SWAN ISLAND	Dual acceptor. Had been knocking on the door and a deserved win came last start by a nose over 1200m at Dalby. In great form and can make it back-to-back wins.
5	BRAZEN DYNAMO	Was well fancied last time but ran well below par, finishing ninth and beaten 6 lengths over 1000m at Toowoomba. Rates well and can break through if finds best.

R4 - BEAUDESERT | 14:25 | AUD \$17,000 | PRYDE'S EASIFEED EASIOIL-BM60

12	CORONEL	Not a prolific winner with just two victories from 33 starts. Last start finished fourth over 1200m at Gold Coast. Has ability and is expected to run well.
6	MISHANI CONMAN	Finished midfield last start at Toowoomba over 1000m, beaten 3 lengths. Tackles a longer journey this time. Expected to do much better.
9	COME IN SPINNER	Off the mark with his maiden success three back but has missed the placings last two, the latest when ninth at Doomben. Rates well here and is worth another try.
10	KATANAROCK	Scored over 1100m at lpswich last time and has a solid record at the journey. No reason he cannot salute again.
1	WHITEBAIT PATTIE	Returned from a layoff last start and was beaten 2.5 lengths into fourth over 1100m at this track. Rates highly and should improve sharply. Fitter for that run and expected to be in the finish this time.

2	LEADERSHIP SPILL	Five-year-old gelding with multiple wins at this journey. Good effort but found one better last time out, beaten 1.3 lengths, over 1200m at Doomben. Tough to beat on best form.
1	KRAKATOA ERUPTION	Has been racing in top form lately making it three wins in a row, the latest scoring here at the same trip by half a length. Hard to knock current form and should go close again.
7	NORM'S CHOICE	Has been thereabouts at both runs this campaign. Good effort last start to finish fourth over 1110m at Doomben three weeks ago. Ready to peak at the third run in. Hard to beat.
4	MOSCINI	Was safely held when resuming over 1000m at Sunshine Coast, finishing fifth and beaten 2.5 lengths. Is a second up winner in the past and should do much better.
5	SWAN ISLAND	Dual acceptor. Improved on prior starts to win by a nose at Dalby over 1200m. Rates highly and can make it back to back wins.
