Genuine staying chance. Runner-up to Mr Clint last year. Low draw will give him every chance for an economical run throughout. May not have the class of a Top Knight, but don't underestimate him.

#### 4th Pick: ARAMAAYO (2)

Dual Group 1 winner. Put up a gallant run in the Queen Elizabeth II Cup. Seems more effective over mile. Has drawn the widest. Might be caught wide early, which could soften him up inside the concluding stages. Will still make presence felt.
