RACE 1: SPREADEX SPORTS BEST PREMIER LEAGUE ODDS HANDICAP

Fly The Nest Miss Calculation Luxy Lou

The key to this race could be the recent clash between Miss Calculation (first) and FLY THE NEST (second), with the latter taken to come out on top this time around courtesy of a 5lb pull at the weights. Tony Carroll's charge has not been outside the first two in his last five starts and he deserves a change in luck. Recent C&D winner Luxy Lou can also have a say in proceedings.

NO. HORSE NAME

- 1 MISS CALCULATION Successful at 6f and 7f including a win on the all-weather. A winner at 12-1 at Wolverhampton over 7f on her latest outing last month, beating Fly The Nest by a neck. Carries a 5lb penalty today for that success.
- 2 FLY THE NEST He has won three times from 1m to 1m 1f on the all-weather (2 PO). Beaten a neck by Miss Calculation when second of 10 at 7-2 on his latest outing at Wolverhampton over 7f last month.
- 3 REVERSION A winner at 5f. Beaten 14l behind Cicely at 33-1 when last of 12 on his latest outing at Wolverhampton over 1m 1f in December last year.
- 4 GOOD HUMOR A winner at 7f on polytrack. Beaten 15l behind Sandy Paradise at 14-1 when last of 9 on his latest outing at Kempton over 1m last month.
- 5 LUXY LOU A winner at 10-1 over this course and distance on her latest outing last month, beating Navy Drums by 1 1/4l.
- 6 CAPPANANTY CON Has won nine races from 5f to 6f including 8 wins on the all-weather (4 PO), but last win was over two years ago. Beaten 6l behind Magicinthemaking at 28-1 when seventh of 9 on his latest outing at Kempton over 7f last month.
- 7 DELAGATE THE LADY She has won three times at 6f including 2 wins on polytrack. Beaten 8l behind Privilege at 8-1 when 9th of 13 on her latest outing at Chelmsford City over 6f last month.
- 8 HEAVENS LIGHT Yet to place in three starts. Beaten 13l behind Floating Spirit at 150-1 when eighth of 10 on his latest outing at Kempton over 7f last month.

Chronograph Oyamal Urban Outlook

CHRONOGRAPH looks to be improving and his form figures suggest that a win may be just around the corner, with the slight rise in distance expected to suit. Oyamal wasn't without promise on his first start for new connections at Southwell, while Latin Verse only got motoring late on when

making his debut over shorter here last month. Urban Outlook is a newcomer to note coming from a bloodline his trainer knows well.

Now that the penny has dropped for MISS MOONSHINE after a taking success at Kempton, there should be much more to come from Rod Millman's filly, especially as she returns to a C&D she was narrowly denied over on her penultimate start. Arbaawi (third) has just over three lengths to find with the selection on that Kempton run but can't be ruled out, nor can Wolverhampton winner Once Adaay, who makes his handicap debut.

Unforgotten Brains Starshiba

Brains arrives in tremendous form having notched back-to-back successes at Kempton and Chelmsford but having never won from a mark this high, he could prove vulnerable. UNFORGOTTEN hasn't been seen on a racecourse since his Newcastle win in April 2021, but it's interesting that the Godolphin team persist with him and, if he's at the top of his game, an opening mark of 86 might be lenient. Others to note include Starshiba and Tropez Power.

- 1 UNFORGOTTEN A winner at 13-8 at Newcastle over 7f on his latest outing in April '21, beating My Swallow by 4 1/2l.
- 2 TROPEZ POWER He has won three times from 6f to 1m 1f including 2 wins on the all-weather. Third of 6 behind Zealot beaten 3 1/2l at 9-2 on his latest outing at Southwell over 1m last month.
- 3 FARASI LANE He has won three times from 7f to 1m including a win on polytrack. Third of 11 behind Frantanck beaten 1 1/2l at 10-1 on his latest outing at Windsor over 1m (soft) in October last year.
- 4 MILLION THANKS A winner at 1m. Finished 4l behind All The King's Men when fifth of 12 at 8-1 on his latest outing here over 7f last month.
- 5 BRAINS Has won ten races at 1m including 9 wins on the all-weather (1 FB, 8 PO). A winner at 85-40 at Chelmsford City over 1m on his latest outing last month, beating Counsel by 3/4l.
- 6 STARSHIBA He has won four times from 7f to 1m on polytrack. Beaten 1 1/4l by Jilly Cooper when second of 8 at 11-4fav on his latest outing at Wolverhampton over 7f last month.
- 7 ENOUGH ALREADY He has won four times from 1m to 1m 2f including a win on polytrack. Finished 1 1/4l behind Siam Fox when fourth of 8 at 8-1 on his latest outing at Wolverhampton over 1m 1f in December last year.

Politics Broxi Bobby Dassler

In a contest lacking depth a chance can be taken with the class-dropping POLITICS, who looked outpaced in a hotter handicap over 6f at Southwell three days ago. Although he remains 3lb above his last winning mark, that success came over this C&D and he should not be taken lightly. Broxi has been running consistently well of late and is feared most, ahead of the Tom Ward-trained Bobby Dassler.

- 2 SECRET STRENGTH A winner at 5f. Beaten 6l behind All The King's Men at 11-2 when 11th of 12 on his latest outing over this course and distance last month.
- 3 POLITICS He has won three times from 5f to 7f including 2 wins on the all-weather (1 PO). Finished 4 1/2l behind Sir Robin when sixth of 9 at 11-2 on his latest outing at Southwell over 6f last month.
- 4 PORFIN Winner of six races from 5f to 7f including 5 wins on the all-weather (3 PO). Beaten 10l behind Alafdhal at 17-2 when 10th of 12 on his latest outing at Wolverhampton over 6f last month.
