C1 - PRIX DE LA SOCIETE DES COURSES DE CHATEAU-DU-LOIR - 2300m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Newcomers Race - Flat - EUR € 21,000

- **1. CELTIC FURY -** By Persian King out of a Group 3 -placed dam. Well spoken and can make his presence felt
- **2. THE FRENCH SON -** Out of a dam that was a one time winner from 3 starts while the sire, Nathaniel, was a Multiple Group I winner. Top yard and is hugely respected
- **3. KING'S LIGHT -** Out of a dam who was a maiden from 11 starts and in unlikely to trouble the judge on debut. Others preferred
- **4. ARACO -** Dam was a three time winning horse from 7 starts while the sire, Golden Horn, is a multiple winning Group sire. Best to have a look in the betting
- **5. ONE ISLAND -** Out of Mira Star, who was a one time winner only winning her Maiden. Yard always to be feared with juveniles and is worth a look in
- **6. SHAMASSA -** Dam won three times including a Group III and featured in a Group I race while the sire, Almanzor, was a multiple Group I winner. Expected to be ready
- **7. FEBELLE ROSAY** Has been supplemented and is out of a one time winning mare while the sire, Garswood, was a multiple Group winning sire. Betting will guide
- **8. AMITY -** Has been supplemented and is out of an unraced mare. Sire, Bated Breath, was a Group II winning horse and featured in multiple Group races across British tracks, Hong Kong and Canada
- **9. SANTA CAROLINA** By Reliable Man out of a modest mare. Unlikely to pose a threat on debut and can be overlooked
- **10. LIGHT MELODY -** Dam won 3 times from 4 starts where 2 of the wins came from one being a Group I and the other a Group II. Entrusted to Cristian Demuro and must be hugely respected
- **11. RIGEL -** By Goken and out of a dam that was a one time winner from seven starts. Others make more appeal
- **12. GIANETTA -** Out of a dam that ran modestly in Germany. hard to make a case on debut and is best to pass over
- **13. BONJOUR MON AMOUR -** By Kodi Bear and out of an unraced dam. Come from top connections and has to be closely monitored in the betting
- **14. POLITICIENNE -** By Intello out of a Dam that won 3 from 11 starts and also featured in a Group III race and won a Listed race



Summary: THE FRENCH SON (2) is a decent sort on breeding and if the experience is not needed, he will surely give a good account of himself. SHAMASSA (6) is a beautifully bred horse that has Group races running through her DNA and has the requirements to produce a debut winning performance. LIGHT MELODY (10) holds huge contentions here based off a sparkling pedigree line. CELTIC FURY (1) completes the top four mix to make a wise debut.

C2 - PRIX DU CANTON DE SABLE-SUR-SARTHE - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - Maiden Race - Flat - EUR € 21,000

- **1. SALAM DUBAWI -** Finished 9th in a Maiden over 2100m at Saint-Cloud on the 4th of April 2025. Forgive his last run, still holds winning claims
- **2. CASIM -** Finished 9th on debut in a Maiden over 1400m at Saint-Cloud on the 4th of April 2025. Will improve on debut performance
- **3. BAHIANE -** Finished 11th in a Maiden over 2000m at Lion D'Angers on the 6th of April 2025. One to pass by
- **4. LUFFY -** Finished 5th in a Maiden over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on the 23rd of April 2025. Could be a lurker for the quartet plays based off Maiden form
- **5. KNOSSINGTON -** Finished 8th in a Maiden over 1350m at Senonnes on the 12th of April 2025. Eachway chance and should improve here
- **6. SAINT ELIGIUS -** Finished 8th on debut in a Maiden over 2000m at Saint-Cloud on the 20th of March 2025. Should seek improvement but will find it hard to compete with the top selectors
- **7. TIZIAN -** Finished 6th in a Maiden over 1600m at La Teste-Bassin Arcachon on the 22nd of March 2025. Include in quartet plays
- **8. SPEED ROMAN -** Finished 8th on debut in a Maiden over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on the 18th of April 2025. Others weigh more attraction
- **9. BAY MOON -** Finished 4th in a Maiden over 1600m at Nantes on the 9th of April 2025. Include in larger spends for the backend of quartets
- **10. VESCO -** Finished 5th in a Handicap over 2000m at Lion D'Angers on the 21st of April 2025. Include for exotic spends
- **11. HOT COLD -** Finished 13th in a Maiden over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on the 29th of March 2025. One to pass by
- **12. SIR ROBERT -** Finished 6th over 1300m at Warsaw on the 17th of November 2024. Debut run on French soil and will be one to keep an eye out on
- **13. TURTLE BAY -** The Mare, PEPPER BAY, raced twice on British soil and remained a Maiden while the sire, ALMANZOR, was a Group I, II and III winning horse
- **14. IONATOS -** Supplemented IONATOS is out of the Mare, L'ETOILE, which had a short racing career with three starts and no victory while the sire, MAGNA GRECIA, was a two time Group I winning horse
- **15. THE BIG TICKET -** The Mare, PURPLE SENSATION, won 11 times from 54 starts all above 2000m while the sire, KENDARGENT, was a 1 time winner in featured in Group contests



Summary: SALAM DUBAWI (1) can be forgiven for his last start when finishing ninth and although stepping back to the mile, he will be trying his best to make winning claims here. KNOSSINGTON (5) has had two career starts and certainly strikes a field to make further improvement over the 1600m. CASIM (2) was unplaced on debut and steps 200m further from his debut run which could be perfect for him to enhance his form. SIR ROBERT (12) enters French soil from Polish surfaces and could pose to be an interesting sort.

C3 - PRIX DE LA SOCIETE DES COURSES DE MONTMIRAIL - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - Maiden Race - Flat - EUR € 21,000

- **1. MANNEVILLE -** Finished 4th in a Class 3 Conditional over 1500m at Vannes on the 13th of April 2025. Include for the backend of quartets
- **2. BADANA -** Pleasing 2nd in a Class 3 Conditional over 1500m at Vannes on the 13th of April 2025. Include in all exotic plays
- **3. PIECE MAITRESSE** Finished 8th in a Maiden over 1800m at Chantilly on the 12th of October 2024. Others weigh more attraction
- **4. VENETIAN BEAUTY -** Finished 10th in a Maiden over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on the 29th of March 2025. Will seek to make improvement
- **5. MALA WYSKA -** Finished 3rd in a Maiden over 1400m at Nancy on the 5th of April 2025. Include in exotic spends
- **6. ELFENN -** Finished 4th on debut in a Maiden over 1800m at Nort-Sur-Erdre on the 20th of April 2025. Include in larger perms of exotics
- **7. OLYMPIQUE DES BOIS -** Finished 9th in a Maiden over 1350m at Senonnes on the 12th of April 2025. One to pass by in this field
- **8. ELENKA -** Finished 4th in a Handicap over 1300m at Argentan on the 9th of April 2025. Erratic on form
- **9. LANAMAYA** Finished 5th in a Maiden over 1500m at Deauville on the 3rd of December 2024. Scopes to improve on current form but top selectors have the upper advantage
- **10. DOUBLE JEU -** Finished 9th in a Handicap over 2000m at Lion D'Angers on the 21st of April 2025. Others pose a better interest
- **11. DAY DREAMING -** Finished 7th in a Maiden over 1900m at Chantilly on the 28th of February 2025. Must be considered as a place chance
- **12. FAROAH -** Finished 13th in a Maiden over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on the 29th of March 2025. Others seem more intriguing
- **13. RHENIA -** Finished 9th in a Class 3 Conditional over 1200m at Evreux on the 15th of April 2025. One to ignore in this field
- **14. SIYLHETA -** Filly by Wootton Bassett out of a Dam that was a 1 time winner from 4 starts. Well placed in the weights and must be given consideration
- **15. LADY MELISSA -** This filly is by Churchill and out of an unraced mare. Top connections in red hot form and must be closely monitored

Summary: LADY MELISSA (15) is a pleasing filly who is by the stunning sire, Churchill and if the genetics of the sire is dominant in her genes, she could see herself relishing her opponents. SIYLHETA (14) is out of the mare which was a one time winner over 1400m and this filly could be anything in the making and should be respected. DAY DREAMING (11) ran a cracker in her penultimate start when finishing second on debut and a repetition of that run will make her a massive runner. BADANA (2) holds a bold interest and must be considered.

C4 - PRIX DU CANTON DE SILLE-LE-GUILLAUME - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Class 3 Handicap - Flat - EUR € 20,000

- **1. CREW DRAGON -** A winner in a Class 4 Claimer over 1400m at Lion D'Angers on the 21st of April 2025. Eachway shout
- **2. ON Y CROIT -** Finished 12th in a Class 2 Handicap over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on the 25th of March 2025. One to pass by against top selectors
- **3. LIGHT WAKEUP -** Finished 12th in a Class 2 Handicap over 1600m at Fontainebleau on the 21st of April 2025. Erratic but capable on his day
- **4. CHIRICCO -** A winner in a Class 3 Handicap over 1600m at Nantes on the 9th of April 2025. Strong eachway chance
- **5. KILFRUSH MEMORIES -** Great 2nd in a Class 3 Handicap over 1600m at Lyon Parilly on the 16th of April 2025. Strong winning chance
- **6. CALYPSO -** Finished 13th in a Class 3 Handicap over 1400m at Deauville on the 1st of February 2025. Holds a place chance on extended form
- **7. DORIANELLO -** Finished 4th in a Class 4 Claimer over 1400m at Lion D'Angers on the 21st of April 2025. Does have decent form but there are stronger horses to take on
- **8. MARILLAWOOD -** Finished 5th in a Class 3 Handicap over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on the 11th of April 2025. Others seem more appealing

Summary: KILFRUSH MEMORIES (5) ran an eye-catching second in his last start and if he brings that run here, he can certainly add to his winning tally. CHIRICCO (4) is absolutely treasuring life at the moment coming off two career wins and his penultimate start shows him scoring over the course and distance. It won't be no surprise if he reels off the hattrick win here. CREW DRAGON (1) was a winner in his last start over the distance but does face a tougher opposition here but should go well again. CALYPSO (6) has a place chance.

C5 - PRIX DU CANTON DE LA-SUZE-SUR-SARTHE - 3200m (a2m) - TURF - Maiden Race - Flat - EUR € 13,000

- **1. MARANNI -** Failed to finish over 3800m at Compiegne in a Class 2 hurdles race on the 16th of May 2024. Would be a shock winner
- **2. ALEX THE DANCER -** Finished a clear 5th over 4000m at Loudeac in a Class 4 hurdles course qualifier on the 20th of April 2025. Outsider for the placings back on the flat
- **3. DIYASHAL** Runner up over 3900m at Nantes in a Class 2 hurdle on the 9th of April 2025. Fair sort on the flat
- **4. JOINVILLE LE PONT -** Finished a clear 3rd over 3600m at Granville in a Class 4 chasing event on the 15th of July 2024. Easy to look elsewhere
- **5. DSCHINGIS RIVER -** Finished 6th behind a reopposing sort over 3100m at Nantes in a maiden on the 9th of April 2025. Can improve to challenge
- **6. RUBY ROSE -** Poor run in 15th over 3200m at Fougeres in a Class 4 course qualifier on the 20th of April 2025. Difficult to fancy back on the flat
- **7. LARWA -** No show in 10th over 3100m at Nantes in a maiden on the 9th of April 2025. Can run into the money
- **8. DSCHINGIS JOY -** No type of effort in 12th over 2000m at Fontainebleau in a maiden on the 7th of March 2025. Erratic but could earn
- **9. ROSIMIX -** Held in 6th over 3200m at Saumur in a Class 4 on the 30th of March 2025. Needs to show improvement
- **10. PRINCE EXPRESS -** Lackluster performance in 7th over 3700m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat in a hurdles handicap on the 22nd of November 2024. Others make more appeal
- **11. IALBAN -** No show over 4000m at Durtal in a Class 4 chasing event on the 23rd of March 2025. Would be a shock winner
- **12. LA ZINGARA -** No type of effort in 13th over 2200m at Moulins in a maiden on the 5th of April 2025. Difficult to recommend on form
- **13. RECORDING QUEEN -** Lackluster effort in 11th over 2500m at Argentan in a Class 4 divided handicap on the 9th of April 2025. Hard to fancy on form
- **14. EMBIEZ -** Solid effort in 3rd over 3100m at Nantes in a maiden on the 9th of April 2025. Should go close to winning
- **15. DOUCE AMIE** Moderate effort in 6th over 3600m at Fontainebleau in a Class 2 chasing event on the 28th of October 2024. Easy to pass by



Summary: EMBIEZ (14) has been steadily improving with each outing and produced a pleasing finish last time out which should hold him in good stead heading into this event. DSCHINGIS RIVER (5) was in behind the top pick at his latest outing and can get closer with some weight off the back. He appears to be the main danger. LARWA (7) failed to fire up last time out and shouldn't be dismissed in this contest as she is more than capable of posing as a threat. DIYASHAL (3) has been successful over the hurdles having won three times but is back on the flat where he remains a maiden but has the form to earn.

C6 - PRIX DU CANTON DE LA FLECHE - 3200m (a2m) - TURF - Maiden Race - Flat - EUR € 21,000

- **1. SONNAZ -** Runner up over 2500m at Evreux-Navarre in a limited handicap on the 15th of April 2025. Should be in the firing line
- **2. MUSK OF THE NIGHT -** No type of effort in 11th over 2500m at Argentan in a maiden on the 9th of April 2025. Can show vast improvement
- **3. FEEL THE HEAT -** Poor display in 11th over 2000m at Toulouse in a claimer on the 1st of December 2024. Hard to recommend
- **4. EDROSA -** Fair performance in 6th over 2400m at Pornichet in a maiden on the 1st of March 2025. Can run into the money
- **5. POSSIBLE -** Finished well downfield in 9th over 2400m at Lyon Parilly in a maiden on the 16th of April 2025. Would be a surprise winner
- **6. SO GATSBY -** Finished 7th over 2300m at Angers in a maiden on the 26th of April 2025. Can run into the money
- **7. BLANCHE EPINE -** Not disgraced in 6th over 2100m at Haras Du Pin in a maiden on the 13th of April 2025. Each way claims
- **8. QUI EVIDAMENT QUI -** No type of performance in 11th over 2500m at Nort-Sur-Erdre in a maiden on the 20th of April 2025. Would be a shock winner
- **9. DI BAHIA -** Lackluster effort in 5th over 2300m at Tarbes in a Class 2 on the 6th of April 2025. Others inspire more confidence
- **10. BABYKEN -** Dam won once over 2000m and this gelding hails from a yard that are operating at an 11.9% win strike rate this year. Interesting jockey booking

Summary: SONNAZ (1) has been taking on winners and running well in defeat. He appears to be ideally teed up on his return to maiden company and can make amends. BABYKEN (10) is a newcomer that won't need to be 100% ready to make his present felt on debut and is worth including. MUSK OF THE NIGHT (2) gets the services of Christian Demuro which is notable and there could be serious improvement on the cards. SO GATSBY (6) has only had two outings to date and is open to natural improvement so is worth including.

C7 - PRIX DU CANTON D'ECOMMOY - 1100m (a5f1/2) - TURF - Claiming - Flat - EUR € 15,000

- **1. GUNS AND ROSES -** Finished 4th over 900m at Saint-Cloud in a claimer on the 18th of April 2025. Can outrun odds
- **2. AVENUE CHOPE -** No type of effort in 9th on debut at Saint-Cloud in a claimer on the 18th of April 2025. Would be a surprise winner
- **3. WOODWOODED -** Dam won once as a two year old on debut and this filly could follow in her footsteps. The market will be a good guide
- **4. ASENSEOFSERENITY -** Far from disgraced in 6th over 900m at Saint-Cloud in a claimer on the 18th of April 2025. Should have a say in the outcome
- **5. ADORA -** Finished a clear 7th over 900m at Saint-Cloud in a claimer on the 18th of April 2025. Can improve here
- **6. CAPOUCHINE -** Dam was unraced and this daughter of Victor Ludorum could be anything on debut. Follow the market
- **7. SUCH A LOVELY DAY -** Dam was unraced but this nicely bred daughter of Oasis Dream could know the business on debut. Trainer is operating at a 12% win strike rate

Summary: ASENSEOFSERENITY (4) has had three educational runs to date and looks ready to win in what appears to be a winnable race that lacks depth. SUCH A LOVELY DAY (7) is a filly who steps out on debut with absolutely no weight on the back which could see her running very well. CAPOUCHINE (6) is from a sire that has already had success from a few of his progeny and this filly could be the next to have a positive impact on those stats. WOODWOODED (3) is bred to be speedy and needs to be watched carefully.
