Hougoumont Mountain Warrior Tribal Hunter

HOUGOUMONT was only beaten a neck into second by a smart youngster on his debut at Carlisle and he should be hard to beat with the benefit of that experience. Mountain Warrior also displayed plenty of promise on his racecourse bow and may prove to be the main threat to the selection, although Tribal Hunter is related to several winners and should not be underestimated, despite his lack of a previous run.

Billy Wedge hit the crossbar over C&D last time and is another to consider.
