RACE 1: VIRGIN BET APPRENTICE HANDICAP

Hortzadar Ventura Rascal Cosa Sara

HORTZADAR had Ventura Rascal (second) and Hale End (fifth) behind when scoring by a length over C&D last month and he was put up 3lb for that effort. The eight-year-old remains well below his previous winning mark of 91 in April last year and he looks ready to strike once again. If Cosa Sara can run to the level of her penultimate start, when successful over 7f at this track, then she could also have a say.

1 HORTZADAR Has won eight races from 7f to 1m on ground varying from good to firm to soft. A winner at 12-1 over this course and distance (good to soft) on his latest outing last month, beating Ventura Rascal by 1l.

7 COSA SARA Winner of five races from 7f to 1m on ground varying from good to firm to good to soft. Finished 6l behind Mac Ailey when fourth of 8 at 5-1 on her latest outing at Hamilton over 1m (good to soft) last month. Has won twice at Ayr this season.

Golden Strike Glory Hyde Bona Fortuna

Inexperience at the start probably did for GOLDEN STRIKE on his debut at Pontefract 12 days ago but the manner in which he powered home to claim a close third was notable and he could be a different proposition with that experience to draw upon. Glory Hyde also catches the eye after a solid run at York last moth, while Bona Fortuna and Firebird appeal most from the newcomers.

The penny has really dropped for the Rebecca Menzies-trained gelding, who made it two wins from his last three starts when scoring over this trip at Beverley last week and he escapes a penalty for that apprentice handicap success. Montevideo is respected on her handicap debut.

Finished 14l behind Restorer when fourth of 8 at 5-1 on his latest outing at Chester over 1m 4f (good to soft) last month. Has won 3 times this season.
