RACE 1:EBF MAIDEN STAKES (GBB RACE)

Mackenzie Rose Bin Hayyan Chelsea Annie

The form of Bin Hayyan's two outings have been handsomely advertised and the Dark Angel colt should be thereabouts if building on his latest outing. Although, a chance is taken on MACKENZIE ROSE, who had a torrid time of it on debut at Brighton. After missing the break, the filly took a keen hold and appeared unbalanced for the duration of the the race. To make matters worse, she was hampered close home and had to be eased down. The Mark Johnston-trained filly may fare better in this contest, while Chelsea Annie also merits consideration.

Noble Crusade warrants plenty of attention as he won his maiden well at Carlisle and was far from disgraced when third under a penalty at Redcar last time. A mark of 78 might underestimate him on his handicap bow and he's a danger to all if it does, but it might be worth siding with the proven handicap form of STATE OF BLISS. A solid third off today's mark over a mile at Leicester last time, Mark Johnston's charge could be better for this step up in trip. Ayr Poet is consistent enough to have his say, while Sandret has acquitted himself well enough in two handicaps over this distance recently.

Royal Countess brings winning C&D form to the table and has run well off a 1lb higher mark in three starts here so far this year. She is the top-rated performer in this line-up and looks sure to run well, but a chance is taken on the less-exposed CAPLA LASS. The three-year-old daughter of Garswood was an eye-catching fifth on her seasonal return over 1m at Musselburgh six days ago (hampered before Joanna Mason dropped her whip) and she may improve for this longer trip. Castle View also holds claims on his handicap debut.

The impression that JOHN JASPER created when fifth at Haydock last time was particularly noteworthy, travelling nicely before failing to see daylight on a number of occasions. The drop in trip here is unlikely to cause any problems and, granted more luck in running this time, he looks capable of breaking his maiden. Last-time-out course winner Mi Capricho will have no problem moving back

up a furlong and is feared, while Coviglia showed distinct promise on his first start for this yard at Hamilton last month and is also respected.

3 COVIGLIA He has won four times from 7f to 1m on good to firm and good ground and on the all-weather. Finished 2 1/4l behind Retirement Beckons when fifth of 11 at 9-2 on his latest outing at Hamilton over 1m (good to firm) last month.

4 MI CAPRICHO He has won three times at 7f on good to firm ground. A winner at 14-1 here over 7f (good to firm) on his latest outing last month, beating Motawaazy by 1/2l.

5 KILCONQUHAR A winner at 6f on the all-weather. Third of 14 behind Muatadel beaten 1/2l at 9-1 on his latest outing at Hamilton over 6f (good) last month.

Headingley Summa Peto Bulls Aye

A case can be made for all of these but preference is for HEADINGLEY, who bounced back to form when finishing third at Doncaster last time. That form was boosted when the second won earlier this week and the application of first-time blinkers may help this three-year-old. Summa Peto failed to fire at Royal Ascot but his previous form is very encouraging, including a maiden win over this C&D. Bulls Aye is another unexposed type, while Shelir and Redarna are more than capable when at their best.

4 HEADINGLEY Successful twice at 1m on good to firm ground and on the allweather. Third of 6 behind Siam Fox beaten 2 1/2l at 3-1 on his latest outing at Doncaster over 1m (good to firm) last month.
