C1 - PRIX XAVIER CEBRON DE LISLE - 1100m (a5f1/2) - TURF - Claiming - Flat - EUR € 15,000

- DALENDA Unplaced in both career starts thus far including at Le Mans on 23 April. First time
 in a claimer
- **2. OCEANE PEARL -** Good second on 19 April at Saint-Cloud in a similar contest. First start new yard and has every chance
- **3. DUFY -** Newcomer by Toronado who is a half-brother to a winner at 2. Should be worth a check in the market
- **4. LA MOSCA -** Posted a good effort first time out on 23 March at Saint-Cloud but has gone cold in two subsequent outings
- **5. CABRA DO MONTE -** Newcomer by Totxo whose dam has shown speed in her early days. Cannot be discounted and a market check should tell more
- **6. CARRICASTEL -** Good finish on debut at Bordeaux on 6 April over 5f when 4th. Player with improvement likely
- **7. DANDY GALAXY -** Well held in both starts to date including on 19 April at Saint-Cloud. Has work to do here and can be passed over
- **8. TREVI** Has shown little of note in three starts to date and is unlikely to trouble the judges. Best to overlook
- **9. MADEMOISELLE BERE -** Newcomer by Whitecliffsofdover who is likely to need the run and can easily be passed over

Summary: OCEANE PEARL (2) ran a solid race on her second outing at Saint-Cloud on 19 April. She changed hands on this occasion and is expected to be a serious player first time up for trainer Adrien Fouassier. OCEANE PEARL (2) ships a long way from Maisons-Laffitte to run his first race and is worth some consideration. OCEANE PEARL (2) posted a good first start effort and should improve. OCEANE PEARL (2) can spring a surprise.

- **1. CARAJONES -** Game 2nd at Argentan on 11 April over 6.5f in a claimer. Tries the trip and could be a serious player
- **2. DARSHANN DARNOULT -** Unplaced in both starts to date including at Evreux on 24 April last time. Tries the claiming division but remains hard to fancy
- **3. DA VINCI -** Promising debut last back end on PSF at Deauville but posted a disappointing comeback run at Le Mans on 23 April. First time in a claimer
- **4. ON BORROWED TIME -** Finished 5th in a handicap at Le Mans on 23 April last time out. Won two races in UK earlier in a career and a player here
- **5. MISS LIZY -** Well beaten in a maiden last January at Pornichet when last seen in action. First run for new connections today
- **6. LILITH -** Went off the mark at La Roche Sur Yon on 14 April in a claimer over an extended mile on 5h attempt. First start new yard today
- **7. INTELMAH -** Down the field on debut at Le Mans in a maiden on 23 April. Down in grade and could pop up
- **8. PICCINELLI -** Best of four runs so far was over a mile at Machecoul early March. First time in a claimer and is worth considering

Summary: ON BORROWED TIME (4) is well placed in the weight and can win this race if capable of building up on his last effort in a handicap at Le Mans. ON BORROWED TIME (4) ran a solid race last time out at Argentan and should have a leading role here if he stays the trip. ON BORROWED TIME (4) is back over what seems to be his best distance. DA VINCI (3)c takes a step down in grade and could have a say in this line-up.

C3 - PRIX MARATHON - 3700m (a2m1/4) - TURF - Class 3 Handicap - Flat - EUR € 20,000

- **1. DESIRE FOR EVER -** Ran below par at Le Mans on 23 April when down the field in a Class 4. Had won her two previous starts and should bounce back
- **2. SRIDEDGREEN -** Finished 3rd of five last time out at Durtal ahead of stablemate PENCLAUDJEANGREEN (8). Very consistent and can be involved at the finish
- **3. KER STORMY -** Not disgraced when 7th of 13 in a Class 4 at Le Mans on 23 April and has claims if he can build up on this effort
- **4. ALTESSEROYALETAVEL -** Unplaced over hurdles at Auteuil on 24 February when last seen in action. A winner on the flat last year and will enjoy the trip
- **5. ZALETTO -** Finished 4th in a Class 4 over a mile and half at the venue on 24 April. Previously won over 15f and must have every chance
- **6. KIROZ -** Back on form and was a good 2nd here on 6 April over 15f. Has every chance on the back of this effort
- **7. MUNAADRAM -** Bounced back to form when 3rd of twelve in a Class 4 at Argentan on 12 April and has claims on the back of this performance
- **8. PENCLAUDJEANGREEN -** Last of five at Durtal on 21 April over 14f. Boasts a decent record at Nantes and should be able to make amends
- **9. SPIRIT OF DANCE -** Well held when back on turf on 18 April at Nantes over a mile and half and has a few lengths to find
- **10. IL EST DIVIN -** Three time winner who ran with credit on seasonal debut on 31 March at Loudeac when runner-up in a Class 4. Leading chance with improvement likely

Summary: ZALETTO (5) generally goes well over the longer trips and is sure to play a leading role in this open contest. PENCLAUDJEANGREEN (8) is better than his last start suggests and is expected to make amends at a track where he has a decent record. Stablemate to the former, SRIDEDGREEN (2) is a tough competitor and could also have a say. SRIDEDGREEN (2) is a French AQPS that is worth a mention against the thoroughbreds.

- **1. LOST IN MUSIC -** Three times winner who was unplaced in a handicap at Chantilly on 29 April. Easier task today and can bounce back
- **2. WAR OF THE ROSES -** Six starts maiden who finished 3rd in a handicap at Senonnes last time out. Very consistent and can go off the mark this time around
- **3. ERIDITA DOVER -** Finished 3rd in a Class 2 over course & distance on 18 April and has every chance if capable of repeating this effort
- **4. LADYSHOW -** Has long been knocking at the door and was 2nd to ERIDITA DOVER (3) last time out over course & distance own 18 April. Player
- **5. KEDUREV -** Fifteen starts maiden who finished 3rd of five over 10f at Durtal on 21 April. Needs to improve a few lengths to be involved

Summary: WAR OF THE ROSES (2) has run some solid races thus far and looks very competitive over this selective mile and half course. However he will have to keep a close eye on ERIDITA DOVER (3) who comes in the race on the back of a good 2nd over the course & distance in a Class 2. LOST IN MUSIC (1) takes a slight drop in class and can bounce back. LADYSHOW (4) cannot be discounted and will have her supporters.

- **1. KENOR DE MAEL -** Very consistent and was third last time out in a Conditions race at Senonnes-Pouancé over 2300m on 14 April. Not out of it
- **2. KIKI MORIVIERE** Not at all disgraced when 5th last time out in a GR.2 race at Saint-Cloud over 2400m on 27 September. Can win if fit
- **3. KNIGHT DES MOTTES -** Unreliable but did show his best when winning last time out, a Conditiosn race at Cluny over 2450m on 9 July. Should need this run returning from a break
- **4. KATE TO WIN -** Consistent this year and was runner-up last time out in a Conditions race at Senonnes-Pouancé over 2300m on 14 April. Can contest the finish once again
- **5. KISS ME D'EX -** Did not show his best when 6th last time out in a Conditions race at Senonnes-Pouancé over 2300m on 14 April. Capable of bouncing back to be a threat
- **6. KRACK BOUM AULMES -** Showed promise when scoring on his debut in a Conditions race at Senonnes-Pouancé over 2300m on 14 April. Can follow up

- **10. KERALA -** Not disgraced when third on her debut at Le Lion-d'Angers over 2400m on 1 April. Place chance in this line-up
- **11. KASTELLE BEAUFEU** Did not run too badly when 7th on debut in a Conditions race at Senonnes-Pouancé over 2300m on 14 April. Capable of improvement but others are preferred

Summary: KRACK BOUM AULMES (6) did all that was asked when winning on debut and had a number of these rivals behind him that time. He should win. KISS ME D'EX (5) did not have a clear passage last time out so should get a lot closer this time. KIMI DE MAI (8) has been good so far and should be a threat. KATE TO WIN (4) is consistent and should be involved with the finish once again.

C1 - PRIX PRALINE - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - Newcomers Race - Flat - EUR € 27,000

- **1. SAGANNE -** Unraced by Zelzal, the leading trainer will have this filly well-forward for her debut. The betting can guide
- **2. RIMJA -** Newcomer by Soldier Hollow, the dam won over 1600m. From a leading trainer who will have this filly nicely tuned. The betting can guide
- **3. SCHIKERIA -** Unraced by Zarak, good stable and will be better for this run. Monitor the betting closely
- **4. LYCADA -** Newcomer by Flintshire, should be better for this run. The betting can be the best guide
- **5. PINTA -** Unraced by Zarak, the dam won a Group 3 race over 1200m. Will be well prepared for a bold show on debut. The betting can be informative
- **6. SULTANE -** Newcomer by Le Havre, has a nice profile and was supplemented for this race. Monitor the betting for clues
- **7. UNTIL DAWN -** Newcomer by Dawn Approach, from the powerhouse of Andre Fabre. Can not be discounted on debut and the betting can be informative
- **8. SUNNY SPELL** Unraced by Too Darn Hot, from a good stable who warrants respect. Any market interest should be noted
- **9. NOVA HOPE -** Newcomer by Zoustar, taking profile and can have a say on her debut. Any market support should be noted
- **10. ST ELVIRA -** Unraced by Ectot, stable runners tend to improve for a run or two. Watch the betting exchanges
- **11. MODERN ERA -** Unraced by Starspangledbanner, her trainer knows the time of day and any market support should be noted

Summary: Some well-bred fillies line up and RIMJA (2) could be the pick of them. Her dam was a winner and she is from a trainer who can ready a debutante. PINTA (5) looks good on paper, her dam won a Group 3 race over 1200m and she will be well forward for this outing. UNTIL DAWN (7) is a daughter of Dawn Approach and trained by Andre Fabre. She will not be far away at the business end. SULTANE (6) could fare best of the rest.

- **1. WIKENDA -** 5th last time in a handicap over 1400m at Chantilly on April 15th. Ought to be in the shake-up
- **2. BANKIER** Unplaced last time, nice 4th before that in a handicap at Saint-Cloud on October 10th over 1600m. Place contender
- **3. LISIMBA -** Unplaced last time, 4th before that at Chantilly on November 21st over 1400m in a handicap. Live chance for new connections
- **4. LOVEFORCE -** 4th last time over 1650m in a maiden race on April 28th and placed before that on both starts. Others more likely
- **5. COSTARMORICAIN -** 2nd last time at Evreux over 1800m in a claimer on September 5th. Back from a break and has solid each-way claims
- **6. TEMPLETON -** Nice 2nd last time at Moulins in a Class 3 race on April 14th over 1400m. Live chance

- **1. SUNWAY -** 5th last time when needing the race in April, won the Vainqueur De Criterium International (Gr.1) over 1600m on October 22nd before that. Form pick
- **2. CASAPUEBLO -** 4th last time in a Group 3 race at Parislongchamp when more was expected of him on April 14th over 2100m. Can come forward for that run
- **3. WOOTTON VERNI -** 2nd in a Listed race last time at Chantilly over 1800m on March 8th. Is progressive and can not be ruled out
- **4. CORNELIENNE -** Won last time over 2000m at Parislongchamp on April 18th in a maiden race. Can improve and be involved

Summary: SUNWAY (1) will be sharper for a run last month when fifth and this promising colt scored last October in the Vainqueur De Criterium International (Gr.1) in October and should have too much class for his rivals. CASAPUEBLO (2) was a shade below par last time but was a promising juvenile and can acquit himself better today. CORNELIENNE (4) got off the mark on her seasonal return and warrants respect.

- **1. WAITARA -** Won last time at Strasbourg over 2000m in a Class 4 handicap on April 22nd. One to keep safe
- **2. PLEASEMAN** Won last time over 2400m at Moulins over 2400m on April 14th. Hard to rule out of the frame
- **3. ZULU NYALA -** Won last time over 2000m at Nancy in a Class 4 handicap on April 4th. One to pay attention too
- **4. ASHGHAR -** Four unplaced runs of late, 2nd before that over 2000m in a Class 3 race on August 23rd at Vichy. Place chance
- **5. MOWGLI -** Better effort when 5th at Lyon Parilly last time over 2000m in a Class 3 race on April 27th. Can get involved on his best form

- **2. GRAZANO** Has dropped in the ratings after a few unplaced runs, ran a credible race when 6th last time on April 28th over 2800m. Player
- **3. LANDARYNA -** Has seven unplaced runs since a win in a Class 4 handicap at Deauville on August 24th over 1900m. Opposable

- **1. VICE CAPTAIN** Nice 3rd last time over 1300m in a claimer at Argentan on April 11th. Can not be ruled out
- **2. TIGER KING -** Three runs so far in Ireland, the latter at Dundalk when 5th over 1400m on the all weather surface. Others rate higher
- **3. KALEOCREEK -** 3rd last time at Fontainebleau in a claimer over 1200m on April 30th. Usually on the premises in these type of events
- **4. MISS WOO WOO -** 4th two runs ago over 1300m at Argentan in a claimer on April 11th. One for the each-way backers

- **4. FILLE DU ROI -** Four unplaced runs of late, won before that at Deauville over 1500m in a claimer on December 3rd. Looks unlikely
- **5. LIGHT WAKEUP -** 3rd last time at Le Mans over 1600m in a Class 3 handicap on April 23rd. Opposable
- **6. KERNO QUATZ -** 5th last time at Saint-Cloud in a Class 3 race over 1400m on April 5th. Can not be ruled out
- **7. IKEN** 5th last time, won before that over 1600m in a Class 2 handicap on September 14th at Fontainebleau. One to consider
- **8. MILAD -** 3rd last time over 1400m in a Class 3 handicap on April 10th. Ought to be in the shake-up
- **9. DZARINA** Has several unplaced runs since scoring at Compiegne on October 13th over 1400m. Needs to get back to form
- **10. MADAME DE SAXE -** 4th two starts ago in a handicap at Chantilly on October 31st over 1600m. Others make more appeal

Summary: PUERTO MADERO (3) was a good second two runs ago at Saint-Cloud over 1400m and is the tentative selection in an open race. JACK O'BOY (2) scored three runs ago over 1400m in a Class 3 race and is more than capable of being involved. KERNO QUATZ (6) is one for the each-way backers to look at after a credible run last time when fifth at Saint-Cloud. MILAD (8) makes up the shortlist.
