

R3 LE LION D'ANGERS [L-H]

C2 - PRIX VERN D'ANJOU - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Class 3 Race - Flat - EUR € 23,000

- **1. LUCKY CHOP -** Two placed runs, 3rd on the latter over 1000m in a Class 3 race at Lyon Parilly on April 23rd. Among the leading contenders
- 2. **NEAR FLY -** Unraced colt by Golden Horde, the dam was a winner over 2200m. Nice profile and should be considered each way
- **3. TREVILLY -** Unraced colt by De Treville, the dam never ran. Can be expected to improve for this debut run and is one to keep an eye on in the betting exchanges
- **4. LIMPIDE -** Two nice 3rd placed efforts, the latest over 1000m at Chantilly in a Class 3 race on April 14th. Has shown enough to get off the mark
- **5. ALGINE CHOPE -** Unraced filly by Gutaifan, the dam won 1 race over 1600m. Satble runners warrant respect. Best watched in the betting market for any support
- **6. ARTEMISE -** Unraced filly by Goken, the dam never ran. Stable runners tend to need a run or two for experience. Watch the betting patterns
- **7. UTXA -** Unraced filly by Australia, the dam never ran. Might need this run for experience, and could need a bit further in time. Watch the betting for any support
- **8. TASTEFUL -** Newcomer by Lope De Vega, the dam won 1 race and was second in the Prix Marcel Boussac (Gr.1). Nice pedigree and she can play a lead role on debut from a good stable

Summary: LIMPIDE (4) can make the best of her racecourse experience and get her first success after a pleasing third at Chantilly in a Class 3 race. She should appreciate the slight step up in trip. TASTEFUL (8) has a taking pedigree, her dam won a maiden and was second in the Prix Marcel Boussac (Gr.1). She will be well prepared for this racecourse bow. LUCKY CHOP (1) has experience and shaped well to be third last time. NEAR FLY (2) looks good on paper and is one to watch in the betting market.

C4 - PRIX DU HARAS DU PETIT TELLIER - 2400m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Class 4 Race - Flat - EUR € 8,500

- **1. ROMANELLO -** 6th last time, 2nd before that over 2100m on the PSF in a Class 4 handicap on February 13th. Has won on the turf and can not be dismissed
- **2. WEST MARTIN -** Several unplaced runs of late, the latter over 2300m at Angers on April 26th in a Class 4 handicap. One to avoid
- **3. HAVIASSOR -** Unplaced on the last start over 2400m on March 24th, 2022 in a Class 2 handicap at Saint-Cloud. He has fitness to prove but can make the frame
- **4. LASSAUT -** He has a long absence to overcome, 2nd in the Prix Niel (Gr.2) over 2400m on his penultimate start on October 11th, 2022. Fitness to prove, but is a classy performer
- **5. WINHERALD LAUJAC -** Three unplaced runs, the latter over 2100m at Senonnes on April 12th in a conditions race. Has shown very little ability
- **6. HEARTLAND -** Won on her second start at Senonnes in a conditions race on April 12th over 2100m. She should enjoy this step up in trip and can feature
- **7. ROYAL STAR -** Fair 5th over 2350m in a Class 3 race on April 21st at Machecoul. Stays well and enters calculations
- **8. VITA PIEL -** Unraced filly by Tunis, the dam never ran. Stable runners warrant respect. The betting can be the best guide
- **9. ANGLESEA -** Three unplaced runs so far, 7th on the latter over 2100m in a conditions race at Senonnes on April 12th. Place contender at best
- **10. CHAYTON GIFT -** Unplaced on the sole start over 3100m in 2024 in a Class 4 handicap at Pornichet on January 27th. Can be overlooked

Summary: LASSAUT (4) is a classy performer who was second in the Prix Niel (Gr.2) over 2400m on his penultimate start on October 11th, 2022. Absent since late October that year, he should be well prepared by connections for this return outing. He is preferred over the less experienced HEARTLAND (6), who scored on her second run at Senonnes last month and looks promising. ROMANELLO (1) acts on turf and the PSF and can not be overlooked. ROYAL STAR (7) is another to keep onside.

C6 - PRIX DES VENTES OSARUS - 2400m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Maiden Race - Flat - EUR € 9,500

- **1. KANDO -** Showed signs of ability when 9th on his debut at Haras- Du- Pin in a maiden on April 13th over 2100m. Can strip fitter this time and be on the premises
- **2. KILLER KING -** Three unplaced runs so far, the latter over 2500m in a maiden race on April 20th at Nort-Sur-Edre. Hardly inspiring form
- **3. SYTADEL -** 6th on his one run over 2200m in a maiden race at Orleans on April 6th. He will need vast progress to trouble some of these
- **4. MON BLACK DU LIVET -** Unplaced on the one run over 1600m at Saint-Malo on July 15th last year. Might need this outing after an absence
- **5. PADDOCKWOOD -** Improved effort to be 4th at Argentan on April 9th over 1900m in a claimer last time out. One to consider each-way
- **6. VALENTINE DAY -** Two unplaced runs so far, the latter over 1800m at Nort-Sur-Edre on April 20th in a maiden race. Opposable
- **7. MANEATER -** Unplaced last time, 4th before that over 1800m at Le Croise-Laroche on debut in a maiden on April 5th. Live chance
- **8. CLAIRE -** Nice debut 4th over 2100m at Haras-Du-Pin on April 13th in a maiden race. She will make progress from that experience and can play a lead role
- **9. QUEST FOR MAGIC -** Promise when 5th on her sole start over 2500m at Argentan in a maiden race on April 9th. She will know more this time and can have a say
- **10. FIVE FIVE -** Unraced gelding by French Fifteen, the dam ran a few times. From a respected stable that knows how to ready a newcomer. Watch the betting patterns for clues
- **11. MAFONTAINE -** Unraced filly by Le Brivido, the dam never ran. Likely to need this run for experience. Monitor the betting for clues

Summary: Although disappointing last time, MANEATER (7) showed plenty of ability when she was fourth on her debut early last month at Le Croise-Laroche. She is given the vote ahead of CLAIRE (8), who ran with promise when she was fourth at Hars-Du-Pin last month on her debut. QUEST FOR MAGIC (9) showed promise on debut when fifth at Argentan in April and can be considered. KANDO (1) looks best of the others.

C7 - PRIX CHRISTIAN DE TREDERN - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Maiden Race - Flat - EUR € 21,000

- **1. SANLAK -** 9th on his debut over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on March 29th in a conditions race. He should of learnt from that run and can be more involved
- **2. FRENCH DANCER -** Three runs so far, 5th on the most recent over 1650m at Machecoul on April 21st in a maiden race. Looks safely held
- **3. DON'T SHUT ME DOWN -** Fair 5th on the one run over 1800m at Fontainebleau on April 12th in a maiden race. Capable of making his presence felt
- **4. FAVOLO -** 6th on the one run over 2100m at Haras-Du-Pin in a maiden race on April 13th. Might be more suited when handicapped
- **5. KAWANN -** Promise to be 3rd in the only start over 1600m at Nantes on April 9th in a maiden race. One to respect and can make the top four
- **6. METAMORPHIC -** Ran well to be 4th at this track in a maiden race on April 6th. He can improve and can play a leading role
- **7. GORDON START -** 5th on debut at Nantes over 160m in a maiden race on April 9th. He should improve and has outside place claims
- **8. SWINGUER -** Nice 2nd over 1800m in a maiden at Le Croise-Laroche on April 5th on only his second start. He can keep improving and score
- **9. ETREHAM -** Fair 4th over 2000m at Lyon Parilly on April 23rd in a maiden race. Among the leading each-way options
- **10. CHEVALDOR -** Ran well to be 4th on the one run so far over 2100m at Haras-Du-Pin in a maiden on April 13th. Might find a few of these too smart
- **11. INCANTATION -** Well beaten over 2100m in a maiden at Haras-Du-Pin on April 13th on the one run so far. Can be overlooked
- **12. MON FAVORI -** Has been unplaced on all six runs, the latter over 1600m in a handicap at Nantes on April 9th. Faces a stiff test
- **13. DREAM INDEX -** Has shown ability in his two runs this year, 6th on the latest over 1600m at Chantilly in a maiden race on February 13th. Ought to be thereabouts
- **14. SYRUS -** 5th on debut at Haras-Du-Pin over 2100m in a maiden race on April 13th. He should improve and is best watched this time

Summary: SWINGUER (8) looks the standout in this open maiden. He showed marked improvement when runner-up at Le Croisé-Laroche on his second outing last month and can go one better. METAMORPHIC (6) made a promising debut when fourth at this track in early April and is expected to come forward for that experience. ETREHAM (9) progressed from his debut to finish fourth at Lyon-Parilly and has each-way claims. DON'T SHUT ME DOWN (3) completes the shortlist and should not be dismissed lightly.

C8 - PRIX DE CHAMPTEUSSE-SUR-BACONNE - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Maiden Race - Flat - EUR € 21,000

- **1. MELOSA -** Nice 2nd at Toulouse over 2100m on April 7th on her second start in a maiden last time. She looks progressive and can not be overlooked
- 2. SEPULVEDA Fair 5th last time over 2200m in a maiden at Fontainebleau on April 12th on her second start. She can keep on improving and is one to keep safe
- **3. GOLDEN DISC -** Improved to be 4th on her second run over 2400m at Lyon Parilly in a maiden on April 16th. One to pay attention to
- **4. LAWFUL LADY -** Ran well to be 2nd over 2100m at Haras-Du-Pin on April 13th on her debut. Progress expected and she can be competitive
- **5. XCLUSIVITE -** Placed on both runs so far, 3rd on the latest over 1950m at Le Mans on March 10th in a maiden race. Has work to do
- **6. FAJING -** Unplaced last time in a Class 1 race at Parislongchamp on April 17th over 1600m. This is less taxing, and she warrants respect
- **7. KASHARA** 9th on the one run over 2000m at this track in a maiden race on April 6th. Best watched for the time being
- **8. STITCHING WHEEL -** Unplaced over 2100m in a maiden at Saint-Cloud on April 4th last time, 2nd before that over 1600m on her second run at Clairefontaine on October 22nd. Player
- **9. KISSAKO -** 8th on the one start over 2500m at Nancy on April 5th in a maiden race. Needs vast progress to be involved
- **10. KATIE LIGHT -** Well beaten over 2300m at Angers on the one run in a maiden on April 26th. Unlikely to feature
- **11. MAPLE TAFFY -** Unplaced last time, 3rd previously on her debut at Pornichet over 2100m on February 20th in a maiden race. One to consider
- **12. SCULPTURALE -** 7th on debut over 2400m at Lyon Parilly on April 16th in a maiden race. Likely to improve and has outside place claims
- **13. HELP DAVIER -** Two unplaced runs so far, the latter over 1800m at Fontainebleau on April 12th. Needs a few to misfire
- **14. NABA QUEEN -** Unraced filly by Persian King, the dam won 1 race. From a respected stable who will have this filly well prepared for her first day at school
- **15. OBJECTIVE ONE -** Unraced filly by Kendargent, the dam won 2 races. Stable runners tend to need a run or two for experience. Watch the betting for any support
- **16. NOELLE DOREE -** Unraced by Sottsass, the dam never ran. One that might need this run for experience unless the betting says otherwise



Summary: STITCHING WHEEL (8) can be forgiven for her last run when not beaten far in a well-contested maiden at Saint-Cloud last month. She is better judged on her second at Clairefontaine last October. MELOSA (1) was a pleasing second at Toulouse on her second start and can play a lead role. SEPULVEDA (2) was a creditable fifth on her last run at Fontainebleau in mid-April and can make the frame. LAWFUL LADY (4) can improve from a pleasing second on debut and warrants respect.

C9 - PRIX FRANCE GALOP - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 15,000

- **1. DAYSANIYA -** 6th last time, she won before that over 2000m at this track in a Class 4 handicap on April 6th. Might need to drop in the weights a few kilos
- 2. ESKANDANI Unplaced last time, 3rd before that over 2000m at this track on April 21st in a Class 4 race. Place contender
- **3. MAGIC STARS -** Placed on the last two runs, the latter when 4th at Parislongchamp on April 24th in a Class 3 handicap over 1600m. Live chance
- **4. GAVIAL -** Ran well when 2nd at Nantes over 2400m in a Class 4 race on April 9th. Can make the top three
- **5. HEY MAN -** 4th on the last run at this track over 2000m in a Class 4 race on April 21st. Won twice last year in Class 4 handicaps. Outside place chance
- **6. KAHOUNA -** Won on her last start over 2500m at Evreux in a Class 4 handicap on April 15th. Can not be overlooked
- **7. TORTOLA -** Unplaced last time, 3rd previously over 2300m at Senonnes in a Class 4 handicap on March 15th. Has a stiff test ahead
- **8. KENNY -** Two unplaced runs of late, 4th before that at Deauville in a Class 4 handicap when 4th on February 1st. Capable of having a say
- **9. RONCHEROLLES -** Two unplaced runs of late, the latter over 2100m at Chantilly on October 12th in a Class 3 handicap. Might just need this run after an absence
- **10. SPINNING MIST -** She has several unplaced runs this year, the latest over 1900m at Deauville in a Class 3 handicap on April 6th. Pass over
- **11. DAFNE -** Has shown very little form recently, 8th at Angers on April 26th in a Class 4 handicap on the most recent start. Looks ungenuine
- **12. WARDAMA -** Placed on both runs this year, the latter over 2000m at Le Lion D'Angers on April 6th in a Class 4 handicap when 2nd. Player
- **13. BELLA CIAO -** Ran well to be 2nd at Saint-Cloud over 2100m in a Class 3 handicap on April 18th. Can be competitive
- 14. GOT FROST 5th last time out over 2400m at Fougeres in a Class 4 race on April 20th. Looks inconsistent

Summary: MAGIC STARS (3) has been placed on her last two starts, the latest at Parislongchamp when fourth in a well-contested Class 3 handicap. This might be less challenging, and she can get her head in front again. BELLA CIAO (13) arrives after a decent second-placed effort at Saint-Cloud in mid-April in a Class 3 handicap and can make the selection work hard. WARDAMA (12) has been placed on both runs this year and is the logical each-way option. GAVIAL (4) is also one to keep onside.

- **1. AROWN -** Four unplaced runs since a win over 2000m at Durtal on January 26th in a Class 4 race. Can make the top four
- **2. LA PELEMOISE -** 5th on her last run on the PSF over 1700m in a Class 4 race on December 29th. Others preferred
- **3. ALATHEA -** Nice 2nd on the latest start over 2000m at Fontainebleau on April 21st in a Class 3 handicap. Hard to overlook
- **4. LUNATICOS -** Four unplaced runs this year, the latter over 1600m at Nantes in a Class 4 handicap on March 30th. Opposable
- **5. ALSIMRYA -** Needed the run last time over 1900m in a Class 3 handicap at Deauville on April 8th. She can improve and can make the frame
- **6. BOETTI -** Unplaced last time, 3rd before that over 2000m at Pau in a Class 3 handicap on January 12th. In the mix
- **7. LOVE TOO -** Unplaced on the last two runs, the latter over 1600m in a Class 4 handicap at Nantes on March 30th. Can be passed over
- **8. FLUTE EN SOL -** She has dropped in the weights and was a creditable 5th over 2300m at Angers in a Class 4 handicap on April 26th on her latest run. One to pay attention to
- **9. SEABISCUIT DU RHEU -** Two unplaced runs of late, won before that at Pornichet on November 23rd in a handicap. Needs a few to falter
- **10. LOVECAYAN -** Unplaced last time, 2nd before that over 1650m at Machecoul on March 16th in a Class 4 race. Unlikely to threaten
- **11. ELKABIER -** Placed on his last two runs, the latter when 3rd at Saint-Cloud in a Class 3 handicap on April 4th. Key chance
- **12. A NOS SOUVENIRS -** Two unplaced runs last time, 3rd before that over 2200m in a Class 4 handicap at Dieppe on August 5th. Needs to be more reliable
- **13. FLAMBOYANTE -** Unplaced last time out, 3rd previously over 1950m at Le Mans in a Class 4 handicap on March 21st. One to look at each way
- **14. MARCELINE DESJY -** Unplaced last time, she won before that at Senonnes in a Class 4 handicap on March 15th. Unreliable

Summary: ELKABIER (11) has been placed on the last two runs at Saint-Cloud, when third in a Class 3 handicap in early April. ALATHEA (3) could be the main threat after a second-place effort at Fontainebleau in late April in a Class 3 handicap. FLUTE EN SOL (8) has dropped in the weights and races of an attractive handicap mark. BOETTI (6) is another to consider after a third two runs ago at Pau on the PSF.

- **1. DURYTHME -** Finished 6th in a Class 3 Conditional over 1350m at Lyon Parilly on the 16th of April 2025. One to pass over in this field
- **2. GAME RUN -** A great 2nd in a Class 2 Handicap over 1200m at Chantilly on the 14th of April 2025. Strong winning chance
- **3. OZAN -** Finished 13th in a Class 2 Handicap over 1200m at Chantilly on the 14th of April 2025. Others make more appeal
- **4. NATIONAL SERVICE -** Respectable 3rd in a Class 2 Handicap over 1200m at Chantilly on the 14th of April 2025. Include in larger exotic plays
- **5. MAJOR OAK -** Decent 6th in a Class 2 Handicap over 1200m at Chantilly on the 14th of April 2025. Good eachway chance
- **6. CHIRIMIRI -** Finished 7th in a Class 2 Handicap over 1600m at Chantilly on the 10th of December 2024. Returns from a small layoff and might need the run
- **7. WILD WEST -** Pleasing 4th in a Class 2 Handicap over 1200m at Chantilly on the 14th of April 2025. Eachway claims
- **8. FORZA CAPITANO -** Finished 8th in a Class 2 Handicap over 1200m at Chantilly on the 14th of April 2025. Hard to recommend on inconsistent form
- **9. DAIQUIBERRY -** Finished 10th in a Class 2 Handicap over 1200m at Chantilly on the 14th of April 2025. Must be included in exotic plays
- **10. SCARFACE -** Finished 10th in a Class 2 Handicap over 1400m at Parislongchamp on the 6th of April 2025. One to respectfully pass by
- **11. WOOTTON MELODY -** Finished 5th in a Class 3 Conditional over 1350m at Lyon Parilly on the 16th of April 2025. One for the quartet plays
- **12. YOKEN -** Finished 14th in a Class 2 Handicap over 1400m at Parislongchamp on the 6th of April 2025. One to ignore
- **13. DROGO -** Finished 12th in a Class 2 Handicap over 1400m at Parislongchamp on the 6th of April 2025. Others weigh more attraction
- **14. BROTHERS OF LILY'S -** Finished 16th in a Class 2 Handicap over 1200m at Chantilly on the 14th of April 2025. Currently holds a highly erratic form to boast confidence
- **15. HORTENSIA BASC -** Finished 5th in a Class 2 Handicap over 1200m at Chantilly on the 14th of April 2025. Form gives her a massive lurker chance



16. ZELASQUIN - Finished 12th in a Class 3 Handicap over 1400m at Compiegne on the 25th of April 2025. Others make more of an interest

Summary: GAME RUN (2) was a good second over the track and trip last time out and has all the equipment to go one more and end up adding to the winning tally. MAJOR OAK (5) gets the services of Mickael Barzalona and he certainly knows how to bring a horse back to his best. WILD WEST (7) was a winner in his penultimate start over the distance and must be respected as he is effective over the trip. DAIQUIBERRY (9) holds a top four place chance. NATIONAL SERVICE (4) can contend in the mix and has a shout.

C2 - PRIX DE LA MERE MARIE - 1000m (a5f) - TURF - Newcomers Race - Flat - EUR € 50,000

- 1. IKOTOFETSY Is out of Kourkie while the sire, Threat was a Group II winner. Others weigh more attraction
- **2. REDOUTABLE -** Supplemented Redoutable is out of the mare Rive Neauve who was a 1 time winner and featured in Group races while the sire, Penny's Picnic was a multiple Group winner. Include in exotics
- **3. FOCUS -** The mare, Hidaka raced 4 times for 1 win and featured in a Group III race while the sire, Siyouni, was a Group I winner. Can definitely hold a winning appearance
- **4. DREEMAH -** Is out of the lovely mare Al Jazi who was a Group III winner over British soil and the sire, Armor was a Group III winner and featured in Group races. Could be anything according to pedigree, do follow
- **5. EXTRAVAGANZA -** Is out of Killi who was a 4 time winner over 24 starts while the sire, Muhaar was a multiple Group I winner. Strong sire form, but the mare does not give confidence
- **6. POETIC FLOWER -** Is out of the unraced mare Jacinta De Vega while the sire Ardad was a Group II winner and Listed winner. Others have more appeal
- **7. HERE I BOW -** The mare So Like Your Moves did not break her maiden during her racing career while the sire, Bow Creek was a Group winner in Ireland and Britain. One to pass by respectfully
- **8. SHOW SET -** Is out of the experienced mare Astrologia while the sire, Birchwood was a Listed winner and featured in Group races. Include in quartet plays
- **9. SELF CONTROL -** Is out of the unraced mare Spanish Angel, while the sire Starspangledbanner was a multiple Group I winner and featured in multiple Group races. If ready, can start her career with winning ways
- **10. PIANA -** The mare, Restless had 13 runs and did not break her maiden while the sire, Zelzal was a multiple Group winner. One for the backend of quartets

Summary: SELF CONTROL (9) takes her place in this difficult unraced Conditional but her pedigree does show if the run is not needed, she can start with winning ways. FOCUS (3) is piloted by Maxime Guyon who can produce a solid ride on this young colt and put his best foot forward. DREEMAH (4) is a lovely bred horse that has all the talent in the world to produce an eye catching debut run. REDOUTABLE (2) wraps up the top four mix and can feature.

C3 - PRIX DE GUICHE - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Gr3 Race - Flat - EUR € 80,000

- **1. PURE LEGEND -** Produced a decent 3rd in a Class 1 Conditional over 1600m at Parislongchamp on the 17th of April 2025. Eachway chance
- **2. LES PETITS PRINCES -** A winner in his last start over 1600m at Chantilly on the 17th of March 2025. Must have a bright chance in featuring
- **3. AL AALI -** Finished 3rd in a Listed over 1800m at Chantilly on the 9th of March 2025. Respectable recent form but one to pass by here
- **4. CUALIFICAR -** A winner in a Group III contest over 1800m at Parislongchamp on the 6th of April 2025. Strong winning chance
- **5. BULNES -** A winner in a Class 1 Conditional over 1900m at La-Teste Bassin Arcachon on the 2nd of April 2025. Does look to be the dark horse that can disrupt the top four
- **6. CURRAGH CAMP -** A pleasing 2nd in a Listed over 1800m at Chantilly on the 9th of March 2025. Include in exotics
- **7. MADERO -** Was not disgraced when finishing 7th in a Group III contest over 1600m at Parislongchamp on the 13th of April 2025. Include for the quartet plays

Summary: CUALIFICAR (4) was a solid winner in a Group III contest over the distance and he can certainly follow up on that win here.
