RACE 1: BRITISH STALLION STUDS EBF 'NEWCOMERS' MAIDEN FILLIES' STAKES (GBB RACE)

Elegant Charm Jalapa Liberalist

With William Buick riding at Saratoga on Saturday, James Doyle gets the mount on newcomer ELEGANT CHARM, a daughter of Exceed And Excel, and representing the Charlie Appleby yard who are in great form. She could make a winning debut, though Jalapa is a half-sister to Irish Derby winner Westover and is clearly one to watch. Liberalist is another to keep an eye on in a field that may well be full of future winners.

Madame Ambassador is proving difficult to win with and is dropped to this grade for the first time since 2021, but a distant last at Pontefract in July leaves her with plenty to find. She is better than that and could place, but if FEARLESS BAY gets home over the mile and a half, he may come put on top. A running-on third at Windsor last week, he looks a player now, and could have the edge over Dark Mystery, who is expected to be far happier dropping back in distance.

A step up in class may not be enough to faze Night Of Luxury, who arrives in this following a comfortable win over this trip at Epsom last month. Nonetheless, he now receives a 6lb higher mark for that win, so preference is for the relatively unexposed FALLING SHADOW. Charlie Appleby's charge finished a disappointing seventh on his latest outing at Royal Ascot in June, but he has every chance of building on his handicap bow in this contest. Kenzai Warrior is another who merits consideration.

2 DARAMETHOS A winner at 1m 2f on the all-weather. Beaten 13l behind Wink Of An Eye at 3-1fav when last of 8 on his latest outing over this course and distance (good to soft) in June last year.

3 FALLING SHADOW A winner at 1m 2f on good ground. Beaten 9l behind Missed The Cut at 13-2 when seventh of 13 on his latest outing at Ascot over 1m 2f (good to firm) in June.

4 WONDER ELMOSSMAN Successful at 7f and 1m on the all-weather. Beaten 1 3/4l by Sea The Shells when second of 8 at 17-2 on his latest outing at Chelmsford City over 1m 2f last month.

5 WHITEFEATHERSFALL A winner at 1m 1f on good to firm ground. Beaten 15l behind Warren Point at 14-1 when 9th of 13 on his latest outing at Goodwood over 1m 2f (good to firm) last month.

6 NIGHT OF LUXURY Successful twice at 1m 2f on good to firm and soft ground. Won on his latest outing when 5-4fav at Epsom over 1m 2f (good to firm) last month, beating Wisper by 1 3/4l. Has also won at Leicester this season.

LAKOTA SIOUX remains of interest having recorded a good third in Listed company at Ascot in June, and further improvement could be just around the corner given she managed to see off the well-fancied Alfred Munnings into sixth position during that contest. Ivory Madonna seems a big threat stepping up in trip, given she kept on well for second over 6f last time out, while Divina Grace recently scored over this C&D and completes the shortlist.
