

R3 LE MANS [L-H]

C1 - PRIX DE CHAUFOUR-NOTRE-DAME - 1950m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 2 - Flat - EUR € 24,700

- **1. LE LANDIN -** Nice win over 1650m in a maiden race at Craon on September 6th by 0.75L. He is open to more progress and warrants respect
- 2. VAN BLUTCH Facile success by 11L on his only start over 1800m in a maiden race at La Teste on September 6th. He looks above average and can follow up
- **3. MAGDA -** Good win when getting on top near the line on his second start over 1700m at Marseille Borely on September 4th in a maiden race. He will thrive over this extra distance
- **4. MUSICAL MOON -** Nice win on her second start at Le Mans over this trip on September 12th in a maiden race. Has to improve further to be involved in the finish
- **5. MADAME LY -** Two wins of late, the latter over 1600m in a handicap at Saint-Cloud on September 26th by 2.5L. She is improving and can play a live role
- **6. DELICADA -** Won on her sole start over 1800m at Saint-Malo on August 29th in a conditions race in a close finish. Improvement expected but this is a much stronger race and others preferred

Summary: VAN BLUTCH (2) made a striking debut, winning by an impressive 11 lengths at La Teste in early September. He's open to further improvement and could well follow up. LE LANDIN (1) deserves respect after scoring in a 1650m maiden at Craon last month. The step up in trip could unlock additional progress. MAGDA (3) also looks likely to appreciate the extra distance, having finished strongly to win last time out at Marseille-Borély in September.

C2 - PRIX DES OEILLETS - 1950m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 2 - Flat - EUR € 20,100

- **1. TORRONE -** 8th last time out, 3rd previously over 2000m in a Class 1 race at Le Lion D'angers on July 18th. He won on debut at Cholet in June over 2100m.
- **2. SPRINT FINAL -** Two unplaced efforts so far, the latter over 1800m at Morlaix in a maiden race on May 11th.
- **3. THE LAST FOAL -** 7th on his debut at Landivisiau over 2150m in a maiden race on September 21st.
- **4. BLOWN BY THE WIND -** Four unplaced runs this year, all in decent races, below par in a Class 2 race at Compiegne over 1600m on September 24th. Capable if returning to her better form
- **5. SEPULVEDA** Unplaced last time, a win previously over 2000m at Le Lion D'Angers on May 6th in a maiden race.
- **6. DUNE -** 6th in a Listed race at La Teste in late August last time out, 2nd previously over 1800m in a Class 1 race at Compiegne on June 21st. Player
- **7. MELANESIA -** Credible 6th in a Class 2 race at Parislongchamp on September 4th, she won before that over 2200m at Clairefontaine in a maiden in mid-August. Can have a say

Summary: DUNE (6) found Listed company a bit too demanding at La Teste in late August, but her runner-up finish in a Class 1 at Compiègne in June was a solid effort. She gets the marginal vote ahead of MELANESIA (7), who ran respectably in a Class 2 event at ParisLongchamp on September 4th. BLOWN BY THE WIND (4) has been slightly below her best of late, but if she can bounce back to form, she must be taken seriously. SEPULVEDA (5) looks the best of the remainder.

C3 - PRIX D'ALLONNES - 1950m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Maiden - Flat - EUR € 14,600

- **1. FIVESTARS -** Ran her best race so far when 2nd over 1600m in a claimer at Mont-De-Marsan on August 1st last time out. In the mix
- **2. LES PATINS -** Two unplaced runs so far, the latter over 1800m at Compiegne on September 16th. Needs vast progress to make the frame
- **3. JOUR DE COEUR -** Unplaced on the one run so far over 1600m at Chantilly on September 20th. Has to improve a large amount to be involved
- **4. FIRST LADY STAR -** Two runs so far, both unplaced, with the latter over track and trip in a maiden race on September 12th. Look elsewhere
- **5. RUE RECAMIER -** 7th on her only start over 2000m at Vichy in a maiden race on September 22nd. Others make more appeal
- **6. MIDNIGHT MAGIC -** Showed improvement to be 2nd on her second start over the track and trip in a maiden on September 12th, when beaten in a close finish. She can go one place better
- **7. TEAM BREIZH -** Improved effort to finish 3rd over track and trip on September 12th in a maiden race. Capable of making an impact
- **8. MAPAQUITA -** 6th on her sole start over 1600m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat on September 8th in a conditions race. Progress expected stepping up in distance today
- **9. MUHA MALPIC -** Unraced filly by Muhaarar, the dam never ran. From a respected trainer who can ready a newcomer to strike on debut. Monitor the betting patterns closely
- **10. KAISERROSE -** Unraced filly by Japan, the dam won two races and was Listed placed. From a top stable that will have this filly well prepared for her first day at school. The betting can be informative

Summary: MIDNIGHT MAGIC (6) looks the most sensible option in this fillies' event. She was narrowly beaten into second over this track and trip in early September and can go one better here. Her likely main rival is TEAM BREIZH (7), who finished third in that same race, one length behind, when they met on September 12th. MUHA MALPIC (9) has an appealing profile and is worth monitoring in the betting for any support. Debutante KAISERROSE (10) is another to keep in mind and could run well.

C4 - PRIX D'AIGNE - 1950m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Maiden - Flat - EUR € 14,600

- **1. ROBERTO PESTO -** 5th on his one run over 1800m at Saint-Malo on August 29th in a maiden race. Improvement needed to make the top four
- **2. AVISIO -** One run so far when he failed to feature over 1600m at Angers on September 22nd in a conditions race. Makes little appeal
- **3. MILANO -** 9th on his debut at Saint-Cloud on September 12th in a conditions race. He will be expected to improve and is worth watching with an each-way possibility

4. CORTESE D'ASTI -

- **5. STILL LOVING DREAM -** Unplaced on his only start over 1950m at this track in a maiden race on September 12th. Has work ahead to make the top four
- **6. NABAB ' K -** Placed 4th on his two runs, the most recent over 2000m at Vichy in a maiden on September 22nd. Ought to be thereabouts
- **7. LE SENONNAIS -** Two unplaced runs so far, the latter over 1650m at Craon on September 28th in a maiden race. Unlikely to be a threat
- **8. DIABLOTIN -** Two 4th placed runs so far, the latter over 1950m at this track in a maiden race on September 12th. Capable of being competitive
- **9. LAPENTY -** Unraced colt by Ectot, the dam won 2 races, including a Group 3 race, and was placed in a Group 2 event. Nice pedigree and from a stable that knows the time of day. Bold show expected
- **10. CLOTH OF GOLD -** Unraced gelding by Cloth Of Stars, the dam won 6 races, including a Listed, Group 3, and was placed in a Group 2 race. One to pay attention to
- **11. GOLD STANDARD -** Unraced colt by Galileo Gold, the dam ran once. Likely to know what is required from a stable that can ready a newcomer. Monitor the betting patterns
- **12. AUGIAS -** Unraced gelding by Gutaifan, the dam ran three times. Can be expected to improve for this run, and his trainer is not known for first-time out winners
- **13. ESKENDER GLAZ -** Newcomer by The Grey Gatsby, the dam never ran. His trainer is not known to produce many first-time-out winners. The betting patterns could be informative

Summary: DIABLOTIN (8) has been fourth on the last two runs, the most recent at this track in a maiden race in early September. He is the tentative selection ahead of LAPENTY (9), who looks good on paper. His dam was a smart performer who won at Group 3 level. The booking of Maxime Guyon catches the eye. CLOTH OF GOLD (10) is also making his debut and is one to keep an eye on in the betting market. NABAB ' K (6) looks best of the remainder.

C5 - PRIX REINE BERENGERE - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Class 2 - Flat - EUR € 24,700

- **1. NORTH ICE -** Recent success on his third start over 1200m at Marseille Borely in a maiden race on September 15th. He can play a lead role again
- **2. DOLLAR DES BOIS -** Won on his second run over 1650m at Sable-Sur-Sarthe on August 31st in a maiden race last time out. Up in class, and others seem better equipped
- **3. FARFLIES -** Won on her debut over 1400m at Strasbourg on September 14th in a maiden race. She will improve and warrants respect
- **4. HERE I BOW -** Three unplaced runs since a win over 1350 at Lyon Parilly on August 23rd in a maiden race. Possible place contender
- **5. DARINICE -** Got off the mark on her fourth start at Niort in a maiden over 1400m on September 14th. This requires a good deal more, and others preferred
- **6. WARAMINI -** Unplaced last time out in a strong Class 2 race, a win previously over 1400m at Compiegne on July 21st in a maiden race. One to pay attention to
- **7. KOZLOVSKHA** Ran with promise when 4th on her sole start over 1600m in a conditions race at Chantilly on September 20th. Ought to make the top four with progress expected
- **8. SANGOMAR -** Placed on both of her starts, the latter over 1600m at Chantilly on September 15th in a Class 2 race. Can be involved at the finish

Summary: NORTH ICE (1) got a deserved success over 1200m on his latest start at Marseille Borely in mid-September. The step back up to 1400m should not be a concern. He can get the verdict over WARAMINI (6), who ran in a strong Class 2 race at Deauville last time and is best judged on her win at Compiegne in July. SANGOMAR (8) has shown promise and can be involved at the business end. KOZLOVSKHA (7) can improve from her debut fourth and looks best of the rest.

C6 - PRIX DE SARGE-LES-LE-MANS - 3200m (a2m) - TURF - Class 2 - Flat - EUR € 20,100

- **1. SYNERGETIC -** Four unplaced runs of late, well beaten in a handicap on his last start at Saint-Cloud on September 2nd. Unlikely to be a threat
- **2. TALGAT -** 7th on his last start in a Class 2 race in late August, a win previously over 2650m at Chateaubriant on June 25th in a maiden race. He can make his presence felt
- **3. KANDO -** Got his first success over 3100m at Saint-Cloud in a maiden race on September 12th on his last start. Ought to be in the shake-up
- **4. SPANISH PRINCE -** Decent 2nd over 2300m at this track in a Class 2 race on September 12th. Capable of making the top three
- **5. BLACK ULTRA -** Unplaced last time out, a win previously over 2200m at La Teste on June 26th in a maiden race. One for the shortlist
- **6. IKKO -** Two unplaced runs of late, 6th on the latter of them over 2400m at Salon Provence in a handicap on September 13th. Look for an alternative
- **7. DER SHTERN -** Won on the one run so far over 2400m at La-Roche-Posay on September 14th in a conditions race. He should step forward for that experience and enters calculations
- **8. HERMETIC -** Ran well to get off the mark on his second start at Le Lion D'Angers on September 20th in a maiden race last time out. One to keep safe
- **9. DARINGA** Unplaced last time out, a win before that over 3000m in a handicap at Le Lion D'Angers on August 14th. Faces a stiff task
- **10. ILE DE RE -** Won on her second run over 2650m at Chateaubriant on May 12th in a maiden race. This will be more challenging

Summary: TALGAT (2) looks like the best option in this Class 2 event. He ran a reasonably good race in a strong Class 2 race at Clairefontaine in late August when last seen. He gets the verdict ahead of HERMETIC (8), who ran with promise when he got off the mark at Le Lion D'Angers in late September in a maiden race. SPANISH PRINCE (4) looks like a good option for the each-way backers to take seriously. KANDO (3) is also worth a mention.

C7 - PRIX DE CHAMPAGNE - 1950m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Handicap - Flat - EUR € 16,300

- **1. ELFENN -** Two unplaced runs since a win at Vichy in a handicap on July 16th over 2000m. Has work ahead to make the frame
- **2. TIYANADA -** Two unplaced efforts since a 2nd on her debut at Compiegne on May 21st in a maiden event. Needs to raise her game to trouble the judge
- **3. PETITFLEURDECHAMPS -** Two unplaced efforts this year, the latter over 1600m in a claiming race at Vichy on September 22nd. Can be avoided
- **4. HAYA LAND -** Two unplaced runs since a 3rd over 1600m in a handicap at Vichy on July 18th. Can make his presence felt
- **5. CHRISTINE -** Two recent unplaced efforts, 4th previously at Vittel on August 12th over 2100m in a handicap. Others make more appeal
- **6. LA CACHUCHA -** Ran well to be 2nd on her last run over 2000m at Mont-De-Marsan on September 10th in a Class 3 race. One to keep onside
- **7. FROMONTINE -** Two placed runs of late, 2nd on the most recent over 1950m at this track in a handicap on September 12th. Hard to ignore
- **8. CAMICA -** 6th on her last start over 2300m at Le Mans in a Class 2 race on September 12th. Hardly inspiring credentials
- **9. MR HARPIN** 6th on his last run in late February over 2150m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer. He won a claimer at the same track in early February. This might be difficult for him
- **10. BUFFALO WOMAN -** 7th on her last run, a win before that over 2100m at Le Touquet in a claiming event on August 17th. One to consider each way
- **11. TWARAB -** He has solid form with five recent placed runs, 4th on the latter over track and trip in a handicap on September 12th. Can make the top four
- **12. READY TO GO** Fair effort to be 4th on her last start over 2000m at Mont-de-Marsan on September 10th in a Class 3 race. Place contender
- **13. REJAITT -** 4th on the last run over 2350m in a handicap at Strasbourg on September 14th. She is still looking for her first success, and others seem more likely
- **14. GYP SEA -** Two placed runs of late, 4th on the latter over 1600m in a handicap at Bordeaux Le Bouscat on September 8th. Key chance
- **15. THE BIG TICKET -** Three unplaced runs, well beaten over 2000m in a claimer at Parislongchamp on July 3rd when last seen. Looks safely held

Summary: GYP SEA (14) has been in solid form in her last two outings. Her fourth-place finish at Bordeaux Le Bouscat in early September was a respectable effort, and she looks ready to get her head back in front. FROMONTINE (7) could pose the main threat; she's been placed in her last two starts, including one over this track and trip, and commands plenty of respect. TWARAB (11) has been remarkably consistent, hitting the frame in five recent runs, and can't be ruled out. LA CACHUCHA (6) is another worth considering.

C8 - PRIX DE LA CHAPELLE-SAINT-AUBIN - 1950m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 3 Handicap - Flat - EUR € 19,200

- **1. LOVE IS GOLD -** Recent success over 2150m at Landivisiau in a Class 4 race on September 21st. Hard to rule out of the top three
- **2. SCHIKERIA -** Placed 4th on her two runs this year. The latest over 2200m at Lyon Parilly in a Class 3 race on September 16th. She can be hard to beat
- **3. LAUPER -** Two recent solid efforts, 3rd on the latter over 1400m at Dax in a claiming race on September 13th. Others seem more likely
- **4. NOLITO -** Placed on his last four runs, 2nd on the latter over 2000m at Vichy in a Class 3 handicap on September 22nd. In the mix
- **5. BENIMARU -** Two unplaced runs since a 2nd over 2000m at Saint-Cloud on April 4th in a Class 3 handicap. He needs to be more reliable
- **6. GOGUEN SPAISE -** Four unplaced runs recently, 5th on the most recent over 1850m at Parislongchamp on September 14th in a Class 2 handicap. Has a place chance at nice odds
- **7. BAD ROMANCE -** Three unplaced efforts since a win over 2300m at this track on May 3rd in a Class 3 race. Likes the track and warrants respect
- **8. UNEXPECTED GIRL -** Unplaced on the one run this year over 1800m in a Class 3 claiming race at Chantilly on September 15th. One to avoid
- **9. KER WELEN -** Fair run to be 4th at Angers on September 22nd in a Class 4 race over 1600m last time out. Can play a lead role
- **10. VILLA DARYA** Placed 4th on her last run over 2150m at Landivisiau on September 21st in a Class 4 event. She needs a few to misfire
- **11. WARDAMA -** She has won three of her last four starts, the latest success was over 2000m at Saint-Cloud on September 19th in a Class 3 handicap. Ought to be in the shake-up
- **12. HIGHBARI -** 7th last time out, a win previously over 1600m at Aurillac in a Class 4 race on September 14th. Unlikely to trouble some of these
- **13. CHESTER SKY -** 4th on his last start over 2200m at Rostrenen in a Class 4 event on June 7th. This requires a good bit more to feature
- **14. DSCHINGIS GALI -** Not seen since an unplaced effort over 1900m in a Class 3 claimer on November 27th, 2024. Likely to need this run for fitness
- **15. DELTA SPIRIT -** Credible 4th on his last run over 2000m at Fontainebleau in a Class 4 race on September 21st. One to consider each way

Summary: SCHIKERIA (2) could prove the best option in this open handicap that closes the card. She ran a solid race when fourth at Lyon-Parilly in a Class 3 event in September and should go well again. LOVE IS GOLD (1) may pose a threat despite carrying top weight and will look to make life difficult for the selection. KER WELEN (9) appears a smart inclusion in all place bet combinations, given his consistency. NOLITO (4) has hit the frame in his last four starts and cannot be ruled out of the placings.

C1 - PRIX AU-DELA DES PISTES - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 16,300

- **1. TIGER KING** Won a Handicap over this course and distance on 18 September. That victory was with authority and he can cope with the 5-pound penalty
- **2. CARLSTON -** Finished 9th in a Claimer over 1650m at Amiens on 28 September. Looks outclassed in this company
- **3. CHIAREGGIO -** Finished 7th in a Handicap over 2000m at Vichy on 22 September. Form is not good enough to be considered
- **4. MANDRES -** Ran 10th in a Handicap over 1500m at Deauville on 21 August. She is a winner at this track and has competed against stronger
- **5. LIDISBARN -** Ran 6th in a Claimer over this course and distance on 18 September. Has form at this course but will need to do more
- **6. COEUR DE ROUME** Ran 7th in a Handicap over 1600m at Compiegne on 24 September. He will need to up his game in order to feature
- **7. TENNESSEE JOHN -** Ran 14th in a Handicap over 2500m at Deauville on 16 August. Poor form and cannot be considered
- **8. LAURENT -** Ran 6th in a Handicap over 1600m at Compiegne on 24 September. His rating has dropped and that could make him the surprise package in this field
- **9. COGOLIN -** Ran 2nd in a Handicap over this course and distance on 18 September. His rating has dropped to a level which will make his competitive in this sort of race
- **10. JOAO -** Ran 3rd in a Handicap over this course and distance on 18 September. He ran well enough at this course last time to be a contender in this
- **11. SHANNA ROSE -** Finished 6th in a Handicap over 1800m at Clairefontaine on 22 August. Could place in what is a very open race
- **12. AMOUAGE -** Won a Handicap over this course and distance on 18 September. Another with a victory at this course and is expected to be competitive
- **13. LAPPUHRCHE -** Ran 7th in a race over 1600m at Baden Baden in Germany on 3 September. His current form is not strong enough
- **14. NOBLE ANGEL -** Ran 4th in a Handicap over 2200m at Amiens on 28 September. Her form has been consistent and she does have decent form at this course
- **15. JOJO -** Ran 6th in a race over 1600m at Ostende in Belgium on 25 August. Has been performing well and might have confidence on her return to France



Summary: This looks a highly competitive event but COGOLIN (9) has a win, a second and a third in three starts at this course, all over 1800m, and off a competitive rating looks the runner to beat. MANDRES (4) disappointed last time but is another who runs well at the course. NOBLE ANGEL (14) is consistent and seldom runs a bad race. JOAO (10) has good form at this level and is also worth consideration.

C2 - PRIX DE L'AVESNOIS - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 14,400

- **1. HUNTER VALLEY -** Ran 4th in a race over 1500m at Mons-Ghlin in Belgium on 1 October. She has some decent form in Belgium and could cause an upset
- **2. QUEEN'S ANGEL -** Ran 7th in a Handicap over this course and distance on 18 September. She finished strongly in that race and could place
- **3. KATUBA -** Ran 5th in a race over 1200m at Ostende in Belgium on 7 July. Earlier form in France was not good but displayed ability in Belgium
- **4. LE CHAT BOTTE -** Finished 10th in a Handicap over 2200m at Amiens on 28 September. He is better than that last run and must be considered
- **5. ANGEL DUST -** Ran 5th in a Handicap over 1600m at Compiegne on 24 September. Runs well at this level, has won at this course and should go close
- **6. PEARL HARBOUR -** Ran 2nd in a Handicap over this course and distance on 18 September. She is in top form, has won at the course and looks the runner to beat
- **7. ELEGANCE DOREE -** Finished 14th in a Handicap over 1600m at Compiegne on 19 April. Been off for almost six months and could need the run
- **8. PALETUVIER -** Finished 12th in a Handicap over this course and distance on 12 September. Looks unlikely to feature in this event
- **9. SHOWBOATED -** Ran 10th in a Handicap over 1400m at Strasbourg on 27 September. Form is poor and he cannot be considered
- **10. ANTICO -** Ran 14th in a Handicap over 1900m at Chantilly on 25 September. His current rating makes him competitive and was not far behind PEARL HARBOUR (6) two runs back
- **11. SARACEN STAR -** Ran 4th in a race over 2100m at Mons-Ghlin in Belgium on 1 October. First run back in France since 2023. Drops in distance
- **12. PRINCEDESCHAMPS -** Ran 6th in a Handicap over this course and distance on 18 September. He is returning to form and is suited to the course
- **13. PADDY WHITE HEART -** Ran 8th in a Handicap over 1800m at Chantilly on 5 September on 5 September. Not in good form and unlikely to feature
- **14. PEANUT ROYALE -** Ran 8th in a Handicap over 2200m at Amiens on 28 September. She will need to up her game to feature
- **15. WHAT DO YOU SAY -** Finished 8th in a Handicap over 2000m at Vichy on 22 September. His form is poor and he cannot be considered

Summary: PEARL HARBOUR (6) was the 'money horse' in her last start over this track and trip but found one too good. She should go one better this time. ANTICO (10) was not far behind her in that race and on that basis stands out as the main danger. ANGEL DUST (5) is in good form and looks suited to the race conditions and that makes her a serious contender. PRINCEDESCHAMPS (12) showed a return to form last time.

C3 - PRIX DU PLOUICH - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Claiming - Flat - EUR € 11,500

- **1. MISS ANGEL -** Ran 3rd in a Claimer over 1900m at Chantilly on 20 September. That was a top effort after having contested Quinté+ races. A deserved favourite
- **2. LORD ASCOT -** Ran 10th in a Claimer over this course and distance on 18 September. Well held by others on recent form
- **3. ZUNDER -** Ran 5th in a race over 1600m at Dusseldorf in Germany on 14 September. Will be fitted with Australian blinkers for the first time so could be competitive
- **4. ZARREEN -** Finished 10th in a Maiden over 1350m at Lyon Parilly on 29 September. Unlikely to feature in this event
- **5. PINYA -** Won a Maiden over 1650m at Sable/Sarthe on 31 August. That form was franked by the runner-up who went on to win at this course
- **6. JOUKOVKA -** Finished 11th in a Handicap over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on 12 September. Held by others on her last run
- **7. RUE DE L'ODEON -** Ran 11th in a Handicap over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on 12 September. Drops in class and that could give her a place chance
- **8. GOLDEN VALE -** Ran 4th in a Claimer over 2100m at Angers on 22 September. She is always thereabouts at this level so has place prospects
- **9. ENYA -** Unraced 3yo filly by Fighting Irish out of Monsun mare Eva's Time. Granddam contested a Group 1 race at Leopardstown in Ireland
- **10. MIAIMAOU** Ran 6th in a Claimer over this course and distance on 18 September. She is competitive at this level and could place
- **11. DIYAA -** Ran 12th in a Handicap over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on 12 September. Will need to up her game to feature
- **12. KALINAGO -** Ran 13th in a Handicap over 2000m at Saint-Cloud on 19 September. That was her first run after a rest so improvement is expected
- **13. GERMAN STYLE -** Ran 5th in a race over 2050m at Magdeburg in Germany on 13 September. Has form over this distance in Germany

Summary: MISS ANGEL (1) has raced in far stronger company and showed last time when dropping back to a Claimer that she is highly competitive at this level. That does make her the runner they all have to beat. PINYA (5) got off the mark last time with a win in a Maiden and could go on with her lifted confidence. Once you look past those two there are many with chances, in particular RUE DE L'ODEON (7), who drops in class, and ZUNDER (3), who will race in Australian blinkers this time.

- **1. AMELIA -** Ran 6th in a Claimer over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on 19 September. She has performed admirably at this level and will appreciate the drop in distance
- **2. LANDSCAPE -** Ran 10th in a Handicap over 1200m at Chantilly on 25 September. He is a lot better than that race suggests and back in this class he should show his best form
- **3. ASENSEOFSERENITY -** Ran 5th in a Claimer over 1300m at Chantilly on 5 September. Never far behind in a race at this level and there was a lot to like about the way she finished off her last run
- **4. ST GERMAIN -** Ran 3rd in a Claimer over this course and distance on 18 September. That was good enough to make him a consideration in this line-up
- **5. FIRE UP THE JETS -** Ran 4th in a Claimer over 1100m at Salon Provence on 30 September. Has more to do but could place
- **6. ANESIDORA -** Ran 4th in a Claimer over this course and distance on 18 September. Will need to up his game to be competitive
- **7. RETT LIKE -** Ran 5th in a Claimer over 1400m at Lion D'Angers on 20 September. Will need to do more to be competitive
- **8. CAPOUCHINE -** Ran 4th in a Claimer over 1400m at Lion D'Angers on 20 September. She runs well in Claimers and could cause a surprise
- **9. IGETAKICKOUTOFYOU -** Finished 6th in a race over 1000m at Tipperary in Ireland on 27 May. Faces a lot stronger this time
- **10. AVENUE CHOPE -** Finished 10th in a Claimer over 1400m at Chantilly on 30 September. Appears unlikely to feature
- **11. ARTEMISE -** Finished 10th in a Maiden over 1200m at Saint-Cloud on 19 September. This is her first run in a Claimer and the drop in class should suit

Summary: This appears to be a wide-op race but there is lot going for AMELIA (1) who seldom disappoints in Claiming races. She will also enjoy dropping back to 1100m this time. ASENSEOFSERENITY (3) tends to run well in races at this level and should be competitive once again. ARTEMISE (11) has been contesting Handicaps and should improve dropping in class. One should ignore the last run of LANDSCAPE (2) and he could show more at this level.

- **2. LITTLE JUMBY -** Has struggled of late and was 8th in a Conditions race at Niort over 1400m o 14 September. Capable of making the frame
- **3. GUALTALLARY -** Has not shown much yet and was 11th in a handicap over this track and trip on 18 September. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. EL MADAR -** Did not show his best when 9th in a Conditions race at Fontainebleau over 1200m 21 September. Did better earlier this year and can be competitive
- **5. GOT BLOOM -** Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a handicap at Le Touquet over 1300m on 17 August. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **6. LABELLED WITH LOVE -** Has run well in both her starts, the latest when third in a Conditions race at Angers over 1600m on 11 September. Has claims this shorter distance

- **8. LIPS PEARL -** Well beaten in both starts, the latest when 11th in a Conditions race at Dieppe over 1100m on 7 June. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **9. TSARINAS SONG -** Did not show her best when 7th in a handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 1350m on 16 September. Capable of better and is not out of it
- **10. BREATHE ON -** Has struggled this year and finished 6th in a handicap at Mons over 950m on 12 September. Did better last year and could earn some money
- **11. FORZA BELLA -** Has struggled in her four starts so far, the latest when 8th in a claimer at Vichy over 1600m on 22 September. Others make more appeal
- **12. PEGGIES REVENGE** Only modest of late and finished 6th in a handicap over this track and trip on 18 September. Can earn some money

Summary: LABELLED WITH LOVE (6) has shown promise so far in her first two starts. The drop in distance is interesting, but she may well be better than these rivals. PREA GIANCA (7) has reached 17 starts without winning a race but can still be a threat to these rivals. TSARINAS SONG (9) did not show her best on local debut but has claims. EL MADAR (4) has struggled in France so far but is also not out of it.

- **3. GIORGIANA -** Has won her last two starts in this division, the latest was over this track and trip on 18 September. Can double up
- **4. EXCALIBUR -** Did not show his best when 9th in this division over this course and distance on 18 September. Capable of better and could play a minor role
- **5. LOVELY ANGEL -** Showed some improvement when third in this division at Amiens over 1650m on 28 September. Big chance in this line-up
- **6. HALL OF FAME -** Yet to win a race and finished 9th in a handicap at Angers over 1350m on 22 September. Capable of improvement ,dropping to a claimer

- **3. ZILCOVER -** Has really struggled of late and was tenth in a Conditions race at Wissembourg over 3000m on 9 June. Returns from a break and others make more appeal
- **4. COMBERMERE -** Has struggled this year and was 11th in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 2200m on 14 September. Did better last year and is not out of it
- **5. SIGN OF STARS -** Unreliable and was unplaced last time out in a Conditions race at Lyon-Parilly over 3400m on 16 September. Better this distance and can contest the finish
- **6. GALEGO STAR -** Unreliable and finished sixth at this level at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 2200m on 22 August, Did better before that and could play a minor role
- **7. DSCHINGIS JOY -** Has struggled of late and was 9th in a Conditions race at Craon over 3000m on 29 September. Capable of an upset dropping to a claimer

- **4. ZELMAN** Did not show his best when 7th in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 6 March. Returns from a break but can score
- **5. SPEEDSTER -** Has struggled of late and was tenth in a handicap at Deauville over 1400m on 3 August. Tries further and can upset
- **6. REAL LOVE -** Showed some improvement and was runner-up at Bad Harzburg over 1550m on 26 July. Tougher task in this line-up
- **7. COSMIC FRONT -** Holding form and finished fourth in a Conditions race at Argentan over 2900m on 4 June. Drops in distance but can play a minor role
