Alsvinder Captain Corcoran Not On Your Nellie

Captain Corcoran brings winning C&D form to the table and warrants respect on his seasonal bow, while Not On Your Nellie also has a lengthy absence to overcome but is more than capable of a big performance. It could, however, pay to side with a race-fit ALSVINDER. He races off a 13lb lower mark than when runner-up on the all-weather at Lingfield last time and dropping back from 6f will likely help. Under top apprentice Billy Garritty, a bold bid looks assured.

Daddy Frank Ebnzaidoon Diamond Of Dubai

John & Thady Gosden look to have a strong hand here and slight preference is for their DADDY FRANK. He has been denied by just a neck in both of his two outings so far, but the Frankel colt has looked a winner in waiting and is backed to make it third time lucky here. The Clarehaven team are also responsible for Ebnzaidoon, who cost \$825,000 and has made the podium on both starts so far. Richard Hannon won this in 2019 and his Dubawi colt Diamond Of Dubai could go one better than his encouraging Lingfield second on debut, while Dubawi Sands also runs in the colours of Sheikh Mohammed Obaid Al Maktoum and requires a market check.

Plymouth Rock is back down to his last winning mark and is tried in first-time blinkers on just his second start for David Loughnane. Channel Packet was third over 10 furlongs at Chelmsford last week and drops back in trip off the same figure, while Sorbonne struggled in heavy ground in his final appearance of 2020, but before that was progressing nicely and will appreciate a sound surface here.
