

R1 Longchamp [R-H]

C1 - QATAR CUP - PRIX DRAGON - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Claiming - Flat - EUR € 100,000

- **1. MOSHRIF** Placed on his last two runs, 4th on the most recent over 2000m in a Group 1 PA race at Deauville on August 5th. Hard to ignore
- **2. AL ZWAIR -** Unplaced on his last few starts, 5th on the most recent over 1600m in a Group 3 PA race at San Sebastian (ESP) on August 15th. Look elsewhere
- **3. LUWSAIL -** He won two races in the Spring, the latest of them on his penultimate start, which was a Group 1 PA race over 2000m at this track on May 11th. He was 2nd at Deauville over 2000m in a Group 1 PA on August 5th when last seen. Player
- **4. HM ALCHAHINE** Nice form with three wins in a row this year, the most recent over 1600m in a Group 2 PA race at Hamburg-Horn (DEU) on July 6th. Live contender and is top-rated
- **5. DJAFAR -** Fair 3rd last time out over 1600m in a Group 1 PA race over 1600m at Goodwood (UK) on July 30th. Others rate higher

Summary: HM ALCHAHINE (4) has been in top form, winning his last three races. His most recent success came at Hamburg-Horn in Germany in a Group 2 PA race in early July. He can edge this from LUWSAIL (3), who won two Group 1 PA races in the Spring of this year and ran a pleasing race when he was second at Deauville early in August on his last run. MOSHRIF (1) has been placed on the latest two starts and is capable of being competitive.

C2 - QATAR PRIX FOY - 2400m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Gr2 Race - Flat - EUR € 119,000

- **1. ALMAQAM -** Decent 2nd on July 26th over 2050m at York (UK) in the Sky Bet York Stakes (Gr.2) and success in a Group 3 race before that in late May at Sandown Park (UK). Might find a few too smart
- 2. CHEEKY BOY 3rd on his last start over 2400m at Vichy in a Listed race on July 15th. Faces a tough challenge
- **3. IRESINE** He has been 4th on his last two runs, the most recent in the Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud (Gr.1) on June 29th over 2400m. Others rate higher
- **4. MONT ST MICHEL -** Recent success at Killarney (IRL) on August 22nd over 3400m in a conditions race. Big step up in class and down in trip might find him out
- **5. ARROW EAGLE -** He has won all four races this year. The last success was over 2400m at Chantilly on June 1st in the Grand Prix De Chantilly (Gr.2). He is improving and enters calculations
- **6. MAP OF STARS -** Good effort to be 2nd in the Grosser Dallmayr-Preis (Gr.1) in Germany on July 27th over 2000m. Previous course winner. Up in trip but warrants respect
- **7. SOSIE -** Classy performer, who won the Prix d'Ispahan (Group 1) at this track in late May on his penultimate start. He was caught flat-footed when last seen in the Coral-Eclipse (Group 1) at Sandown on July 5th. More is expected this time
- **8. LOS ANGELES -** Top-class performer on his day. He won the Tattersalls Gold Cup (Group 1) at the Curragh in May and was given a strange ride next time, 4th on the last run in a Group 3 race over 2000m on 16th August at the Curragh. He will like this extra trip today and can score
- **9. BYZANTINE DREAM -** Decent 2nd last time out in the Tenno Sho (Spring) (Grade 1) at Kyoto (Japan) in early May. He won the Longines Red Sea Turf Handicap (Group 2) previously in Riyadh. One to pay attention to

Summary: LOS ANGELES (8) is a proven Group 1 performer, having landed the Tattersalls Gold Cup at the Curragh in May, and can bounce back to his best under Christophe Soumillon with Ryan Moore sidelined. He is narrowly preferred to SOSIE (7), winner of the Prix d'Ispahan (Gr.1) here in late May and well suited by this trip. MAP OF STARS (6) brings strong form after finishing runner-up in the Grosser Dallmayr-Preis (Gr.1) in Germany late in July and must be respected. ARROW EAGLE (5) looks next best.

C3 - QATAR PRIX CARRUS - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Class 2 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 50,900

- **1. SKYLIGHT BROCHARD -** Unplaced last time, 3rd before that over 1350m at Cholet in a Class 2 race on June 30th. Honest gelding who can feature
- **2. DIVINE CHRISNAT** Unplaced last time out, 4th before that over 1600m at Compiegne on July 24th in a Class 2 handicap. Needs to be more reliable
- **3. KIARO -** Credible 3rd over 1500m at Deauville on August 21st in a Class 2 handicap when last seen. One to consider, and can make the frame
- **4. BELLANO -** Two unplaced runs this year, 7th at Deauville over 1500m in a Class 2 handicap on August 21st when last seen. He has to enter each way calculations
- **5. TORTISAMBERT -** Two unplaced efforts since a 4th at this track over 1400m in a Class 2 handicap on May 22nd. Each way angle
- **6. AMEDRAS -** Four unplaced runs of late, well beaten over 1400m in a Class 2 handicap at this track on June 12th when last appearing. Unlikely to be involved
- **7. LEOPARDUCCIO** Unplaced last time out, 4th previously over 1500m at Deauville on August 21st in a Class 2 race. Makes limited appeal
- **8. AGAT -** Four unplaced runs of late, 9th at Deauville over 1400m in a Class 1 race on August 24th on his most recent outing. He has eased in the weights and can make the top four
- **9. CHALDERO -** Three good runs recently, 2nd at Deauville in a Class 2 handicap over 1500m on August 21st on his latest. Well drawn and can win under Mickael Barzalona
- **10. RECONSTRUCTED -** He won two runs back over 1400m in a claimer at Vichy on July 18th. He has won Class 3 handicap races this April, but this is a stiffer test
- **11. PUMALIN PARK -** Four unplaced runs since a win over 1400m at this track in a Class 2 handicap on April 6th. Among the leading each way contenders
- **12. TALENTUOSO -** Two unplaced runs since he was 3rd over 1400m at Compiegne on May 30th in a Class 3 race. Others seem better equipped
- **13. SEVENDAY -** 3rd two runs back over 1400m at Deauville on August 3rd in a Class 3 handicap. His best form has been over 1200m
- **14. WHITE PLATIN -** 9th on the last start at Deauville over 1200m in a Class 1 handicap on August 16th. He won at Vichy in mid-July over 1400m and warrants respect
- **15. WAPI -** Well beaten last time out over 1500m on August 21st in a Class 2 handicap at Deauville. He lacks consistency, and others make more appeal
- **16. FOU FURIEUX -** Out of form this year, several unplaced efforts. 8th at Deauville over 1500m in a Class 3 handicap on August 21st on his last start. Hard to recommend



Summary: CHALDERO (9) arrives in good form, with a Deauville win two starts ago and two seconds either side of that success. With Mickael Barzalona aboard and a favourable draw, he holds strong claims. SKYLIGHT BROCHARD (1) is admirably consistent and, despite carrying top weight, should give another solid account. TORTISAMBERT (5) has run well here before and is respected, while BELLANO (4) should be fitter for recent outings and is expected to improve. AGAT (8) also makes the shortlist.

C4 - QATAR PRIX DU MOULIN DE LONGCHAMP - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - Gr1 Race - Flat - EUR € 800,000

- **1. MARHABA YA SANAFI -** 9th last time, 2nd previously over 1600m in a Group 3 race at Chantilly on June 15th. Not quite the force of old, and others are preferred
- **2. QUDDWAH -** Good win over 1600m in a Group 3 race at Chantilly on July 20th. He can make his presence felt back in action on a track he has won at
- **3. ROSALLION -** He has been competing in Top-Class races all year, 4th over 1400m in the City Of York (Gr.1) Stakes on August 23rd when last seen. Group 1 winner last year (St James Palace Stakes) at Ascot, and he can not be ignored
- **4. DANCING GEMINI -** Classy colt, 3rd on his last start over 1600m in the Prix Jaques Le Marois (Gr.1) on August 17th over 1600m. Ought to be in the shake-up
- **5. GO TO FIRST -** 5th on his last run over 1600m at Deauville in the Prix Jaques Le Marois (Gr.1) on August 17th. He needs to run a personal best to win
- **6. LEAD ARTIST -** 7th on his last runs, a win before that at Newbury (UK) on May 17th over 1600m in the Lockinge Stakes (Gr.1). He might find a few too smart
- **7. PERSICA -** Two unplaced efforts since a win at Epsom (UK) over 1700m in the Diomed Stakes (Gr.3) on June 7th. Unlikely to threaten the principles
- **8. ALCANTOR -** Fair 4th at Chantilly when last seen on July 20th in a Group 3 race on July 20th. Among the leading each way chances
- **9. SAHLAN -** Nice success in a Group 3 race at Deauville over 1600m on August 10th on his most recent start. One of the leading contenders
- **10. THE LION IN WINTER -** Unplaced last time out, 3rd previously over 1400m at Deauville over 1600m on August 17th in a Gr.1. 3rd in the Prix Jean Prat over 1400m in early July. Merits consideration
- **11. HENRI MATISSE** Solid performer, 3rd last time out at Ascot (UK) over 1600m in the Visit Qatar Sussex Stakes (Group 1) at Goodwood on July 30th. He won the Poule d'Essai des Poulains (Group 1) at this track in May. He has a key chance and can be too smart for his rivals
- **12. SERENGETI -** Four unplaced runs of late, the latest when 7th in a Group 1 race at Goodwood (UK) on July 30th over 1600m. Look elsewhere, and a pacemaker role is expected

Summary: HENRI MATISSE (11) thrives over 1600m and looks the one to beat. Winner of the Poule d'Essai des Poulains (Gr.1) here in May, he has maintained his form since and will be hard to oppose with Christophe Soumillon in the saddle. ROSALLION (3) has been competing at the highest level all season and should be more effective back at this trip after finding 1400m in the City of York Stakes (Gr.1) on the sharp side. SAHLAN (9) and QUDDWAH (2) can fight out the minor honours.

C5 - QATAR PRIX VERMEILLE - 2400m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Gr1 Race - Flat - EUR € 600,000

- **1. SURVIE -** Finished second in the Group 1 Sumbe Prix Jean Romanet over 2000m at Deauville on 24 August. Is looking for first Group 1 success
- **2. AVENTURE -** Finished second behind Calandagan in the Group 1 Grand Prix De Saint-Cloud over 2400m at Saint Cloud on 29 June. The daughter of Sea The Stars will be competitive
- **3. GINALYAH -** Finished fifth in a Group 3 over 2500m at Deauville on 17 August. Cristian Demuro rides but she may be outgunned in this line-up
- **4. BEDTIME STORY -** Finished behind Survie when fifth in the Group 1 Sumbe Prix Jean Romanet over 2000m at Deauville on 24 August. She is not the stable elect
- **5. WHIRL -** Super impressive when winning the Group 1 Qatar Nassau Stakes over 2000m at Glorious Goodwood on 31 July. She should take a power of beating with Christophe Soumillon booked to ride
- **6. GEZORA -** Won the Group 1 Prix De Diane Longines over 2100m at Chantilly on 15 June. Mickael Barzalona steps back into the saddle and she merits healthy respect

Summary: WHIRL (5) has won her last two starts over 2000m, both of which were Group 1 races. She is the class horse and Christophe Soumillon deputises for the injured Ryan Moore. The daughter of Wootton Bassett should take a power of beating. AVENTURE (2) comes off a good second-place finish behind Calandagan in a Group 1 at Saint Cloud. She should pose a massive threat. GEZORA (6) won the Group 1 Prix De Diane Longines on 15 June. She is in a good space and merits obvious consideration. SURVIE (1) has placed in two Group 1's this year. She should get the run of the race from pole position and can show.

C6 - QATAR PRIX NIEL - 2400m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Gr2 Race - Flat - EUR € 119,000

- **1. LEFFARD -** Winner of the Group 1 Cygames Grand Prix De Paris over 2400m on this course on 13 July. Cristian Demuro retains the ride, and he will be looking to follow up with another victory
- 2. CUALIFICAR Finished third in a Group 2 over 2000m at Deauville on 16 August. His penultimate run when second in the Group 1 Qatar Prix Du Jockey Club catches the eye
- **3. SWAGMAN -** Won a Group 3 over 2000m at Sandown on 25 April. He returns from a short break, and the Trainer/Jockey combination cannot be ignored
- **4. PARACHUTISTE -** Won a Conditional Listed over 2400m at Clairefontaine on 15 August. Oisin Murphy is booked to ride, but more is needed to win this contest
- **5. BAY CITY ROLLER -** Finished sixth in a Group 2 over 2050m at York on 26 July. His penultimate run behind Daryz is eye-catching
- **6. NITOI -** Finished second in a Conditional Listed over 2000m at Deauville on 17 August. He finished behind a talented sort that day and looks to be maturing into a nice type
- **7. AFTERMATH -** Having first run this year. Won over 1400m at the Curragh on 29 September 2024. May be outclassed in this line-up
- **8. TENNESSEE STUD -** Hails from the visiting Joseph O'Brien yard. Finished fourth in the Group 1 Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby over 2400m at the Curragh on 29 June. Merits healthy respect

Summary: LEFFARD (1) comes off an impressive victory in the Group 1 Cygames Grand Prix De Paris. He is the class horse in the race and should be the horse to beat. CUALIFICAR (2) is better than his last start when third at Deauville. His penultimate run in the Group 1 Qatar Prix Du Jockey Club catches the eye and he is a big runner on that effort. TENNESSEE STUD (8) was not disgraced in the Group 1 Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby last time and should have a say. NITOI (6) is maturing into a nice horse and should give a good account of himself.

C1 - PRIX ASSOCIATION DES AQPS (PRIX RICHARD DE GENNES) - 2400m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Gr3 APQS Race - Flat - EUR € 33,900

- **1. MONDIALITO D'HUEZ -** Impressed on debut with a good win in a Conditions race at Le Liond'Angers over this distance on 3 August. Can follow up
- **2. MISTERDOC** Showed some improvement when a winner of a Conditions race at Vittel over 2400m on 15 August. Tougher task this time
- **3. MISSION SMART -** Consistent so far and was runner-up in a Conditions race at Le Lion-d'Angers over this distance on 28 July. Not out of it
- **4. MOONLIGHT STAR -** Holding form and finished third in a Conditions race at Le Lion-d'Angers over 2400m on 3 August. Can earn some more money
- **5. MERCI GABY -** Has not done much wrong in two starts and was a winner last time out in a Conditions race at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2700m on 22 July. Can make the frame
- **6. MARLAND -** Attracted betting support when third on debut in a Conditions race at Le Liond'Angers over this distance on 3 August. Be right there at the finish
- **7. MERVEILLE ALLEN -** Shows promise and was victorious in a Conditions race at Le Liond'Angers over this distance on 10 August. Can follow up

Summary: A competitive race for a small field. MONDIALITO D'HUEZ (1) looked good when winning on debut and has every chance of following up in a tougher field. MARLAND (6) was only third behind that rival on debut but should be more of a danger this time around. MERVEILLE ALLEN (7) shows promise and could have a lot more to offer. MISSION SMART (3) is consistent and can get involved in the finish once again.

C2 - PRIX SEE YOU SUN - TROPHEE DE L'ELEVAGE ANGLO-ARABE - 2400m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Condition Race - Flat - EUR € 45,700

- **1. HARRY DE LA BRUNIE AA** Ultra-consistent and finished third in a Conditions race at La Teste-de-Buch over 2400m on 27 June. Has claims
- **2. JAFAR D'ESCAR AA -** Has been modest of late and was 5th in a Conditions race at Mont-de-Marsan over 2450m on 16 July. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **3. VERTIGO POMPADOUR AA -** Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Conditions race at Mont-de-Marsan over 2450m on 16 July. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. JAKARTA TROIS AA -** Remains in good form and finished third in a Conditions race at Mont-de-Marsan over 2450m on 16 July. Not out of it
- **5. HALANDJILA AA -** In very good shape and was runner-up in a Conditions race at Mont-de-Marsan over 2450m on 16 July. Be right there at the finish
- **6. HORIZON DE TANUES AA -** Has only been modest of late and was 7th in a Conditions race at Mont-de-Marsan over 2450m on 16 July. Others make more appeal
- **7. NOTE AREDIENNE AA -** Still improving and was victorious in a Conditions race at Mont-de-Marsan over 2450m on 16 July. Can follow up

Summary: NOTE AREDIENNE AA (7) has won three of her five starts and was impressive when getting the better of HALANDJILA AA (5) at Mont-de-Marsan in July. She sets the standard for the race and is a confident pick. HALANDJILA AA (5) was only run out of it late that day and will not go down easily again. HARRY DE LA BRUNIE AA (1) is very consistent and was not disgraced behind HALANDJILA AA (5) when they met. JAKARTA TROIS AA (4) is another in good form and capable of winning.
