RACE 2:BET365 HANDICAP (HERITAGE HANDICAP)

Inigo Jones Peter The Great Too Friendly

INIGO JONES was last seen finishing third to the subsequent Hampton Court first and third (Mohaafeth and Secret Protector) in the Newmarket Stakes on the Rowley Mile in early May. This son of New Approach remains unexposed and that form suggests that a mark of 96 may underestimate his ability. Peter The Great has shown plenty of ability in novice company in recent months and he cannot be discounted on his handicap bow, while Dubai Honour also makes the shortlist having been the first home on the far-side in the Britannia. Foxes Tales is likely to be popular have won the Golden Gates but a 9lb rise for that win has to be a slight concern. Too Friendly should not be underestimated at potentially a big price having caught the eye when not seeing out the trip in the King George V last time.

Sandrine Hello You Oscula

The first three home from the Albany at Royal Ascot reoppose here and SANDRINE may well confirm her superiority over Hello You and Oscula this afternoon. Andrew Balding's filly had a bit in hand over those rivals on that occasion and she may have more to offer today. That said, the beaten rivals will have some hope of reversing that form, with a less stiff track potentially suiting Hello You and Oscula raced on her own for the majority the race at Ascot. Flotus disappointed when favourite for the same contest and it is far too soon to be writing her off, while Desert Dreamer has an each-way chance.

- 5 HONEY SWEET Foaled 16 Feb. Dam a lightly raced maiden. A winner at 5f on soft ground. Beaten 4l behind System at 22-1 when seventh of 15 on her latest outing over this course and distance (good to firm) last month.
- 6 OSCULA Foaled 15 Apr. Successful twice at 6f on good ground. Third of 15 behind Sandrine beaten 2l at 10-1 on her latest outing in the Group 3 Albany Stakes at Ascot over 6f (heavy) last month. Has won at Epsom and Brighton this season.
- 7 SADMAH Foaled 17 Mar. Full sister to Dajraan, won at 7f. A winner at 6-1 at Haydock over 6f (good to firm) on her latest outing last month, beating Madame Bonbon by 3/4l.

RACE 4:BET365 TROPHY (HERITAGE HANDICAP)

Lostwithiel Global Storm Amtiyaz

Global Storm has improved up in trip this season having won on the Rowley Mile on his penultimate outing before finishing third to Amtiyaz at Royal Ascot. That said, the horse he beat at Newmarket, LOSTWITHIEL, is overpriced as he drops back in trip having not stayed 2m4f in the Ascot Stakes. He travelled well before stamina limitations kicked in and the use of Mark Crehan's 3lb claim will aid his cause further. Arthurian Fable has run with credit on both his starts this campaign, finishing fourth on both occasions behind Global Storm and Amtiyaz, and he is capable of being in the mix along with Prince Alex, who finished second at Goodwood last time, and Northumberland Plate runner-up Hochfeld.

Alcohol Free Snow Lantern Lady Bowthorpe

Connections of ALCOHOL FREE were adamant she would stay a mile and received the justification of their view when running out a solid winner of the Coronation Stakes at Royal Ascot. She got the better of Snow Lantern (second) and Mother Earth (third) on that occasion and Andrew Balding's filly may yet have more to offer as the season progresses. Snow Lantern proved her York run in May to be a blip as she bounced back in style, proving she is up to Group 1 company, and she has to command the utmost respect. Her conqueror on the Knavesmire, Primo Bacio, missed Ascot on account of the ground and comes into this with every chance, while Lady Bowthorpe can confirm herself best of those who tackled the Duke Of Cambridge at Royal Ascot with the winner, Indie Angel, taking full advantage of the track bias towards the near side rail.
