SUSURRANDO (5) was most disappointing when starting favourite last time out as Fine Dining made all, cruising home to victory. He could prove better this shorter trip. Veteran CIRCLE OF GRACE (7) makes the trip from the Highveld for a trip on the poly. He only has 49 kg to shoulder and ridden by a more than capable apprentice.
