**RACE 1: DUBAI DUTY FREE SHERGAR CUP DASH (HANDICAP) (CLASS 2) (3YO PLUS) (FROM ASCOT RACE 1)**

**ADAAY IN DEVON - APOLLO ONE - JORDAN ELECTRICS**

Race Preview: Apollo One finished an excellent second in the Stewards' Cup at Goodwood last weekend and he must be respected off 1lb higher. That said, the admirably consistent ADAAY IN DEVON edges preference. Rod Millman's charge was narrowly denied when finishing runner-up over 6f in a York Group 3 last month and, pitched back into handicap company, she may prove tough to stop. Jordan Electrics completed a four-timer over 5f at Hamilton last week and completes the shortlist off a 6lb higher mark.

Race Preview: SAMUI looked every inch a stayer to keep on the right side of when fairly bolting up over 2m1f at Killarney last month and, despite a 13lb hike in the ratings, it would be no surprise if this progressive son of Siyouni had enough in the locker to bring up a double. The suspicion is that Spirit Mixer did too much too soon when faring best of those ridden prominently over an extended 2m4f at Goodwood last week. He can emerge as the main danger to the selection eased 1lb, while Fox Journey is also considered from a sliding mark.

Race Preview: INSANITY looked the likely winner for a long way before being denied in the shadows of the post when finishing runner-up over C&D last month and, nudged up 3lb, he can atone for that near-miss here. Set Point made a winning return to the level when scoring gamely over 1m2f at the Curragh recently and the six-year-old is considered off 5lb higher. The Goat and Dancing In Paris are others to consider in what looks a competitive affair.

Race Preview: JARRAAF took a big leap forward to score by a comfortable two and a half lengths over track and trip last month and was put up 8lb for that triumph. Owen Burrows' colt is unbeaten over this distance and he can continue his upward trajectory to make it three wins out of five starts. Imperial Guard hit the frame in a hot handicap at Newmarket on his latest outing and it would be no surprise to see him get involved off the same mark, while last-time-out winner Venture Capital is another to keep an eye on.
