The son of Muhaarar was an 18,000-euro purchase as a yearling, and though his pedigree is not packed with speed, the potential for soft ground may emphasise his stamina on this stiff track. Duchray has to be of some interest for a trainer that has a history of success with his two-year-olds.

Claim The Stars ran creditably, without getting his head in front last season, culminating in a below-par effort in the 200,000-pound two-year-old race at Doncaster in September, and he sets a decent form standard on his return. Preference is for RAMBUSO CREEK, however, who, similarly to the aforementioned rival, performed consistently in his two-year-old campaign. Most notably, the selection went well here on debut, when runner-up, and his liking for the track can stand him in good stead this afternoon. Karl Burke saddles Lullaby Bay, and she could be involved if improving on her third-placed finish at Wolverhampton in November.

Fine Wine and Dave Dexter both arrive on the back of wins at Southwell on their most recent starts, and are others to note.
