Richard Hannon's filly may be better suited to the hustle and bustle of a big field but granted a strong pace here, she could be coming home faster than most. Porsche Cavalier appears a shrewd purchase for Robyn Brisland and is likely to be the biggest danger on the back of a strong effort in the Dick Poole Stakes. Wolverhampton winner Benefit is open to any amount of improvement as well.
