Kenilworth, 13.04.2021, Race 1, Gallops, 1200m, Turf, R57.000, 13:05GMT+2

Race Summary: Tricky start. ALL SWAGGER wasn't beaten far on debut and ought to have come on since, so may have more to offer stepped up in trip with that experience under the belt. GREEN VIGILANTE ran with promise on debut and has been gelded since, so is likely to improve and should be included. RAVENSTHORPE showed signs of inexperience first time out but would have tightened up with that outing and should give a bold account of himself with natural improvement expected. HENDO SHUFFLE and MASTER OF TIME also have earning potential. Watch the betting on newcomers NEW YORK NEW YORK and SHESH BESH.

Race Summary: KWINTA'S LIGHT acquitted herself well in a feature against the boys after consecutive second-place finishes and should find this an easier task back among her own sex. Both COMEDY OF MANNERS and GRAYSWOOD PINK have the form and experience to expose any chinks in that rival's armour. SEEKING PEACE could make her presence felt too, although a bigger threat is likely to come from one of the newcomers. Watch the betting!

Race Summary: Good race. HIS CHOICE and IRISH MORNING are progressive sorts racing at the peak of their powers, so are likely to dominate. MASTER OF POWER ought to improve on a pleasing comeback run and could get into the action. BRAVE TIGER is probably at best over this trip and races off a mark lower than that of his last win (this track and trip), so warrants respect. FORT RED is versatile and capable of making presence felt with Richard Fourie back aboard.

Race Summary: HAPPY ARISTOCRAT was left too much to do when dropped out from a wide draw last time. He ought to reward his followers and shed his maiden tag from a favourable draw with Grant van Niekerk back in the saddle. TARA ITI has another wide gate to negotiate but did catch the eye in his last start (wide draw) and could build on that improvement to pose a threat. Stablemate GRAND ESCAPE has failed to build on the promise of his debut 4th (1400m) but has scope for improvement and could reaffirm reverting to this trip. FREEDOM PARK and BEY SUYAY have shown enough to warrant inclusion in larger exotics, while SMILEATTHESUNSET is relatively unexposed and capable of getting into the picture.

Race Summary: JO LOVES has gone close in her last 3 starts (latest over this trip) with the blinkers on, so another bold bid is expected with the headgear retained. PRINCESS OF WINTER fits a similar profile and is likely to fight out the finish. Both IMPERIAL BALLET and CAPE TO RIO finished behind that rival

last time but are capable of better, reverting to this track, so warrant respect. PATH TO GO is one to note as on pedigree, she should improve for this step up in trip. FLY TO RIO has earning potential and appears best of the rest.

Race Summary: T'CHALLA has raised his game after gelding, confirming the improvement of his comeback win with a fast-finishing 2nd in a stronger race on handicap debut. He should improve further in his peak outing, so rates the runner to beat. DE BULL finished just over 2 lengths adrift of him last time and should get closer on these revised weight terms. The extra 200m also likely to suit. WHAT A MAN and BALTIMORE JACK are in good form and effective over this trip, so should be competitive too. POWER GRID and SPRING AWAKENING are of interest at this level, while APLHA PAPPA and TICKET TO RIDE aren't without chances either.

Race Summary: Both FOLLOW THE STAR and DOUBLE REWARD are honest fillies capable of acquitting themselves well against males, although worth taking on with less-exposed and progressive 3yo rivals. SIX HILLS GIANT and CAPTAINS WORLD fall into that category and are likely to improve on recent efforts over this trip. LETS BOOGIE BABY finished behind the latter in a recent meeting but caught the eye on that occasion with a fast-finishing 4th on his return from a break. He will strip fitter for that run, so could represent value with improved fitness on his side. Maturing SUPER DUKE is another to consider.
