RACE 3: COOLMORE STUD HANDICAP

Ibiza Rocks Able Kane Silver Samurai

Able Kane failed to settle at Newmarket on his latest start and holds good claims on his return to 6f. However, IBIZA ROCKS posted some useful pieces of form last season and, with the drop in trip expected to suit, the four-year-old gets the nod. Silver Samurai is still unexposed as a sprinter and after producing a creditable effort at Ascot last week, he cannot be ruled out either.

MORGHOM made a big impression when scoring readily on his racecourse debut over 1m here four weeks ago and, with this shorter trip unlikely to pose any problems, he is fancied to complete the double. Whitebeam finished third behind a couple of useful-looking sorts on her debut over C&D last

month and she is likely to give another good account, while Whats In The Bag, Royal Debut, Naga Eye and Ileach Mathan add further spice to the race.

Zabeir Sea Dart Falling Shadow

A big run from Morghom in the previous race would boost the claims of ZABEIR, who was a fastfinishing second behind that rival on his racecourse debut over 1m here last month. Today's extra yardage will almost certainly suit this son of El Kabeir and he gets the vote to go one better. Sea Dart made a pleasing introduction when third over 7f here last August and he warrants respect stepping up in trip on his return, while Falling Shadow, first past the post at Wolverhampton last time but later disqualified for a prohibited substance, cannot be ruled out either.
